YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels beat the Sea Dogs, 11-4, for their third straight win. The Sea Dogs took a 1-0 lead in the first with an RBI groundout by Chase Meidroth. **Andy Thomas** gave Richmond a 2-1 lead in the bottom of the first with a two-run single. Blaze Jordan tied the game, 2-2, with an RBI single in the third. Richmond scored three runs in each the fifth, sixth and seventh innings to pull ahead, 11-3. Two runs scored on a groundout by **Brady Whalen** and an error and Thomas added an RBI bunt single in the fifth. In the sixth, **Ismael Munguia** hit an RBI single, a run scored on an error and Whalen brought in a run with a single. After a Portland run in the top of the seventh, **Wade Meckler** hit a two-run triple in the bottom of the inning and Munguia brought in a run with a single. Nathan Hickey hit an RBI double in the eighth to close the scoring.

TODAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the fourth of a six-game series against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. This series is the first match-up between the two teams this season. The Flying Squirrels will travel to Portland for a six-game series from August 22-27. Last year, the two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond, with Richmond's series finale win clinching the Southwest Division First-Half title. The Sea Dogs won five-of-six against the Flying Squirrels at Hadlock Field last year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 21-10 in their last 31 games since June 18. On the last road trip, they went 1-2 in a series at Harrisburg and split a six-game set in Akron. In their last 31 games, the Flying Squirrels are batting .247 (245-for-991), the best in the Eastern League, with 30 homers, 44 doubles and have score 161 runs. In that same span, the Richmond pitching staff has combined for a 3.45 ERA, fourth-best in the league, with 330 strikeouts. Over the last 36 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 3.16 ERA (47 ER/134.0 IP) and have allowed nine home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.77 ERA, second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 335.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 463.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.38 ERA, which is the lowest in Double-A, just ahead of Akron (3.43), and the fourth-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors.

THE SEA DOGS have the best overall record in the Eastern League this season and are leading the second-half standings in the Northeast Division. The Sea Dogs are 12-8 in their last 20 games since July 2, including taking four-of-six in last week's series against the Fisher Cats, closing it with a no-hitter on Sunday. Portland's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including SS Marcelo Mayer (No. 1), 2B Nick Yorke (No. 4), RHP Wikelman Gonzalez (No. 7), C Nathan Hickey (No. 10), 2B Chase Meidroth (No. 11) and 1B Blaze Jordan (No. 20). MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospects list includes Mayer (No. 1), Yorke (No. 3), Jordan (No. 10), Gonzalez (No. 11), INF Matthew Lugo (No. 13), Hickey (No. 15), Meidroth (No. 19), RHP Jacob Webb (No. 24) and OF Phillip Sikes (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Wil Jensen** makes his second start of the season and the third of his career against the Sea Dogs. He worked out of the bullpen on Tuesday and threw two scoreless innings. He last started on June 18 at Bowie and threw a pair of scoreless frames. This year, Jensen leads the Eastern League in relief innings pitched and has the second-lowest ERA in the Eastern League (min. 50 IP). Last year, he reached Double-A in mid-July and went on to pitched eight games (five starts) for Richmond, going 2-2 with a 4.91 ERA. Jensen made two starts against the Sea Dogs in Portland last season. On August 9, he threw six innings and allowed three runs. On August 14, he allowed a career-high eight runs in 4.2 innings, his last outing before hitting the injured list for about three weeks. He pitched the rest of the season as a reliever. Jensen was signed by the Giants as a free agent from Pepperdine University in 2020. **For more on Jensen, see page two.**

FOR PORTLAND: Right-hander Grant Gambrell makes his 12th Double-A start. He last pitched on Saturday against the Fisher Cats and threw six innings, allowing two runs, with a season-high nine strikeouts. After going 1-2 with a 5.61 ERA in five starts in the month of June, he has gone 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA in his three July starts. Gambrell was selected in the third round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Royals out of Oregon State, where he was teammates for one season with **Wade Meckler**. He was traded to the Red Sox on June 4, 2021 for RHP Luis De La Rosa. This year, he made six starts with High-A Greenville and was promoted to Double-A Portland on May 18.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels are leading the Double-A level in total attendance (295,122) and average attendance (6,416) this year. They are also 13th in the minors in average attendance. Last year, Richmond led all 30 Double-A teams in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history.

