### INDY BITS

**ABOUT SUNDAY:** Trey Sweeney launched a go-ahead two-run home run in the ninth inning as the Toledo Mud Hens put up five unanswered runs to defeat the Indianapolis Indians, 10-8, in the series finale at Victory Field on Sunday afternoon. The Indians opened the game with a four-run first courtesy of three consecutive RBI doubles from Seth Beer, Billy Cook and Jason Delay. Toledo responded in the following frame with three runs off an RBI double from Stephen Scott and run-scoring groundout from Andrew Navigato. The back-and-forth contest continued from there, with Indy and Toledo exchanging two-run homers by Billy Cook and Spencer Torkelson in the third and fifth innings, respectively. Indianapolis tacked on another pair in the sixth with an RBI single from Andrés Alvarez and a sacrifice fly from Jack Suwinski. With Indianapolis leading 8-5 after six innings, the Mud Hens mounted a comeback for the victory. The first four batters of the seventh inning reached base safely, with Torkelson doubling home a pair to spark the rally. A run-scoring double play then knotted the game at eight runs apiece before Sweeney's two-out homer off Connor Sadzeck in the ninth.

**BILLY'S MILLION DOLLAR COOK-OFF:** Billy Cook, who was traded to Pittsburgh from Baltimore in exchange for RHP Patrick Reilly on July 30, has jumped out to a hot start in two games with the Indians. On Sunday, he went 3-for-5 with two runs, a double, home run and three RBI to lead the team. He has now roped two extra-base hits in each of his last four games, the longest such streak in the International League since at least 2015. In those games, Cook is hitting .588 (10-for-17) with six runs, six doubles, one triple, one home run and six RBI between Triple-A Norfolk and Indianapolis. He began the season with the Tides and hit .279 (73-for-262) with 42 runs, 15 doubles, three triples, 11 home runs and 43 RBI in 70 games between two stints. He also appeared in 15 games with Double-A Bowie and hit .255 (13-for-51) with 10 runs, four extra-base hits and 10 RBI.

**START SPREADING THE NEWS:** Playing in his fifth game with Indianapolis after being traded to Pittsburgh from Boston on July 29 in exchange for RHP Quinn Priester, Nick Yorke extended his hit streak to nine games on Sunday with a single. He is currently rated as Pittsburgh's No. 5 prospect by MLB Pipeline and has six hits, three extra-base hits and four RBI in his short time with Indy. During his nine-game hit streak between Triple-A Worcester and Indianapolis since July 25, he is hitting .313 (10-for-32) with five runs, five extra-base hits and six RBI. In total, he's hitting .313 (51-for-163) with 36 runs, 11 doubles, six home runs and 23 RBI in 43 games.

**EDDIE FOR THREE:** Edward Olivares tied his season high with three hits on Sunday vs. Toledo. It was his third three-hit game of the season and first since June 24 at Cincinnati. Five of his 13 games with Indianapolis since being optioned and joining the Indians lineup on July 12 have been multi-hit performances, following four two-hit games in six contests from July 14-30. The three hits snapped an 0-for-6 showing in his previous two games against the Mud Hens.

**BEER KEEPS FLOWING:** Seth Beer extended his on-base streak to 14 games since July 6 while going 1-for-4 with two runs, a double, two RBI and a walk on Sunday afternoon. The streak began with a 10-game hit streak through July 27, and in those 14 total games he owns a .365 batting average (19-for-52) with 12 runs, four doubles, five home runs and 17 RBI. After starting off slow in his first handful of games with Indianapolis, he has hit safely in 18 of his last 21 since June 27 (2) at Rochester. In total, he is hitting .313 (30-for-96) with 18 runs, 13 extra-base hits and 26 RBI in 26 games.

**HANK ON BASE:** After having his career-high 11-game hitting streak since July 13 snapped on Thursday night, Henry Davis picked up where he left off with a massive two-run home run in the sixth inning on Friday and a double on Saturday. Since his streak began, he is hitting .351 (20-for-57) with 12 runs, four doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, a .403 on-base percentage and 1.035 OPS. He homered in consecutive games from July 13-14 and then capped his series at Iowa with a pinch-hit home run on July 28. He now has 12 total home runs this season between Indy (11) and Pittsburgh (1) after launching a career-high 19 homers between Double-A Altoona (10), Indianapolis (2) and Pittsburgh (7) in 117 total games last season.

**TONIGHT:** The Indians kick off a six-game series at First Horizon Park, home of the Milwaukee Brewers-affiliated Nashville Sounds, tonight at 7:35 PM ET. The Indians have gone 9-13 vs. the Sounds since 2021, going 2-4 last year during one series at Victory Field. Kicking off the series for the Indians is RHP Aaron Shortridge (1-0, 1.50) in his fourth appearance (third start) with the Indians this season. He has never faced Nashville. Countering for the Sounds will be LHP DL Hall (0-1, 2.96), who tossed 5.0 two-run innings in his last start on July 31. It will be his first career start against Indianapolis in three Triple-A seasons.

**SHORTY SHOWS OUT:** Aaron Shortridge made his third appearance (second start) with the Indians last Tuesday and allowed just one run over 4.0 innings, exiting with a 2-1 lead. The performance followed his first Triple-A relief appearance on July 25, where he tossed 4.0 one-run innings (unearned) with just one hit, one walk and six strikeouts while piggybacking with Mike Burrows to earn his first win since Sept. 20, 2023, vs. Rochester in his Triple-A debut. In three games (two starts) with Indy this season, he has allowed three runs (two earned) with 12 strikeouts in 12.0 innings. The right-hander began the season on the injured list and began a minor league rehab assignment with the FCL Pirates on June 17. He made five appearances (four starts) between the FCL and High-A Bradenton, going 0-1 with a 1.76 ERA (3er/15.1ip), 25 strikeouts, 0.91 WHIP and .222 batting average against.

**THIS DATE IN 1988:** Randy Johnson had 15 Triple-A starts under his belt when he took the mound for the Indians at Nashville during a playoff push. Johnson and Pat Pacillo tossed the last no-hitter in the Bush Stadium era when they threw a combined 8.0 hitless innings. Johnson was tagged for the loss as he gave up the game's only earned run in the first inning, despite not giving up a hit. The future Hall of Famer tossed 7.0 innings, issued two walks and struck out eight. Nashville countered with a no-hitter of their own the next day.

### 2024 Highlights

- » Began the season with Double-A Altoona and hit .281 (56-for-199) with 19 runs, 13 extra-base hits and 21 RBI before being promoted to Indianapolis on June 18.
