THE SURGE - The Wichita Wind Surge continue the weekend series tonight in North Little Rock against the Travelers with a chance to win three consecutive games for the first time since April 17-19. Wichita has dropped 32 of its last 41 games. The team has dropped eight consecutive series and have the fewest wins in all of Minor League Baseball (Asheville, 31 wins). Wichita is 17-46 since April 30th.

VS TRAVELERS - The Wind Surge visit the Seattle Mariners affiliate for the first time since the first road series of the year in April. The Travs took five of six in the most recent series at Equity Bank Park in Early May. In 2025 Wichita went 12-6 vs the Travelers and 3-3 on the road. The all-time series has Wichita leading 63 - 46.

OVER 'N OUT - Wichita is second in the Texas League with 120 long balls this season 21 of 25 players have hit HR and 6 players with double digit bombs this year. 75 of the 120 homers have been solo shots..

ON THE BUMP: Riley Quick makes his AA debut tonight for the Surge. He is the Twins' #10 prospect pitching in his first professional season after being drafted in the supplemental first round in the 2025 draft (#36 overall) out of the University of Alabama. The right hander has a whopping 74 strikeouts across 49.1 innings pitched so far this season.

SURGE ROLL PAST TRAVS 10-4: The Wichita Wind Surge (5-14) opened the post All-Star Break slate with a 10-4 victory over the Arkansas Travelers (9-10) on Friday night at Dickey-Stephens Park. Wichita's offense erupted for 16 hits, including six multi-hit performances and three players with three-hit games. Billy Amick reached base five times, going 2-for-3 with three RBIs and two walks. Brandon Winokur recorded his first three-hit game at the Double-A level, while Jay Thomason also collected three hits and drove in two runs. Kyle DeBarge added three RBIs, tying his Double-A career high with a bases-clearing double in the opening inning. Ty Langenberg made his first appearance for Wichita in more than two months before turning the game over to the bullpen. Sam Armstrong earned the win after allowing one run over three innings of relief, while Hunter Gregory, Darren Bowen and Kyle Bischoff each added scoreless outings to secure the victory.

LIGHT UP THE KENDLE- Caden Kendle has recorded a hit in each of his first seven Double-A games, has driven in seven runs through his first seven games with Wichita and has recorded four multi-hit games. He was named Twins Minor League Co-Player of the week last week.

A FINE PLACE TO VACATION- Jaime Ferrer extended his on-base streak to 12 games yesterday and picked up his third homer of the year in Sundays contest.

HOUSTON, WE HAVE LIFT OFF - Marek Houston hitting streak ended at nine games, but has reached base in 13 consecutive. He has had a hit in 14 of his first 18 Double-A games. He was named Twins Minor League Co-Player of the week last week.

ICT NOTES -The Wind Surge are 12-13 in day games, the 25 day games lead the league. Wichita has dropped seven straight Saturday games, 4-10 on the day..... 27 of the 30 wins the team have scored five or more runs. The Surge are 7-11 in one run games. Wichita is last in the league in batting average, 4th in walks, 1st HBP, and 9th in ERA, allowed most hits in all of AA. The team has 73 errors, 9th in the league.

RUNNING WITH THE BULLS - Garrett Spain extended his on-base streak to 14 games, has a seven game hit streak. Recorded his 17th multi-hit game of the season. He hit his 14th home run of the season on Wednesday and recorded multi-hit performances in three consecutive games and matched a season high with three hits.

AMICKS AMBUSH - Billy Amick on-base streak ended at nine games. He leads the team with 20 home runs and 64 RBI. 20 HR is fourth in Texas League and 64 RBI is fifth in the league. He leads the Twins Organization in HR and RBI.

PHILADELPHIA FREEDOM- Andrew Cosetti hit five home runs in last homestand and matched his career high with 14 home runs in a season. In June he hit 6HR, 20RBI and a .379 OBP. Has hit two grand slams this season, the first two of his career and has belted a pair of multi-homer games. Since May 7, he is batting .251, (39x160) with all 14 homers, 36RBI, and 39 BB and leads the team in all categories.

HARVEST TIME- The Surge have added seven players from Cedar Rapids since June 12. Twins number 10 prospect Riley Quick added on Saturday from Cedar Rapids. The team added #21 Khadim Diaw last month, #15 Brandon Winokur last week and #7 prospect Marek Houston at the start of the second half. Rankings are according to *MLB Pipeline*. Quick made his professional debut in April and this season has made 14 starts, and in 49.1 innings has punched out 74 batters while walking 26 and is 0-2 with a 3.47 ERA.

MID SUMMER CLASSIC - Former Wind Surge pitcher Louie Varland was named to the American League All Star team. It's the second Wind Surge alumni to play as Yennier Cano pitched in the 2023 game.

THE PEN- Wichita relievers have pitched a league leading 439 innings so far this season. An average of 5 plus innings per game. The teams pen has earned the win in 28 of the 30 team wins, the bullpen has a 6.16 ERA last in TL, starters are at 5.00. Surge starters are 2-29, fewest wins in the league.

STRIKE EM OUT! - The Wind Surge have 35 games this season recording double-digit strikeouts, punched out ten on Friday. The team has 773 K's eighth most in the league. The Wind Surge hitters lead the league with 878K's.
