Double Feature (Again and Again and Again and Again and Again) – For the fifth time already this season the Worcester Red Sox will play a make-up doubleheader today when they take on the Durham Bulls (AAA-Tampa Bay) in a twin bill beginning at 4:05 pm at Polar Park. Both 7-inning games are live on NESN+ and can be heard on NASH 98.9 FM and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network. Doubleheaders have become somewhat normal for the WooSox as these will be games #47 & 48 of the season and 10 of those will have occurred during doubleheaders (21% of Sox games this season).

Thanks a (Two) Million – The Worcester Red Sox will go over the 2 Million mark in attendance in their 4+ year history at some point during today's doubleheader. The WooSox have drawn a total of 1,996,491 fans to Polar Park since the ballpark opened on May 11, 2021 (to a Covid-restricted capacity of 2,377). Fan number 3,509 today/tonight will be the 2,000,000th fan in WooSox history.

Double Your Pleasure - Worcester is 2-1-1 in their first four twin bills this season...two sweeps, swept once, and split another. They split a doubleheader at home vs. Columbus on April 9; swept a doubleheader in Rochester on April 17; swept Syracuse at Polar Park on April 23; and were swept by the Mets later in that series on April 27. For what it's worth...the WooSox played ten doubleheaders all of last season (going 0-2-8 in those...no sweeps, twice swept, and 8 splits). The Worcester club-record for most twin bills in a season is 11 in 2023.

Double Duty – The WooSox went almost 22 months (and 13 tries) between sweeping a doubleheader, but they did so twice in a little over a week last month. On April 17 in Rochester, Worcester earned their first doubleheader sweep since June 29, 2023 (in Buffalo) when they swept the Red Wings by 8-0 and 4-3 scores (the latter in 8-innings). Then, on April 23 here at Polar Park vs. Syracuse, the WooSox turned the trick again with a pair of 5-4 victories to sweep the Mets. As mentioned above, Worcester is 2-1-1 in their four doubleheaders thus far this season after going 0-2-8 in their 10 twin bills last year. The WooSox went 5-2-4 in their franchise-high 11 doubleheaders in 2023 and they played seven doubleheaders during each of the 2021 and 2022 seasons going 1-2-4 both those years.

Weather or Not - Yesterday marked the fifth home postponement already this season (the others on Saturday, March 29; Tuesday, April 8; Saturday, April 12 – which was cancelled; and Saturday, April 26). Worcester has had just one road game postponed this year on April 16 in Rochester, NY due to snow. The WooSox club-record for most home games either postponed or cancelled is six coming during their abbreviated inaugural 2021 season (that began in May that year). Last year, Worcester had five home postponements as well as five in 2023. Worcester had only two home postponements during all of 2022.

This Series – The WooSox won the opener of this 6-game series on Tuesday night, 8-2 thanks to a strong start from Brian Van Belle – 7 IP, 1 R and a towering 3-run HR from newcomer Jhostynxon Garcia in the 8th-inning to break open a close game. The Sox appeared poised to make it two in a row on Wednesday after a Trayce Thompson go-ahead solo HR in the bottom of the 8th-inning, but former WooSox 3B Jamie Westbrook homered in the top of the 9th to tie the game and Durham SS Carson Williams snuck a 3-run HR just over the LF fence in the top of the 10th-inning to give the Bulls a 7-4 win. The clubs were washed-out on Thursday morning thanks to a rare May Nor'easter, so they play a make-up doubleheader today at 4:05 pm. The 6-game series continues and concludes with single games on Saturday at 4:05 pm and Sunday at 1:05 pm in what will be Worcester's final home game in the month of May.

What Have You Done For Me Lately – The WooSox are 4-4 in their last 8 games following a 4-game losing streak (May 8-11). Over a longer stretch they have lost 15 of their last 23 games since April 25 after winning 10 of their previous 11 games from April 13-24. Worcester – even at one victory apiece in this current 6-game set vs. Durham - is 2-4-2 in their first eight series played this season...two wins, four losses, and two splits.

Trying to Get Even Again - Worcester is 22-24 overall. They have been exactly at the .500 mark on 10 different occasions already this year. The Sox have been 1-1, 2-2, 3-3, 8-8, 9-9, 14-14, 16-16, 18-18, 20-20, and 21-21. The WooSox were a season-low 4-games below .500 (4-8) on April 11, but quickly turned things around to reach a season-high of 5-games above .500 on April 24 (14-9).

