Jersey Shore BlueClaws (37-26/62-64) vs Brooklyn Cyclones (25-39/71-59)

ShoreTown Ballpark – Lakewood, New Jersey (opened 2001) RHP Ryan Dromboski (2-1, 3.48) vs RHP Brett Banks (2-1, 2.59) Series: Game 5 of 6 (BlueClaws lead season series 15-13 of 30)

Last Game Recap...Aroon Escobar had two hits including a home run and scored all three runs as the BlueClaws won their fifth straight game, 3-1 over Brooklyn on Friday night at ShoreTown Ballpark...Luke Gabrysh earned the win, allowing one run in five innings, while Saul Teran earned his 11th save.

Going for 6 (and .500)...The BlueClaws would win a 6th straight game with a win tonight (they have won five in a row and seven of their last eight games)...lersey Shore is 29-13 since the All-Star break...With wins in their last two games (which would mean a seven-game win streak to end the season), they would finish at .500 on the season, at 64-64 (with four cancellations)...<u>The BlueClaws won seven striaght games earlier this year, thru August 8th (vs Brooklyn/Hub City) and they have won seven straight home games dating to August 22nd (vs Hudson Valley and Brooklyn).</u>

In Sight...With two wins this weekend, the BlueClaws would reach 39 wins and set a club record for most wins in a half as a High-A affiliate (they won 38 in the first half of 2024 [2nd by 1.5 games] and the second half of 2023 [won the division in tiebreaker]).

Aroon and Goodbye...Aroon Escobar homered and scored all three BlueClaws runs on Friday night, his second home run of the week (Sunday at Aberdeen), 4th with the BlueClaws, and 15th overall this season...He is 24-78 since August 9th...He now has 11 multi-hit games with the BlueClaws and August 29th was his first three-hit game...Escobar is the #4 prospect in the Phillies system per MLB Pipeline...Escobar was hitting. 285 with 11 home runs, 42 RBIs, and 10 stolen bases with the Threshers...At the time of his promotion, Escobar was 6th in the FSL in average, T1st (with teammate Eduardo Tail) in home runs, 5th in RBIs, 1st in hits (78), and 1st in runs (52). Hit. 360 with five home runs and a 1.088 OPS in April, winning Phillies Minor League Player of the

Pitching Wins....Since the All-Star Break ended on July 18th (a stretch in which the BlueClaws are 29-13), the BlueClaws have a team ERA of just 2.94 (119 ER in 364 innings) including a starting pitcher ERA of 2.92 in that stretch (64 ER in 197 innings)....This week, they have held Brooklyn to a .123 batting average (19-123) and nine runs in four games.

Big 5 Weekend...The BlueClaws started Luke Gabrysh (St. Joe's) on Friday (5 IP, 1 ER) and start Ryan Dromboski (UPenn) tonight...Coupled with reliever Danny Wilkinson (Villanova), the BlueClaws have pitchers from three Big 5 school with a baseball after 2020 and is bringing it back in 2026, is the other Big 5 school with a baseball team)...The BlueClaws had RHP Matt Hockenberry, of Temple, in 2013-14, and he was the team's pitching coach in both 2019 and 2021.

There They Go...The BlueClaws stole two bases on Friday, two on Thursday, three Wednesday and have 11 this week, one week after they stole 24 bases in Aberdeen (including six on Saturday and seven last Thursday)...Jersey Shore has 49 in their last 16 games, and 65 in their last 22 games (since August 12")...They are now 104-121 since the All-Star Break...John Spikerman is a perfect 15-15 since the break...Avery Owusu-Asiedu has 14, one more than Bryan Rincon (IL since August 5"), Devin Saltiban and Dante Nori (who arrived August 25")...Aroon Escobar has 11....Since the All-Star Break ended, the BlueClaws are tied for 7" in the minors with 104 SBs (Great Lakes leads with 130).

