Today marks game #1 of the 2022 season, the first game of a 3-game roadtrip, and the 1st game of a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons. These two teams played 24 times during the 2019 regular season, with the Whitecaps going 10-14. The Whitecaps are a Detroit Tigers affiliate in their 28th season in professional baseball, while Great Lakes is in their 13th year of affiliation with the Los Angeles Dodgers. The last playoff meeting with Great Lakes came in the 2018 Midwest League Eastern Division Quarterfinals, with the Whitecaps sweeping a two-game series. ***This marks the first game for both teams of the 2022 regular season.***

Up Next: The 'Caps return home to open the 2022 season at LMCU Ballpark beginning with opening night against the Lansing Lugnuts on Tuesday, April 12 at 6:35pm to open a six-game series and first batch of 24 games to be played against the Lugnuts this season.

STORYLINES AND HEADLINES

CHASING 2,000: The West Michigan Whitecaps are just 1 win away from their 2,000th win in team history. West Michigan's all-time record is 1,999-1,721.

GETTING RIV-AIR-A: Whitecaps infielder Rey Rivera broke the all-time Whitecaps franchise record for homers with the 26th of his career after a solo blast during the Whitecaps 2-0 win over Lake County on August 14, and finished the season with 34 homers for his Whitecaps career. Rivera's final homer of the season on its final day was his 21st of the season, tying him with 2004 Whitecaps infielder Kelly Hunt for the single-season record.

BACK TO THE MIDWEST: The Midwest League, founded in 1947 and temporarily ceased in 2020, has returned as the name of the 12-team league, replacing the infamous High-A Central moniker given to the league for one season.

PROSPECTS APLENTY: The Whitecaps hold 8 of the Top 30 Detroit Tigers prospects, via MLB Pipeline. Players include....

HEALTH REPORT: The 'Caps injured list holds four players in pitchers Marco Jimenez, Chris Mauloni and Cleiverth Perez, along with infielder Rey Rivera.

ALUMNI REPORT: 2021 Whitecaps infielder Spencer Torkelson, less than a year removed from being assigned to play for West Michigan, has made the Detroit Tigers opening day roster. In one of the fastest ascensions the Tigers have seen through their system in recent years, Torkelson is slated to be the everyday first baseman in Detroit going forward. The former first overall pick of the 2020 MLB Draft, Torkelson hit .312 with a .440 on-base percentage and 5 homers with 28 RBI in 29 games during his six-week stint with the 'Caps last season.

Guzman pitched briefly when the Whitecaps were a Low-A team back in 2019, even pitching in the home opener and tossing five scoreless innings in the team's first win of the season. Guzman, a converted infielder-turned-pitcher, ended the season on the injured list. Once the Tigers #10 prospect by Baseball Prospectus, and the teams' #13 prospect by the Detroit News entering the 2019 season, Guzman tossed a solid 2021 season in Lakeland and is now playing his first season at the High-A level.

LAST START: N/A

2021: Pitched effectively and got better as the season went on, going 7-9 with a 4.65 ERA in 23 games. In September, Guzman posted a 3-0 record with a 1.00 ERA in 4 games and 18 innings.

2019: Was effective in seven starts, going 2-2 with a 2.73 ERA in 33 innings, but had trouble pitching deep into starts, as well as with control. Prior to a scheduled start in May, Guzman suffered a shoulder injury and was sent to the injured list, where he spent the remainder of the season.

2018: Was one of the few reliable starters for Connecticut, going 3-4 with a 3.86 ERA in 51.1 innings, while keeping up his strikeout-per-inning totals at 52 K's in 51.1 IP. Made his first appearance in Lakeland being three years younger than the average player in the Florida State League

MORE: Fastball usually sits between 92-97mph, with a high-upside changeup, and has been known to throw it with more confidence than most other pitchers of his age group (20-21). Working on developing the slider, which will likely determine whether he can stay in a rotation.