Work From Home – Worcester is 10-12 at home compared to 12-12 on the road and their 22-24 record overall puts them in 5th-place and a season-high 10½ GB of 1st-place Lehigh Valley. Durham is 29-18 and in 2nd-place in the IL East 4 GB of the front-running IronPigs who have a 33-14 record.

Closing in on 50 - After Sunday's series finale, the WooSox will have played 50 of their (adjusted) 74 first half games (or 67.5%). The first half (originally 75 games) ends after the June 22nd game here at home vs. Buffalo while the 2nd half begins with everyone at 0-0 on June 24 (the Sox start at Scranton/Wilkes-Barre).

Month to Month - Sox hitters are batting .238 in May (142-for-596) with 20 HR & 86 runs scored while Sox pitchers are 8-10 with a 5.11 ERA this month (88 ER in 155 IP) with 27 HRA and 96 runs allowed. Worcester hit .273 in April with 25 HR & 145 runs scored and WooSox pitchers were 13-13 in April with a 4.74 ERA along with 26 HRA and 128 runs given up.

Sox Standouts

-OF **Roman Anthony** had his 10-game hitting streak snapped on Wednesday (going 0-for-3 with 2 walks), but has still hit in 10 of his last 11 games (15-for-40, .375). He has reached base safely in 16 of his last 26 plate appearances (5 games) with 7 hits and 9 walks. Roman has also been on base in 18 games in a row and has reached in 35 of his last 36 games (since April 6). Among those 35 games on base he has had 29 games with at least one hit and the other 6 games with at least one walk. He has hit safely in 21 of his last 25 games (31-for-87, .356) with 23 walks, 5 2B, 1 3B, 2 HR, 6 RBI, and 20 runs scored.

-INF/OF **Nate Eaton** had his 9-game hitting streak end on May 7. He has hit in 17 of 22 at a .293 clip (24-for-82) with 8 doubles, 2 HR & 12 RBI.

-INF/OF **Vaughn Grissom** has a 6-game hitting streak (8-for-27, .296).

-1B **Nathan Hickey** has 4 HR & 14 RBI in his last 11 games. He did not get a hit on May 17 in Buffalo but reached base all five plate appearances on 4 walks and 1 HBP.

-INF **Marcelo Mayer** had his streak of reaching base safely end at 22 straight games on May 11 (it began on April 15) and has now reached in 28 of his last 31 games. In his last 28 games he is batting .303 (33-for-109) with 5 2B, 1 3B, 6 HR, 31 RBI, and 20 runs scored. Marcelo is 5th in all of professional baseball with 41 RBI on the season behind only Jac Caglianone, formerly of Northwest Arkansas (AA-KC) and recently promoted to Triple-A Omaha, and Aaron Judge who both have 44 RBI followed by Seiya Suzuki of the Cubs who has 43 RBI and Wilmer Flores of the Giants with 42 RBI. Mayer is tied for 11th in the IL with 8 HR.

-OF **Trayce Thompson** has hit in 7 straight (12-for-30, .400) with 1 2B, 3 HR, 7 RBI, and 7 runs scored.

Among the League Leaders – Several WooSox are among the Top Ten in the International League in a variety of categories.

Roman Anthony is 1st in walks (39), 3rd in runs (33), 5th in hits (49), 4th in OBP (.449), 8th in OPS (.959), and 6th in total bases (79).

Nate Eaton is 9th in hits (47), 4th in doubles (15), 5th in extra-base hits (19), T10th in total bases (74), and T8th in runs (29).

Vaughn Grissom is tied for 8th in runs scored (29).

Marcelo Mayer is 1st in RBI (41), tied for 11th in HR (8), and 8th in total bases (75).

Isaiah Campbell is tied for 5th in saves (4).

RHP **Robert Stock** is tied for 6th in SO (51) and 6th in lowest batting average against (.199).

Where They Rank – Worcester comes into play with a .260 Team Batting average (5th in the league), they are tied for 4th in runs scored (246), 5th in hits (395), 2nd in doubles (89), 9th in HR (49), 4th in on-base pct. (.354), 6th in slugging pct. (.422), 5th in OPS (.776), and 3rd in LOB (350). On the pitching side, the WooSox are 12th with their 4.76 ERA.

Durham has the 2nd best ERA in the league at 3.30 (Nashville is at 3.12) while the Bulls are 11th in the IL in batting (.248).

