AMARILLO SOD POODLES (30-31) vs. SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (27-34)

LHP AVERY SHORT (2-1, 3.02 ERA) vs. LHP MASON MOLINA (1-2, 3.31 ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: The Cardinals finish up their series vs. Amarillo (Arizona) with a Sunday night game at Route 66 Stadium ... its the final game of a 6-game series ... Springfield will look to salvage a series split after Amarillo won 3 of the first 5 games in the series ... LHP Mason Molina starts opposite LHP Avery Short.

MOLINA'S MOUND: LHP Mason Molina makes his 13th start of the season and his 3rd vs. the Sod Poodles on Sunday ... in his last start on 6/9 vs. Amarillo he allowed 4 runs (3 ER) on 4 hits over 6.0 innings with 9 strikeouts and 1 walk ... has pitched 6.0 innings in back-to-back starts, tying his season high ... is the only Springfield starter to record two 6.0-inning starts ... his 9 strikeouts on Tuesday set a new season-high and tied his career-high ... leads the Springfield staff and ranks 4th in the Texas League with a 3.31 ERA and a 1.16 WHIP ... in his 2 starts vs. Amarillo has allowed 4 ER in 11.0 IP with 15 strikeouts.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Amarillo took control of the series with a 6-2 win over the Cards on Saturday night ... IF Trey Paige went 2x3 with a double and his 4th home run of the season ... IF Jon Jon Gazdar hit a solo home run to give him homers in back-to-back games ... Amarillo scored 3 runs in the 1st inning and never trailed for the remainder of the game ... RHP Chen-Wei Lin allowed 4 runs (3 ER) over 4.0 innings with 5 strikeouts and 5 walks ... Springfield pitching totaled 9 walks and 8 hits allowed in the game ... RHP Domenic Picone threw 2.2 perfect innings of relief with 5 strikeouts.

WHY THE SOD FACE?: Tonight's game is the 9th of 12 in the season series with Amarillo and the 6th of 9 between the clubs in the Ozarks ... the Cardinals swept a 3-game series at Hodgetown to open up the season and are 5-3 against Amarillo ... Amarillo returns to Route 66 Stadium for a 3-game series, July 17-19.

MAKE IT RAIN: C Rainiel Rodriguez hit two homers in Thursday's game marking the 19-year-old's first HRs at Route 66 Stadium and his first multi-homer game in Double-A ... dating back to 2005 the only hitters younger than Rodriguez to hit 2+ HR in a Double-A game are Vladimir Guerrero Jr., Fernando Tatis Jr., and Konnor Griffin.

DAK ATTACK: IF Dakota Harris hit his 7th home run of the season in Friday's game and his 2nd of the series ... 5 of his 7 home runs have come against Amarillo, including 2 grand slams ... he is hitting .414 (12x29) against the Sod Poodles this season.

NEWEST CARDS: OF Jose Cordoba his 2 home runs in Friday's game and has now hit 4 homers in his first 7 games with Springfield ... IF Miguel Villarreal is hitting .344 (11x34) and has hit safely in 8 of 9 games since joining the Cardinals.