Raylin Rollin...Raylin Heredia had a home run and five RBIs on Thursday night and is 11-31 with five home runs since August 21"...He homered both last Wednesday and Friday in Aberdeen, and twice the week prior against Hudson Valley...These are his first five home runs since returning from the IL on July 4"...Hereidia hit two home runs in April before two months on the Injured List, and now has seven on the season after he hit eight last vear with Clearwater.

Just One...The BlueClaws threw their second one-hitter of the season on Thursday and came within five outs of their second no-hitter of 2025 (July 2nd vs Wilmington, seven inning game)...They threw a one hitter on June 22nd against Hudson Valley, coming within two outs of a no-hitter, which was broken up by none other than Jose Colmenares, then with Hudson Valley and now with Jersey Shore).

Comeback Claws...The BlueClaws come-from-behind win on Thursday was their second win this season in which they trailed in the ninth inning (their other such win was in Greensboro on April 17th when Devin Saliban tied the game with a two run double in the ninth and the BlueClaws won 8-6 in 10 innings)...In their 29 wins since the All-Star break, the BueClaws have trailed in 10 of them (biggest deficit was 3-0 down in a 5-4 win over Wilmington on July 24th).

Hip Hip, Jose...Jose Colmenares (six game hitting streak snapped on Thursday) is 10-30 in his last eight games...He had the game tying RBI double in the ninth inning on Wednesday after a two run triple earlier in the game...He had two hits on Tuesday and is 12-46 since joining the BlueClaws, with two home runs...He homered on August 24th against Hudson Valley, his former team, and again on Friday in Aberdeen...Colmenares hit .222 with six homers with the Renegades before being released on August 6th...He signed with the Phillies and joined the BlueClaws on August 15th...

The Dante Nori Show...Dante Nori (12-39, 13 SBs, 7 BBs in nine games) went 11-24 last week in Aberdeen with 11 stolen bases, adding two hits on Sunday after he went 4-4 with a walk on Saturday, while adding four stolen bases...Nori came within one hit and one steal of tying the BlueClaws single-game records in both categories (Bryan Rincon had a four-steal game earlier in August)...Nori has hit sofely in all but three games with Jersey Shore and has reached base via a hit or a walk at least twice in all but three games...Nori was hitting .262 at the time of his promotion from Clearwater, with 16 doubles, 11 triples, four home runs, 43 RBIs, 37 stolen bases. He hit .304 in June and .324 in July...At the time of his promotion, Nori led the Florida State League in hits with 111, was second in triples, and third in walks with 66.

Number 17....Nori, the 27th pick in last year's draft, becomes the 17th Phillies first round pick to play for the BlueClaws, following both Aidan Miller (2023 draft) and Justin Crawford (2022 draft) who were with the BlueClaws last season....Andrew Painter (2001 draft) and Mick Abel (2022 draft) were both with the BlueClaws in 2022.

Sho Time...Kodey Shojinaga has thrown out 31% of potential base-stealers this year, including one to end the game on Tuesday...He had two hits on Friday, his third two-hit game with Jersey Shore...He is 9-33 since August 13th...Shojinaga, a 6th round pick last year from Kansas, is a Honolulu native that joined the BlueClaws on August 5th from Clearwater where he was hitting.229 with one home up.

Casey's First... Casey Steward earned his first professional save on Tuesday in just his fourth relief appearance since moving to the bullpen earlier this month... In his five relief appearances with Jersey Shore this year, Steward has thrown six scoreless innings, allowing three hits, two walks, and has eight strikeouts.

Spike It Up...John Spikerman is the only Minor League Baseball with at least 25 stolen bases without being caught (he is 27-27 this year and Yasser Mercedes of Fort Myers is 34-35 after being caught on Thursday)...Spikerman had three walks and two stolen bases on Wednesday after he had two, two-hit games last week in Aberdeen...He has four multi-hit games since August 8**...Spikerman is 15-15 stealing bases with Jersey Shore and 37-38 as a pro (only caught on 8/20/24 vs Dunedin)...The Phillies 3** found pick last year (University of Oklahoma), he injured the Blue-Claws from (Leavagter where he had three home runs in 28 agmes while hitting 238. Spikerman added 12 stolen hasse with the Thershers. He hit 36/2 last year with Okl

joined the BlueClaws from Clearwater where he had three home runs in 28 games while hitting .238...Spikerman added 12 stolen bases with the Threshers...He hit .367 last year with Oklahoma and helped the Sooners reach the College World Series in 2022 as a freshman.