Home Run Derby – The WooSox have maximized their use of the long-ball all season as 28 of their total 49 HR on the year have come with runners on base. Worcester batters have belted (21) solo HR, (16) 2-run homers, (7) 3-run blasts & (5) grand slams.

Bulls Run at Polar Park – Worcester has yet to play in Durham, North Carolina since the WooSox were born in 2021. This week marks the Bulls third trip to Polar Park in Worcester, however. Worcester leads the all-time series, 8 games to 6. From August 2-7 of the 2022 season, the clubs split a 6-game series here at Polar Park. Current WooSox RHP Cooper Criswell started one game and appeared in relief in another for Durham during that series back in 2022. And just over a year ago from April 16-21 of 2024, the WooSox took 4 of 6 from Durham here in Worcester. The Sox won the first three games by 7-4, 6-2, and 12-5 scores; the Bulls swept a make-up doubleheader on April 20 by 12-2 & 4-3 scores; and Worcester won the series outright with a 7-1 victory on April 21.

Durham Dynasty - As winners of the 2nd half of the International League in 2023, the Durham Bulls qualified for the International League playoffs for an amazing 19th time in their first 25 Triple-A seasons. (They did not make the post-season last year). Durham did lose their playoff series to eventual 2023 Triple-A Champion Norfolk last September, 2 games to 1 as the Bulls fell short in their attempt to repeat and defend their 2022 International League Championship. The Durham Bulls became the Triple-A affiliate of the Tampa Bay Rays in 1998 when they joined the International League. From 1998 – 2019 (the last year of the former International League), Durham won nine (9) Governors' Cup Championships as champions of the IL post-season. Those titles came in 1998, 1999, 2000, 2002, 2003 (over the PawSox), 2009, 2013, 2017, and 2018. Pawtucket did defeat Durham in a thrilling 5-game Governors' Cup Finals series in 2014. In 2021 in the new Triple-A East, Durham had the best record of any of the 20-teams in the league winning the Triple-A East South Division with their 86-44 overall record. And in 2022 the Bulls won their 10th Governor's Cup before falling one game short of another title in September of 2023.

Streaks Appeal – The WooSox have had a pair of season-high 5-game winning streaks (from April 13-18 and again from April 20-24). Worcester had a season-high 5-game losing streak from April 25-30 and they have also had a 4-game losing streak (May 8-11) and a 3-game losing skid (April 5-9).

Movin' Along in May After April is History – Worcester is scheduled to play 27 games in the 31 days this May and they are 8-9 this month. The WooSox finished 13-13 in April – a month that also included one cold-out, two snow-outs, and one rain-out among three postponements and one cancellation (3 at home & 1 on the road). And the Sox went 1-1 in March that also had one rain-out (at home).

A Winning Tradition – The 2024 Worcester Red Sox went 79-71 to post a winning season for the fourth time in as many years of existence and for the third year in a row under manager Chad Tracy. Trace is only the second Red Sox Triple-A manager to ever post three consecutive winning seasons. Darrell Johnson did so from 1971-73 (the first two years when the Red Sox Triple-A club was in Louisville before moving to Pawtucket in 1973). Worcester finished 35-40 during the first half last year but then improved to 44-31 in the second half. Overall the 2024 WooSox went 40-34 at home and 39-37 on the road. The 2021 WooSox had a 74-54 record during their abbreviated inaugural season, the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73, and the 2023 club posted a 79-68 mark.

2024 WooSox Batters Led the Way – Worcester led all 20 International League clubs in a host of team offensive categories last season. The WooSox led the league with 869 runs scored (Scranton/Wilkes-Barre was next with 846 runs scored). The Sox also led the IL with 786 walks (Toledo was a distant 2nd with 676 walks). Worcester paced the league by a wide margin with an impressive .369 on-base pct. as the WooSox were the only team in the IL with an OBP of over .359 (Scranton/WB was 2nd at .358). Furthermore, Worcester had the 2nd best OPS in the league at .795 (Columbus was 1st at .804).

2024 Rankings – Worcester finished 5th in the IL in team batting with a .259 average. On the pitching side, the Sox were 10th in team ERA (4.84). Sox pitchers allowed the 2nd fewest HR in the league (141 HRA while Nashville had 139 HRA). Defensively, the WooSox were 11th with a .979 field pct. (107 errors in 5126 total chances).

