Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Indianapolis Indians play the first of a six-game series tonight at First Horizon Park. The Nashville Sounds lost their third straight in a rain-shortened game against the Charlotte Knights 3-2 Sunday Afternoon at Truist Field. Right-hander Zack Godley gets the ball for the Sounds against right-hander James Marvel for the Indians.

Zack Godley: 31-year-old Zack Godley makes his fifth start for the Sounds tonight in the series opener. He has compiled a 3-0 record and a 0.90 ERA in 20.0 IP. In his last start on June 2 at Charlotte, the right-hander pitched 7.0 innings and gave up 2 runs (1 earned) on one hit and struck out 4. The South Carolina native was designated for assignment by Milwaukee on May 10 and joined Nashville on May 12. The Brewers signed Godley on March 19. He has pitched in the big leagues for Milwaukee, Boston, Arizona and Toronto. He was drafted by the Chicago Cubs in the 10th round of the 2013 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Tennessee.

James Marvel: 27-year-old James Marvel gets the ball for the Indians tonight. The right-hander is 0-1 with a 4.07 ERA (11 ER/24.1 IP) in five games (all starts) with Indianapolis in 2021. He was named Pittsburgh's Minor League Pitcher-of-the-Year in 2019 after going 16-5 with a 2.94 ERA (53 ER/162.1 IP) in 28 total starts between Double-A Altoona and Indianapolis. He led all of minor league baseball in wins in 2019 and led all Pirates farmhands in wins, strikeouts and ERA (minimum 100.0 IP). Marvel was named to the 2019 Eastern League's Mid-Season All-Star team. He was selected by Pittsburgh in the 36th round of the 2015 First-Year Player Draft.

2021 Standings: The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 14, Second: 5, Third: 1, Fourth: 13, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

Cemented in History: The Sounds came one win short of setting a franchise record in consecutive wins on June 4. They won 15 straight games (5/18-6/3) for the third time in franchise history (July 29-August 14, 2018 and June 2-20, 1999).

Tale of Two Stories: During Nashville's 15-game winning streak, the team hit .259 (132-for-509) with 36 doubles, 31 home runs and 81 walks. The Sounds scored 106 runs and averaged 7.07 runs per game. During the current 3-game skid, the Sounds are batting .122 (10-for-82) and are averaging less than a run per game.

Turn Around for Wilson: Weston Wilson has reached base safely in 10 consecutive games (5/27-present), batting .294 with 8 runs, 3 doubles, 4 home runs, 5 RBI and 11 BB during the streak. Prior to beginning the streak, Wilson was batting .176.

Honors for Ashby: Aaron Ashby was named Triple-A East Pitcher of the Week for his play from 5/31-6/6. He joins Tyrone Taylor as Sounds players to win a weekly league honor. The left-hander's lone start was 6/4 at Charlotte, he struck out a season-high 11 batters and allowed 1 unearned run on 2 hits in 7.0 IP. Ashby was tagged with a tough-luck loss in Nashville's 1-0 setback. Ashby is among Triple-A East League leaders in batting average against (3rd, .170), strikeouts (5th, 39) and ERA (7th, 2.93).

Hiura is Back: Keston Hiura was optioned from Milwaukee to Nashville on 6/7 after being recalled on 5/24. Since being recalled, Hiura hit .069 (2-for-29) with 16 K in 11 games with Milwaukee. He hit safely in 7 of his 9 games with the Sounds, batting .438 with 8 R, 6 doubles, 3 home runs, 7 RBI and 4 BB.

Sounds at a Glance: The Sounds have won 18 of their last 23 games and 21 of their last 27. At 9-3, Nashville has the second-best home record in the Triple-A East, trailing only Omaha (15-3). The Sounds have won their last 6 games at First Horizon Park.

Grass Is Always Greener: Sounds infielder Zach Green is among Triple-A East League leaders in several offensive categories, including RBI (1st, 27), home runs (T-1st, 9), slugging percentage (9th, .578) and extra-base hits (T-9th, 13).

How Sweet It Is: Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,048-1,929. The 2,048 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

The Milwaukee Era: A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.