Lights Out Saul...Saul Teran tied Winston Salem's Phil Fox for the league lead with 11 saves (Fox has been with WS all season) on Frday...He escaped the ghost runner in the 10th Inning on Wednesday to earn the win...He got the last five outs for his 10th BlueClaws save on August 22th and is the first BlueClaw with 10+ saves as a High-A affiliate and the first BlueClaw with 10+ saves since Addison Russ (13) and 2ach Warren (15) did it in 2018...He has allowed four runs in 26 innings with Jersey Shore, adding 23 strikeouts...He gave up two earned runs in 18 innings, adding 31 strikeouts and three walks with Clearwater before originally joining the BlueClaws on June 2th...Teran, 23, signed with the Phillies in 2021.

Extra_Extra_innings? No problem! After their win on Wednesday against Brooklyn, the BlueClaws are 9-1 in extra innings this season...They were the last team in the minors without an extra innings loss (starting 7-0), until they fell 8-5 in 10 on August 9th against Hub City.

From the Draft...The BlueClaws quickly went from having one member of the 2024 draft class (7th round pick, OF Joel Dragoo) to having eight, adding four members of that class on August 5th – OF John Spikerman (3rd round, Oklahoma), C Kodey Shojinaga (6th round, Kansas), RHP Titan Kennedy-Hayes (11th round, Austin Peay State), and LHP Kevin Warunek (18th round, Longwood), and two more on August 21th – LHP Erik Ritchie (12th round, Charlotte), and LHP Erik Ritchie (19th round, East Carolina)...OF Dante Nori (1th round, 27th overall) joined on August 56th.

Upcoming Pitching Probables (subject to change)

Balk This Way...The BlueClaws in two runs on Wednesday, their MiLB-leading 39th and 40th of the season (Asheville has 39 and Kannapolis has 38)...They are in balking distance of the 48 set by Lynchburg in 2023, the most in minors since at least 2005...Jersey Shore has balked in 11 runs this year, tied for the most in the minors... The BlueClaws had a club record five balks on 5/9 vs Aberdeen, and four each on 6/27 and 6/29 at Brooklyn...This year, only three teams have issued at least four balks in a game, the BlueClaws three times, and Aberdeen on 5/1 at Brooklyn (4)...The BlueClaws single-season record was 20

Comebacks...The BlueClaws erased a 4-0 deficit on May 10th to come back and top Aberdeen 9-8, matching their largest comeback win of the season...Their win on 4/17 at Greensboro was their first of the season in which they trailed after the 8th inning - they had five such wins last year (last one was 7/21/24 at Brooklyn when they tied the game in the 9^{th} inning on an RBI double from Felix Reyes and scored three times in the 10th)...Meanwhile, the BlueClaws lost a 7-0 lead on 4/18 at Greensboro, their largest blown lead since also losing a 7-0 at Greensboro, on 5/31/15, and the fourth time since 2011 (4/19/12 at Hagerstown and 4/22/11 at Asheville) they have lost a seven run lead...The BlueClaws gave up two in the ninth to fall on 5/3 at Hudson Valley, a game they led in the ninth after a Jordan Viars tie-breaking home run put them up 4-3 earlier in

The Deadline - Tait Traded...With Eduardo Tait's trade to Minnesota, this is the fifth straight season the BlueClaws have had a player traded as part of a deadline deal. 2025 – Eduardo Tait to Minnesota (Jhoan Duran)...2024 - George Klassen to the Angels (Carlos Estevez) and William Bergolla to the White Sox (Tanner Banks)...2023 - Hao-Yu Lee to Detroit (Michael Lorenzen)...2022 - Ben Brown to the Cubs (David Robertson), Brown had been promoted to Reading one day before the trade but his last appearance was with the BlueClaws...2021 - Tyler Burch to Baltimore (Freddy Galvis) and Kevin Gowdy to Texas (Kyle Gibson).