FULL MUNGUIA: In his six games since returning from the IL, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .440 (11-for-25) with two doubles, two walks and five RBIs, adding a .481 on-base percentage. He picked up four hits in his three games of last week's series at Akron and has seven hits in the first three games of this week's series. On Thursday, he had three hits and scored three runs. Munguia was placed on the injured list on May 20 and reinstated on July 20, missing 49 games.

GLOW SHOW: Over his last 12 games since July 6, **Jimmy Glownke** is batting .325 (13-for-40) with two homers, three doubles, 10 RBIs and five walks. In last week's series in Akron, he hit .450 (9-for-20) with two homers, three doubles and 10 RBIs. Last Tuesday, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. Last Saturday night, Glownke clubbed a two-run homer in the top of the 11th in a 6-5 win.

ALL ABOARD THE SHANE TRAIN: **Shane Matheny** has picked up four hits in this week's series against the Sea Dogs, including a pair of RBI singles on Tuesday and added a walk and a double on Wednesday. He has walked five times in his last two games. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 113 walks, moving ahead of **Ricky Oropesa** (2013-16) for second-most in franchise history. He trails **Jacob Heyward** (2019, '21-22), who had 158 in his career. His .360 career on-base percentage is third-highest in Flying Squirrels franchise history (min. 700 PA).

RETURN OF THE MECK: **Wade Meckler** went on a 24-game on-base streak from May 17-July 6, which was the longest on-base streak to begin a Double-A career in Flying Squirrels history, passing the previous record set by **Luis Matos** (17 games) earlier this season. It was also tied for the ninth-longest on-base streak in franchise history. Meckler also had an 11-game run scored streak from June 23-July 6, which was a Flying Squirrels franchise record, passing the previous mark of nine straight games by Tyler LaTorre in 2014. In Game 1 of a doubleheader on June 23, Meckler tied the single-game franchise record for hits, going 5-for-5 and capping the night with a two-run, walk-off single for a 9-8 win over the Senators. For the season, Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 250 PA) in batting average (.383), ranks sixth in OBP (.455) and is sixth in wRC+ (168). He ranks second in the Eastern League (min. 150 PA) in batting average (.343), third in OBP (.434) and is first in BABIP (.409) while posting the 12th-lowest strikeout percentage (14.9) and the third-lowest swing-and-miss percentage (6.5).

MARTY PARTY: **Brandon Martorano** has reached base 12 times in his last seven games with an at-bat since July 14. He reached base five times on July 14 at Harrisburg, picking up three hits with a walk and was hit by a pitch. In his last 12 games since July 3, Martorano is batting .242 (8-or-33) with seven walks, two RBIs and four runs scored. Martorano missed 39 games on the injured list from April 21-June 8.

TAKE A WALK: **Hayden Cantrelle** has walked 57 times this season, which is second-most in the Giants organization and is the fifth-most in the Eastern League. His 18.3% walk rate is tied for the second-highest in the league this season. He also has the fourth-best on-base percentage (.394) in the league this year. His 57 walks this season are tied for the eighth-most in a single year in Flying Squirrels franchise history, even with **Javier Herrera** (57 - 2013). He is one walk away from tying **Skyler Stromsore** (2014), **Shane Matheny** (2022) and **Joe Panik** (2013) for the fourth-most walks in a season. The single-season record of 80 was set by **Jacob Heyward** in 2019. Cantrelle is on pace for 86 walks this season.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Hayden Cantrelle** is fourth in OBP (.394) and tied for fifth in walks (57). **Carson Seymour** is seventh in ERA (4.06), third in BAA (.232) and fifth in WHIP (1.26).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (No. 6), OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 8), RHP **Mason Black** (No. 9), RHP **Carson Seymour** (No. 14), RHP **Landen Roupp** (No. 15), OF **Wade Meckler** (No. 16), RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 27) and RHP **José Cruz** (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes eight Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29).

IN OTHER WORDS...
