Tonight, Reading and Binghamton continue this week's series with game four. Binghamton holds the 2-1 series edge.

#### Looking to Bounce Back

Reading fell to Binghamton 6-3 last night as Mick ABel suffered the loss after allowing four-earned runs over 4.2 innings. Abel did have eight struckouts, but also issued four walks. Carlos De La Cruz stayed hot with two hits and Cam Cannon went deep again, which was his third homer in the last two days. Tommy McCollum tossed a 1-2-3 frame in his double-A debut.

#### Skipper Milestone Watch

Reading Manager Al Pedrique sits just seven wins shy of 1,000 in his Major/Minor League managerial career. Pedrique's win totals with each organization have been: Royals (102), Astros (158), Diamondbacks (225), Yankees (394), Miami (75) and Phillies (39).

#### Cannon Bal

Cam Cannon hit his third home run in two days with a solo shot last night. Cannon's two home runs Wednesday marked the first multi-homer game of his career and fifth by an R-Phil this season.

#### Remember Me for Centuries

Carlos De La Cruz was the first player in the Eastern League to register 100 hits on the season. His 105 hits rank first in the league, with 98 from Johan Rojas being the second most. Jonathan Rodriqguez from akron is the next closest with 93 hits on the season. De La Cruz also has the following league ranks: HR (3rd), RBI (T8th), SLG (7th), OPS (8th), 2B (5th), XBH (3rd), TB (1st), R (3rd).

#### On the Move

Tyler Phillips, Brett Schulze and Braden Zarbnisky earned promotions to triple-A Lehigh Valley prior to Wednesday night's game. Phillips has had a solid season after missing all of 2022 with Tommy John Surgery, while Schulze and Zarbnisky have proven to be strong out of the bullpen in a variety of situations. Reading also added Tommy McCollum from Jersey Shore, who had a strong year with the high-A club prior to his promotion.

### Around the Organization

The Phillies were off last night and begin a three-game series at Pittsburgh tonight. Lehigh Valley was suspended due to rain with the game tied at two and it will resume tonight. Jersey Shore earned a ten-inning win over Averdeen 4-3 as both Nick Ward and Hao Yu Lee had three hits. Clearwater had a 7-0 win over Jupiter last night to improve to 19-9 in the second half and 63-30 overall. Jonathan Petit got the start and went four shutout frames for the Threshers, while Emaarion Boyds had two hits and two stolen bases to raise his total to 46 swiped bags on the season so far.

#### This Day in Baseballtown History

**July 28, 1999:** At Reading, Jimmy Rollins slugs his second home run of the night, a two-out, two-run shot in the bottom of the 9th to lift Reading past Bowie, 7-5. It is the third time in the '99 season that the Phils beat the Baysox with a walk-off homer.

#### Ponies Rumbling into Town

Binghamton enters today with a 9-14 record in the second half and 44-48 overall record in 2023. Binghamton split a six-game series last week at home against Erie, posting wins on Wednesday, Thursday and Sunday. After this week, the Rumble Ponies return home for a six-game series against New Hampshire. Brandon McIlwain leads the team offensively with a .263 average and 45 RBI entering today. Binghamton ranks last in the Eastern League with a .226 average and is 10th with a 4.42 ERA. Luke Ritter is currently with triple-A Syracuse after a strong start with Binghamton.

#### Ponies Pitcher

Righty Luis Moreno gets the start tonight for Binghamton. He rejoined Binghamton on July 25 after a brief stint with triple-A Syracuse (7/20-25). Moreno made one appearence for Syracuse on July 21, starting and going 3.1 innings in a no-decisions against Buffalo. His last outing for Binghamton came on July 16 against Somerset (L, 3.1 IP, 5 H, 6 ER, 3 BB, 1 SO). He pitched at Reading on June 9 and went seven innings, scattering seven hits, one run and had seven strikeouts. Overall in 2023, Moreno is 6-4 with a 4.88 ERA over 17 games/15 starts (79.1 IP, 45 BB, 77 SO). Moreno split 2022 between St. Luice and Brookyln, posting a 2.84 ERA over 25 appearences. He signed with the Mets as an International Free Agent in 2019 out of the Dominican Republic.
