Scouting Report: The Patriots play the fourth of a six-game series against the Erie SeaWolves at UPMC Park tonight. Somerset has dropped the first three games of the series and are now on a season-high four-game losing streak. The SeaWolves sit just 1.5 games behind Bowie for the top spot in the Southwest Division and carry the second best batting average in all of Double-A (.272).

Digging the Long-Ball: Dermis Garcia hit his 11th home run of the season Tuesday night. He is now tied for the most in all of Double-A (Johan Mieses) and has the third most in all of the minors. The Patriots now have 41 home runs collectively on the season, tied for the most in the Double-A Northeast League with Bowie and tied for fourth-most in all of Double-A (48, Northwest Arkansas).

Home Run Dependant: Somerset has dropped each of the first three games of their current series in Erie. In each game, the only runs the team has scored have come on home runs (six runs total). The team has scored eight total runs over their current season-high four-game losing streak dating back to Sunday; seven of those eight runs have come on a home run.

Go, Diego! Go!: Diego Castillo has reached base safely in eight of his last night games. Over this stretch, Castillo is 14-for-34 (.412) with four home runs, seven runs scored and eight RBI. The Venezuelan countryman has reached base safely in 16 of the 20 games in which he has played this season and was named the Double-A Northeast League Player of the Week for the week of June 1st - June 6th.

Sandstorm: C Donny Sands team-best 16-game on-base streak ended Wednesday night. Over the 16 games, Sands went 20-for-63 (.317) and has reached base at a .394 clip. He had also hit safely in six-straight games carrying a .400 batting average over that stretch.

Vamos Venezuela: Infielder Oswaldo Cabrera was placed on the temporarily inactive list from 5/29 to 6/8 to play with Team Venezuela in the Olympic Qualifiers. In three games since returning to the team, Cabrera is 4-for-11 (.364) with a double and a home run.

Hits and Misses: The Patriots pitching staff owns the lowest ERA (3.15) in all of Double-A baseball. The team has also struck out the most batters (384) and ranks second in both WHIP (1.15) and batting average against (.203) amongst all Double-A teams.

Ride My Car: Reliever Stephen Ridings lost his scoreless streak at 10 innings pitched after allowing a run to score in the eighth inning of Thursday night's contest. Ridings did not allow a run through his first eight appearances and holds the second-lowest ERA on the team at 0.84 behind just Greg Weissert (0.79).
