ABOUT LAST NIGHT... The Sea Dogs mustered just five hits as they fell 5-2 to the Fightin Phils on Friday night, going 0-for-9 with runners in scoring position. **Justin Gonzales** collected his second multi-hit game in his first three Double-A games, ripping a single and a triple throughout the night. He scored both of the Sea Dogs' runs. **Roman Anthony** was one-for-three with a double and a sacrifice fly. **Ronald Rosario** and **Yoelin Cespedes** also recorded hits.

THE ROMAN REPORT Roman Anthony joined the Sea Dogs on a Major League rehab assignment Tuesday. He went two-for-two at the plate with a single, a home run, and a pair of walks. After a scheduled night off on Wednesday, Anthony was back in the lineup Thursday night in left field. He went 0-for-3 at the plate with a pair of groundouts and a strikeout before leaving the game in the seventh inning. On Friday night, playing as designated hitter, Anthony went one-for-three with a double, a sacrifice fly, and a pair of strikeouts.

ALL FOR EXTRA BASES The Sea Dogs have been one of the best extra-base hitting teams in Double-A. Last night, three of their five hits were for extra bases, with two doubles and one triple. Portland has the second most home runs in the Eastern League (153), and the fourth most doubles (204). The Sea Dogs' 376 total extra-base hits is third best in the Eastern League and fifth best out of 30 Double-A teams.

WELCOME, JUSTIN Outfielder **Justin Gonzales** was assigned to Portland on Tuesday, recording a pair of singles in his debut. Wednesday night, he led off the game with his first Double-A home run. Last night, Gonzales recorded his second multi-hit game with a single and a triple, scoring both of the Sea Dogs' runs. According to MLB Pipeline, Gonzales is the Red Sox' No. 2 prospect, and the No. 79 overall prospect in MLB. Across 89 games for High-A Greenville, Gonzales batted .271 with 12 doubles, two triples, 17 home runs, 58 RBI and 56 walks.

FULL HOUSE The Sea Dogs have played 23 sell outs this season, with 12 since the All-Star break (July 17). They have sold out seven of the ten games played during their current double homestand.

PLAYOFF PICTURE After last night's loss and wins from Binghamton and Somerset, the Sea Dogs are tied for second place in the Northeast Division standings with both Binghamton and Somerset. The Fightin Phils are in first place, 2.5 games up on all three teams. In their last ten games, Binghamton is 8-2 and Somerset is 7-3, while Portland is 3-7.

THE BEAN SUPPAHS Tonight, the Sea Dogs take the field as the Maine Bean Suppahs. Bean suppers or suppahs for Mainers is a centuries-old New England tradition. Typically served on Saturday nights, bean suppahs have been a source for feeding and gathering communities at churches and grange halls throughout the state. A Maine bean suppah commonly includes baked beans served with franks...red snappers for Mainers, and brown bread. The legendary competitive eater Joey Chestnut will face three Mainers in a pre-game bean suppah eating contest.

THIS DAY IN SEA DOGS HISTORY August 22, 2010 – Portland scores a 7-6 walk-off win in 10-innings against the Trenton Thunder. The game-winning run was scored on a throwing error by left fielder Damon Sublett on **Jose Iglesias'** single.

ON THE MOUND LHP **Michael Sansone** (3-3, 5.89 ERA) is set for his twelfth appearance and fifth start for Portland this season. He has also made nine appearances and eight starts for Triple-A Worcester. In his last outing against Binghamton on August 15, Sansone allowed five runs on six hits including two home runs. He walked three batters and struck out six in 4.0 innings pitched. Sansone signed with Boston in April 2024 after two years as a non-drafted free agent in the Rays organization and with the Yolo High Wheelers of the Pioneer League. He played college ball at Fairfield.

Leading the Sea Dogs

Acting Manager - Kyle Sasala

Kyle Sasala enters his third season on the Portland staff after a highly successful tenure at Grove City College, where he served as Associate Head Coach from 2016 to 2023. During his time with the Wolverines, Sasala played a key role in the program's rise, highlighted by a school-record 30-win season in 2023 and a 16–4 conference mark. He also helped guide Grove City to a then-record 28 victories in 2019 alongside head coach Matt Royer. Sasala later stepped in as interim head coach for the Eastern College Athletic Conference Division III Championship Tournament, leading the Wolverines to a runner-up finish.

Pitching Coach - Juan Rivera

Juan Rivera also returns to the Sea Dogs coaching staff as a pitching coach for his second season. In 2025, Rivera helped guide a Portland pitching staff that recorded 1,435 strikeouts, the second-most in the Eastern League, while posting a 3.65 team ERA, the fourth-best mark in the league. Rivera spent the previous three seasons as the Salem Red Sox' pitching coach, where he led the staff to a 3.61 ERA, the fourth-best in Single-A. A graduate of Eastern Nazarene College, Rivera has been part of the Boston Red Sox organization since 2022, serving as a Development Coach with Salem before joining the Sea Dogs coaching staff.

Hitting Coach - Trevor Burmeister

Trevor Burmeister joins the Sea Dogs coaching staff as hitting coach after spending the previous five seasons in the Colorado Rockies organization. Burmeister began his coaching career immediately following his collegiate playing career at the University of Wisconsin–La Crosse, where he spent two seasons on the coaching staff. He then served one season at the University of Minnesota Duluth, where the offense ranked third nationally in NCAA Division II with a .352 team batting average and second in the nation with 102 home runs. Burmeister later returned to his alma mater, Madison College (NJCAA), spending three seasons under head coach Mike Davenport. During his time there, he was named the 2019 NJCAA Assistant Coach of the Year by the American Baseball Coaches Association and Baseball America.

Defensive Coach - Kyle Schmidt

Kyle Schmidt joins the Sea Dogs as defensive coach after spending two years with the Red Sox' Single-A affiliate, the Salem Ridge Yaks. Originally from Smithville, TX, Kyle attended the University of Richmond and became a starting catcher for the Spider Baseball Team. Following his 2019 season, Kyle was drafted in the 33rd Round of the 1st Year Player Draft by the Minnesota Twins. Kyle voluntarily retired after the 2023 season. During his playing career, Kyle played at every Minor League level while also being involved in multiple Major League Spring Trainings.

Athletic Trainer - Kelsey Branstetter

Kelsey Branstetter joins the staff as Portland's Athletic Trainer, her first year with the Sea Dogs and second season in the Red Sox organization. She spent last season as the Athletic Trainer for the Greenville Drive (High-A) and served in the same role for Triple-A Louisville (Cincinnati Reds) from 2023-2024. Branstetter graduated from Middle Tennessee State University, where she played four years of soccer. Following her undergraduate studies, Branstetter obtained a master's degree from Wichita State University.

Strength and Conditioning Coach - Jonah Mondloch

Strength and Conditioning Coach Jonah Mondloch returns to the staff for his second season in Portland and his third year in the Red Sox organization. He previously served as an Assistant Rehab Strength and Conditioning Coach, where he supported the strength and conditioning programs for players returning to the field. In that role, he collaborated closely with Major League sports performance and on-field staff to ensure the highest level of care for injured athletes.