Walk-Off This Way...The BlueClaws have three walk-off wins this year - a 9/4 win over Brooklyn when Dante Nori scored on a 10th inning wild pitch, an 8/7 win over Hub City on a 9^{th} inning single

vs Abedeen (Keaton Anthony RBI single), plus July 9th against Hudson Valley (Emaarion Boyd 2-run single) and April 5th against Aberdeen (Opening Night, Boyd scores on wild pitch)...They had eight walk-off wins in 2023, including one in their final regular season home game...On September 3rd, Felix Reyes hit a three-run walk-off home run to cap a four-run BlueClaws ninth inning comeback against Aberdeen.

Snapped at Four...The BlueClaws entered 2025 with four straight winning halves (a streak that has been snapped), both halves in 2023 and 2024, all four halves managed by Greg Brodzinski...The BlueClaws had 10 straight winning halves from 2006 through 2010, all 10 halves in that five year stretch, a streak snapped when they went 33-35 in the first half of the

New to ShoreTown...Of the 31 players on the BlueClaws Break Camp Roster, 13 are making their BlueClaws debuts this season...Of the remaining 18, 14 were with the BlueClaws at the end of the 2024 season (the remaining four were with Reading: RHP Andrew Baker, RHP Tommy McCollum, C Jordan Dissin, IF Zach Arnold)...Baker, McCollum, and Dissin have all been promoted to Reading, though Baker has since returned.

Just Grand...Bryan Rincon's grand slam on 5/20 vs Brooklyn was the BlueClaws first since Jordan Dissin's on June 11, 2024 at Greensboro...The BlueClaws hit three grand slams between 2021 and 2023, but they hit three grand slams in two weeks in 2024 - one by Justin Crawford (May 30th), one by Emaarion Boyd (June 9th), and one by Jordan Dissin (June 11th)...These were the only three grand slams hit by the BlueClaws in 2024.

From The Shore to the Show...127 players have now gone From the Shore, to the Show...Otto Kemp made his Phillies debut on 6/7 and Mick Abel made his Phillies debut on 5/18, the first two to debut this year...Two debuted last year (Ben Brown debuted with the Cubs and Sam Aldegheri debuted with the Angels)...Aldegheri, who was with the BlueClaws from Opening Day 2024 through July 6th, joins Orion Kerkering (2023) as the only players to ever play for the BlueClaws and in the big leagues in the same year (non-rehab).

Bull Back for a Third...Greg Brodzinski returns to manage the BlueClaws in 2025 after leading the BlueClaws to a 73-58 mark in 2023 (and a postseason berth) and a 74-58 mark in 2024...He is the first manager to lead the BlueClaws in three seasons (PJ Forbes in 2004-05, Steve Roadcap in 2007-08, Mickey Morandini in 2012-13, Shawn Williams in 2015-16 and Marty Malloy in 2017-18 are the five managers to manage the BlueClaws for two seasons)...Brodzinski was a coach with Lehigh Valley in 2022 and on the Phillies staff in 2020 and 2021...He is a graduate of Bishop Eustace Prep in Pennsauken,

On the Staff...Ryan Buchter joins the BlueClaws as the pitching coach after spending the last two seasons with Lehigh Valley...Buchter went to Highland Regional High School in Blackwood, New Jersey...Matt Snyder is the hitting coach in his first year in the organization - he was the Assistant Hitting Coordinator for the Marlins last year and in their organization as a coach since 2020... Orlando Munoz returns to the BlueClaws as the Bench Coach... 2021-22 BlueClaws C Herbert Iser makes his coaching debut as the Development Coach...Iser played in the Phillies system from 2019 through 2023 and played collegiately at Dallas Baptist.