Players Aplenty - The 2024 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records (previously set by the 2023 WooSox) as they made 281 player transactions during the 2024 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used 84 different players in 2024 (37 position players and 47 pitchers) to better the mark of 79 players in 2023. Ironically, the 2021 WooSox broke a long-standing Red Sox Triple-A record when they used 72 different players to beat the 1995 Pawtucket Red Sox (during a strike year when replacement players were used for the first month+ of that season) and the 2006 PawSox who each employed 70 different players. When Chad Tracy made his Worcester debut in 2022, the WooSox quickly set a new record using 75 different players (that was immediately topped first in 2023 and again in 2024).

WooSox to BoSox - The WooSox sent 28 different players to Boston during the 2024 season (not counting rehab players). A total of 22 different players were promoted from Double-A Portland to Triple-A Worcester last season.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS (AA) GAME RECAP – The Portland Sea Dogs (22-17) doubled-up Reading, 6-3 yesterday in Maine. Richard Fitts, on Boston’s injured list with a pectoral strain, made his first rehab start – 3 IP, 4 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 2 SO. Richard was slated to start for the WooSox yesterday, but his outing was wisely moved to Maine instead to avoid the miserable Worcester weather. The win went to Christopher Troye (3-0) who tossed 2.1 scoreless innings of relief. Blaze Jordan ripped RBI singles in the 1st and 3rd-innings both times scoring Mikey Romero (double and reached on error). Down 3-2 in the bottom of the 7th, Romero walked with the bases loaded to tie the game, Ahbram Liendo followed with a walk to make it 4-3, and a subsequent balk plated Portland’s 5th run.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – The WooSox today added reliever **Nick Burdi** following his option from Boston on Tuesday. To make room for Burdi, the WooSox placed reliever **Jose Adames** on the development list. And the WooSox today released INF **Alex Binelas** who was placed on the development list on May 20. Binelas was batting .257 with 2 HR & 6 RBI in 13 games this season.

Burdi tossed 2.1 scoreless innings over a pair of relief appearances for Boston last weekend. The right-hander has also pitched in 13 games for Worcester, going 3-0 with 3 saves, a 0.54 ERA (1 ER/16.2 IP), 25 strikeouts, and a 0.84 WHIP. Selected by the Minnesota Twins in the second round of the 2014 First-Year Player Draft, the Illinois native owns a 5.93 ERA (18 ER/27.1 IP) in 33 career Major League games with the Pittsburgh Pirates (2018-20), Chicago Cubs (2023), New York Yankees (2024), and Red Sox (2025).

The Boston Red Sox yesterday acquired first baseman/outfielder **Ryan Noda** from the Los Angeles Angels, in exchange for cash considerations, and optioned him to Worcester. He is expected to be added to the WooSox roster tomorrow.

Noda, 29, has played in 164 career Major League games with the Athletics (2023-24), making 130 starts at first base and one in right field. The left-handed hitter has batted .212 (106-for-501) with a .344 on-base percentage, 26 doubles, one triple, 17 home runs, and 58 RBI. Selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 15th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft, the Illinois native has played in 38 games for Triple-A Salt Lake this season, batting .148 (17-for-115) with 4 HR & 8 RBI along a .364 on-base percentage while making 13 starts in right field, eight at first base, four in left field, and four in center field. Ryan has 122 HR in 698 career Minor League games and 17 HR in 164 Major League games.

Worcester currently has four players on their 7-day injured list...pitchers Shane Drohan, Hobie Harris, Jacob Webb and Josh Winckowski and three players on the development list...RHP Jose Adames, catcher Enderso Lira, and OF Phillip Sikes.

Since the start of the season (8 weeks) the WooSox have sent RHP Hunter Dobbins (three times), RHP Robert Stock, C Blake Sabol, RHP Josh Winckowski, RHP Michael Fulmer, NF Nick Sogard (twice), RHP Luis Guerrero, RHP Cooper Criswell (three times), INF Abraham Toro, and RHP Nick Burdi to Boston; although Stock, Winckowski, Sabol, Guerrero, and Burdi are all back with Worcester. The Red Sox also recalled rehabbers RHP Lucas Giolito & C Connor Wong from Worcester. Furthermore, Fulmer elected to become a free agent and signed with the Cubs following his outright assignment, RHP Quinn Priester was traded, and OF Corey Rosier and C Enderso Lira were sent to Double-A Portland (although Rosier and Lira have rejoined the WooSox).
