INDY BITS

ABOUT YESTERDAY: The Indianapolis Indians jumped out to an 8-4 lead through four innings after a pair of three-run home runs by Dylan Shockley and Seth Beer, but fell to the Rochester Red Wings 12-4 in Sunday afternoon's series finale at Innovative Field. With Rochester leading 1-0 in the first inning following a solo home run by Riley Adams, Dylan Shockley jumped on Washington Nationals rehabber Josiah Gray with a two-out, three-run home run in the second inning. The Indians continued to wear down Gray in the third, with a double by Joshua Palacios kicking off a four-run frame. The hot-hitting outfielder came around to score on a Malcom Nuñez sacrifice fly before Seth Beer, swinging another hot bat for Indy in the series, launched a three-run homer to extend the lead to 7-4. The teams traded runs in the fourth before the Red Wings offense took off against the Indians bullpen and defensive miscues. With two outs in the sixth inning, a hanging fly ball off the bat of Jackson Cluff dropped beyond the outstretched glove of right fielder Ji Hwan Bae to score Carter Keiboom from first base. One inning later, a two-run single by Keiboom against after back-to-back free bases tied the game, and a bases-loaded walk to Cluff by gave Rochester the lead. The Red Wings put up three runs again in the eighth, capped by a two-run double by Juan Yepez that dropped between the center fielder Palacios and second baseman Liover Peguero.

BIG SWING VS. THE BIG LEAGUER: Dylan Shockley made a splash to erase an early 1-0 lead by Rochester in the second inning. With two on and two outs, Shockley took big-league rehabber Josiah Gray deep for his third professional home run and his first since Aug. 10, 2021, with FCL Pirates Gold vs. FCL Orioles Orange. He followed with a double in the fourth inning, marking his first game with multiple extra-base hits since June 5, 2022, with Double-A Altoona vs. Bowie. Shockley now has five extra-base hits in 19 games with Indianapolis after having just three extra-base hits (all doubles) in 62 games over the past two seasons combined. His three RBI yesterday also tied his career high, last matched on Aug. 20, 2021, vs. FCL Pirates Black.

THREE BEERS, PLEASE: Seth Beer continued his hot streak yesterday, going 1-for-2 with two runs, a three-run home run and two walks to extend his hitting streak to four games. He has now hit safely in five of his last six games with a .333 batting average (7-for-21) with four runs, three extra-base hits and eight RBI. It was his fourth consecutive game with an RBI, marking Indianapolis' longest RBI streak since Matt Gorski drove in a run in five straight games from May 18-23. His three RBI performance tied his season-high, last met on May 24 with Double-A Altoona vs. Erie.

WELCOME BACK: Jake Lamb was re-signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on Friday and went 2-for-4 with two runs in his first game back with Indianapolis yesterday. Prior to an 0-for-19 stretch from June 9-15, Lamb was hitting .320 (57-for-178) in 49 games with the Indians, the third-best mark among International League qualifiers. He leads team leaders in batting average (.294) and on-base percentage (.382) for the entire season, while also ranking in slugging percentage (2nd, 418), OPS (2nd, 800), walks (2nd, 28), hits (3rd, 59), RBI (4th, 31), doubles (4th, 13), total bases (4th, 84) and extra-

JP FOR THREE MORE: Joshua Palacios led the Indians offense yesterday, going 3-for-5 with a run, double and RBI. It was his third multi-hit performance at Rochester last week and his second consecutive after going 4-for-5 with two runs, a double and three RBI on Friday, setting season-highs in hits and RBI with the performance. Friday night marked his fourth career-high four-hit game, the last coming in just his second big-league game on April 10, 2021, with Toronto vs. Los Angeles (AL). In that contest, he became the second player in American League history with four-plus hits and four-plus runs in one of his first two career games, following Milwaukee's Wid Conroy on April 25, 1902. Yesterday was also Palacios' seventh multi-hit game in 12 contests since being reinstated from the injured list on June 11, and in that time he is hitting .370 (17-for-46) with five runs, four doubles, one home run and six RBI.

GORSKI GOES FOR EXTRA BASES: Matt Gorski doubled again yesterday and is now tied for the fifth-most extra-base hits in the International League with 34. He also ranks sixth among IL qualifiers with a .567 slugging percentage. He has hit 12 extra-base hits in 21 June games, including eight of 15 total doubles in 63 games this season.

TONIGHT: After going 1-5 vs. the Rochester Red Wings last night, the Indians continue a stretch of 12 games in 12 days with the first of three games at Louisville Slugger Field, home of the Reds-affiliated Bats. In nine games in Louisville this season, they are 2-7. The stretch concludes with three games vs. the Bats at Victory Field from July 4-6. Beginning the six-game home-and-home series tonight is LHP Marco Gonzales, making the first start of a rehab assignment after being placed on the 15-day IL with a left forearm muscle strain on April 14 (transferred to the 60-day IL on June 3). It will be his first career start vs. the Bats. Countering for Louisville is RHP Grant Gavin (0-0, ---), making his Bats debut after being signed by Cincinnati as a minor league free agent. In eight career appearances vs. Indianapolis with Omaha in 2021, Gavin is 0-1 with a 5.19 ERA (5er/8.2ip) and 10 strikeouts.

GONZO: The Pittsburgh Pirates today announced that left-handed pitcher Marco Gonzales will begin a rehab assignment with the Indianapolis Indians tonight at 6:35 as they open a three-game series at Louisville. The 32-year-old was placed on the 15-day injured list on April 14 with a left forearm muscle strain and was later transferred to the 60-day IL. He began the season on Pittsburgh's Opening Day roster and recorded a 2.65 ERA (5er/17.0ip) and 11 strikeouts in three starts. Two of his first three outings were quality starts. Tonight marks Gonzales' first minor league start since 2017 with Triple-A Tacoma and Memphis. In 35 career Triple-A starts, he is 13-10 with a 4.01 ERA (87er/195.1ip) and 156 strikeouts.

THIS DATE IN 2000: Indians starting pitcher Horacio Estrada tossed a complete game, allowing two earned runs on four hits with four strikeouts over 9.0 innings in a 7-2 win over Pawtucket at Victory Field. Kurt Bierek went 2-for-4 with his sixth home run of the season, and the game was completed in a tidy 2 hours and 5 minutes.
