

The Bowie Baysox finished their two-week homestand with a 7-6 victory over the Erie SeaWolves. Despite allowing a two-run home run to Gage Workman in the top of the second, Baysox right-handed starter Chayce McDermott was stellar on the afternoon, only allowing those two runs through five frames and striking out nine to match a Double-A career high. Offensivley, Bowie was powered by a pair of long balls. In the bottom of the fourth, Gilbert Lara hit a three-run home run to not only put the Baysox on the board, but give them a 3-2 lead. Billy Cook would follow suit with his own three-run home run in the fifth to give Bowie a 6-2 lead. The SeaWolves would launch a pair of solo shots off Baysox left-hander Easton Lucas, with Cesar Prieto doubling home a run for Bowie in between. The Baysox would lead 7-4 going into the ninth, before the SeaWolves plated two runs on a sacrifice fly and a single. With the tying run in scoring position with two outs, Bowie brought on right-hander Wandisson Charles to strike out Luis Santana to end the game and pick up his first save of the season.

### TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Harrisburg Senators enter the series at a record of 11-15. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, the Senators currently occupy 5th place in the Southwest division and are 2.5 games ahead of the Baysox. Harrisburg has a .211 team average and has hit the fewest home runs (15) of any team in the Eastern League, but has also allowed the third-fewest (16) to go along with a 4.13 staff ERA. The Senators' roster is highlighted by the No. 2 Nationals prospect and No. 30 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, Robert Hassell III, who recently returned from the injured list. He is one of five Top 30 Nationals prospects on the Harrisburg roster, including right-handed pitchers Jackson Rutledge (No. 11 WSH) and Gerrardo Carrillo (No. 28 WSH), along with left-hander Mitchell Parker (No. 24 WSH) and catcher Drew Millas (No. 30 WSH). The Senators are led by first-year manager Delino DeShields, who has prior coaching and managment experience through the various levels of the Reds' organization.

## TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

The Senators look to send out right-hander Jackson Rutledge for the series opener. The No. 11 prospect in the Nationals' system, Rutledge has had an effective first five starts of the season, yielding 11 earned runs off 23 hits in 27.2 innings, but has accumulated 27 strikeouts as well. Rutledge has gone six innings and thrown over 80 pitches in each of his past three starts, and is coming off his best performance of the season last time out on Wednesday, delivering six shutout frames with four hits and seven strikeouts against New Hampshire. Last season, Rutledge spent his time exclusively with Single-A Fredericksburg after seeing his development stymied by shoulder and blister injuries in 2021. He pitched to a 4.90 ERA through 97.1 innings as a starter, allowing 106 hits to 99 strikeouts, particularly struggling against right-handed hitters, who batted .311 against him. Rutledge was the 17th overall pick by the Nationals in the 2019 draft out of San Jacinto JC. His arsenal features a 2-seam and 4-seam fastball in the mid-90s, alongside a mid-80s slider, upper-80s changeup, in addition to a curveball.

## HOLD UP, LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook broke out of his slump in a big way last week against the Erie SeaWolves. After a brutal 1-for-35 stretch, Cook finished last week going 9-for-19 with three home runs, a double, and 11 RBI in the final five games of the series. Cook now has hits in five straight, with three multi-hit and four multi-RBI games in his last five, along with home runs in three of his last five games. By comparison, Cook only had six hits in his first 61 at-bats of 2023, with only a single extra-base hit and RBI.

## **HESTON IS BESTON**

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. Kjerstad launched his sevnth and eighth home runs of the season last week, putting him back atop the League leaderboards in that category. Beyond the home runs, the Orioles' No. 5 prospect has also demonstrated plenty offensive consistency - leading the Eastern League in slugging percentage (.656) and sitting second in OPS (1.044) among qualifiers, while also standing second in extra-base hits (14) and total bases (59). Kjerstad has the most home runs and extra-base hits throughout the Orioles' system, while his OPS is third best and his slugging percentage is second. Kjerstad's standout start to the season earned him Orioles Minor League Player of the Month honors for April.

### HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with his 36 hits and a .364 batting average. Prieto is currently riding a six-game hitting streak, while registering multiple hits in his past three starts and 11 multi-hit contests in his first 25 games of 2023. His 11-game hitting streak last month is the second-longest in the Eastern League this season and is also the longest streak for any Orioles minor leaguer. Prieto's average leads Baltimore minor leaguers and hits total is second best on the Orioles' farm.

## A RAMON RENAISSANCE

In his third season with Bowie after bouncing around the Orioles' organization, C Ramon Rodriguez has finally found some stability with the Baysox. Rodriguez has multiple hits in three of his last four games for the first time since September of 2021. Rodriguez has reached base a total of seven times in the past two games, with five hits, three of which were doubles. Rodriguez was accquired by the Orioles in March of 2021, and has played across three different levels each of the past two seasons, never playing more than 56 games at any level in a season.

### **COACHING STAFF**

### Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 14-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the heim of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles sys-tem. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlanic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Battimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron. Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's Japking career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson as Japked two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann
