Leading Off

Tonight, Reading begins its second six-game series at Portland this season. Portland won the first series four games to two. Tyler Phillips gets the start for Reading, opposite CJ Liu.

Looking Back

Reading and Hartford split after the Yard Goats overpowered the R-Phils in a 14-5 win. Reading pitching matched a season-high in runs, hits and home runs allowed in a game. Also, R-Phils pitchers combined to allow three homers in an inning, which was a season high and also matched a season-high for hits allowed in an inning. Johan Rojas and Carlos De La Curz hit back-to-back homers in the sixth inning, the third time the R-Phils have went back-to-back this year. Nick Podkul also added a home run in the sixth inning of the loss.

On Base at a Historic Rate

Carlos De La Cruz matched Cameron Perkins 33-game on-base streak that was set in 2014. Dating back to 2010, it is the longest on-base streak by an R-Phil. De La Cruz will pass Perkins if he gets on base tonight. The streak dates back to May 12 and he is hitting .303 on it.

Johan Rojas is establishing himself as one of the best two-way players in Minor League Baseball. Entering last week, Rojas led all Minor League center fielders with 14 defensive runs saved. He also ranks third in the Eastern League with a .313 average, also leading the team.

Consistent Kroon

Matthew Kroon has established himself as one of the most consistent bats in the Reading lineup. After missing all, but two games, in 2022 with an injury, Kroon has played in nearly every game this season and is second on the team with a .311 average; which also ranks fourth in the Eastern League. Kroon also has played third base and all the outfield positions this season.

Bullpen Blues

Reading's bullpen combined to throw six innings and allow seven-earned runs on Sunday. In wins this season, Reading's bullpen has a 2.31 ERA, but in losses it's a 7.56 ERA.

Around the Organization

The Phillies begin a series with Atlanta tonight after sweeping Oakland and going 6-1 on a west-coast road trip. Lehigh Valley begins a series at Worcester after a 2-4 week against Toledo, sitting 34-33 on the year. Jersey Shore, who is 33-29, is back at ShoreTown Ballpark to welcome Rome for a series this week. Finally, Clearwater takes the brief trip to begin a series at Dunedin this week.

This Day in Baseballtown History

June 20, 2013: At Reading, Maikel Franco makes his Fightin Phils debut and goes 2-for-4 in a 5-2 loss to Portland. It would start an 11game hit streak for Franco.

Shipping up to Portland

This is the second series of the season between Reading and Portland, with both at Hadlock Field. The Sea Dogs sit in second in the Northeast Division, 1.5 games back of Somerset. It will be a neck-and-neck battle with the Patriots this week for the first-half crown. Last week, Portland went 3-3 at Binghamton last week and next week, they begin the second half at New Hampshire.

On the Mound for Portland

Righty CJ Liu will get the ball tonight for Portland. It is Liu's 13th start of the season and he is 4-4 with a 4.18 ERA. Over 56 innings, Liu has allowed 54 hits and 29 walks, with 62 strikeouts. He last threw at Binghamton on Thursday, suffering the loss while giving up three runs on eight hits in 3.1 innings pitched. Liu was signed as an internation free agent out of Taiwan in 2019. He split 2022 between Greenville and Portland, combining to go 4-11 with a 6.06 ERA over 26 games and 22 starts. In 2021 he split time between Salem and the Red Sox rookie level team.
