Today: The Lansing Lugnuts look for a third straight win in a matinee against the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers, the second game of a six-game series and the only meetings of the year between the two teams. Wednesday starter Yunior Tur makes his second start of the season, opposed by Wisconsin right-hander Manuel Rodriguez.

Last Night: Lugnuts 6, Timber Rattlers 2. Casey Yamauchi delivered a two-run single in a four-run first inning, Nate Nankil added a two-run single late, and the Lugnuts cruised to victory behind their first quality start of the year, a 6 2/3-inning, three-hit, six-K gem from Jake Garland.

On Deck: The Nuts and Rattlers play a night game tomorrow, a doubleheader on Friday and a matinee on Saturday to wrap up the series, then the Lugnuts head home to play 12 games in 13 days at Jackson Field: April 22-27 vs. Fort Wayne, April 29-May 4 vs. Lake County.

Best in the League: The Lugnuts' offense ranks 1st in the Midwest League in batting average (.263), base hits (89), walks (66), fewest strikeouts (69) and on-base percentage (.396)... though the Nuts also rank 1st in runners left on base (108).

Matchup to Watch: The Lugnuts' patient offense drew seven more walks yesterday, though Wisconsin's pitching staff still leads the league in fewest walks (34, which is 45 fewer than the erratic Great Lakes Loons' staff).

An Observation: The Nuts are the only team in the league without a balk.

Lansing League Leaders: Center fielder Rodney Green, Jr. is tied for the league lead in home runs (4), tied for 2nd in runs scored (9) and tied for 3rd with total bases (23). Fellow outfielders Jared Dickey is tied for 3rd in walks (11) and Nate Nankil is tied for 4th in RBIs (9).

Casey at the Bat: Second baseman Casey Yamauchi, who was literally named by his parents for the title character in Ernest Lawrence Thayer's poem, has driven in exactly two runs in each of his last three games. After opening 2-for-12 (.167) in his first four games, Yamauchi is hitting 6-for-17 (.353) in his last four games.

Soder Pop: First baseman Tyler Soderstrom (2022 in Lansing) crushed two three-run homers against the White Sox yesterday, giving him an MLB-leading eight home runs. Soderstrom is 3rd in the Majors in slugging (.734) and total bases (47) and 5th in OPS (1.137).

Prospecting: The Nuts boast the A's second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman Tommy White (40th overall), southpaw starter Gage Jump (73rd), shortstop Joshua Kuroda-Grauer (75th) and outfielder Rodney Green, Jr. (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 14 and Green is No. 20. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old Steven Echavarria, rated No. 12, and outfielder Nate Nankil, who is No. 30.

DK at the Helm: The 19th manager in Lugnuts history is Darryl Kennedy, entering his second year in the A's organization. Kennedy distinguished himself as a catcher at Manatee Community College before starring at the University of North Florida and was named an NCAA All-American in 1991 en route to North Florida's Hall of Fame, inducted in 2017. Kennedy played in the Minor Leagues for seven seasons, including parts of four seasons in Triple-A. Following his 1997 retirement, he immediately began managing, leading the Gulf Coast League Rangers to the 1998 GCL Championship. Kennedy won a second title with the GCL Rangers in 2000, moving on to stops in the Florida State League, Northwest League and Texas League through 2006. Upon joining the Royals' organization, Kennedy managed in the Appalachian League, Carolina League, Pioneer League, Arizona League and Texas League through 2020. He served as bench coach for the KBO's Hanwha Eagles from 2021 through 2023 before joining the A's as Double-A Midland's assistant hitting coach in 2024.

APRIL 16TH IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2015: Rowdy Tellez's 16th-inning two-run home run of Great Lakes first-baseman-turned-emergency-pitcher Josmar Cordero gave the Lugnuts 4-2 win at Dow Diamond. The game lasted four hours and 51 minutes and ended one inning shy of tying the franchise record for most innings played. **2024:** A thriller in Lake County! Euribiel Ángeles, Jonny Butler and Brayan Buelvas all homered, but it was Colby Halter's infield single with the bases loaded in the ninth inning that pushed the Nuts past the Captains, 5-4, in the opener of a six-game series at Classic Auto Group Park. The Lugnuts entered the game with only two home runs in their first nine games, but shortstop Ángeles' first homer of the year tied the game at 1-1 in the fifth, left fielder Butler's first homer of the year gave the Nuts a 2-1 lead in the sixth, and center fielder Buelvas's first homer of the year broke a 2-2 tie in the eighth. But Lake County's C.J. Kayfus knotted the score with a two-run double off Dylan Hall in the bottom of the eighth, setting the stage for ninth-inning drama. Danny Bautista, Jr. led off the top of the ninth with a strikeout against Magnus Ellerts, but reached base when strike three eluded catcher Johnny Tincher for a wild pitch. After an Ángeles flout, Jose Mujica accidentally punched a single into right field with a check-swing. CJ Rodriguez earned a walk to load the bases. Ellerts struck out Jose Escorche for the second out. That brought up Halter, who hit a slow roller to the right of the mound. Ellerts attempted to field it, only to have the ball tick off his glove, as Bautista, Jr. raced home with the game-deciding run.

In a Nutshell: Making his Lugnuts debut this season... only native Cuban on the team... noted for mid-90s fastball / split-changeup combo... one of three pitchers on the roster standing at least 6-foot-6 or taller (Kyle Robinson, Jake Pfennigs)... looking to become second ever Major Leaguer named Yunior (joining Santo Domingo native Yunior Marte, who spent last season in the Phillies' pen).

Hometown Hero: Though born in La Habana, Yunior grew up in Santiago de Cuba, which also produced such notable Major Leaguers as Bárbaro Garbey, Adeiny Hechavarría and Orestes Destrade.

Dominating in Cuba: Yunior pitched three seasons for Avispas ("Wasps") de Santiago de Cuba in the Cuban National Series, from 2018-2021... in 2019-20, at age 19, posted remarkable line: 0.00 ERA, 9 saves, 22 scoreless innings, 8 hits, 16 walks (two intentional) and 24 strikeouts... teammate: Oscar Colás, now with the White Sox... followed up in 2020-21: 2.11 ERA, league-leading 14 saves, 38 1/3 IP, 32 hits, 10 runs (9 earned), 25 walks, 45 strikeouts.

2023 - Joining the A's: Signed with the Athletics for \$100,000 three days before the end of the international signing period on May 8, 2023... made his pro debut with the Arizona Complex A's on June 5, allowing two runs (one earned) in four innings with no walks and four strikeouts against D-Backs Black... moved up to Stockton on June 17 and finished the season with 19 appearances out of the Ports' pen.

2024 - Back to Stockton: Pitched in relief for the Ports on Opening Day, April 5, and pitched a scoreless sixth before allowing three runs in the seventh inning, suffering the loss in a 7-2 defeat to Modesto... worked as a piggybacker throughout the year, alternating starts and relief appearances... tossed career five innings on four different occasions, allowing one run or fewer each time; curiously, these gems happened once a month - April 18, May 23, June 15, July 31... struck out seven Lake Elsinore Ports in three hitless innings, August 6, setting pro high... vs. lefties: .285/.356/.468, 6 HR... vs. righties: .255/.339/.418... base-stealers went 14-for-16 in successful attempts.
