Road Trip Part Two

The Fightin Phils continue their season-long two week road trip at the Portland Sea Dogs on Tuesday night. It is the first-of-18 matchups between the teams this season and first-of-12 at Hadlock Field in Portland. The Sea Dogs make the trip to Reading from June 9-14 and then the Fightin Phils return to Portland from Aug. 18-23. Reading dropped the 2025 season-series to Portland 13-8, which included a 3-9 record on the road at Hadlock Field.

Doubleheader Split and a Series Win

After a historic 20-0 win on Saturday, the Fightin Phils were blanked 2-0 by New Hampshire in the front end of Sunday's doubleheader. Kyle Brnovich tossed another strong start, allowing one-earned run over 5.1 innings, with three strikeouts. But, Reading was held to just two hits offensive, with one being a double from Raylin Heredia (16) and the other a single from Bryson Ware. The Fightin Phils responded in game two, with a 5-3 victory. It was a bullpen game, with the R-Phils sending five pitchers to the mound: Christian McGowan (0 ER, 1.0 IP), Saul Teran (W, 1 ER, 2.0 IP), Andrew Baker (0 ER, 2.0 IP), Evan Gates (0 ER, 1.0 IP) and Alex McFarlane (0 ER, 1.0 IP). Reading posted just five hits offensively, which featured doubles from Austin Murr (10) and Bryson Ware (6). Aroon Escobar drove in two runs, while Heredia, Ware and Nikau Pouaka-Gregory each had a RBI in the win to claim a 4-3 series victory over New Hampshire.

Winning Ways Continue

With their win in game two on Sunday, the Fightin Phils claimed their third series win of the season, which puts them just one shy of their total series win total from 2025. Also, the Fightin Phils returned to above the .500 mark, which is the latest point in the season they have been over .500 since the conclusion of the playoff-bound 2019 season. Reading has yet to be two-or-more games over .500 this season and can change that with a win on Tuesday night at Portland. Also, entering play on Tuesday, the Fightin Phils sit just three games back of New Hampshire for first place in the Northeast Division standings, as the playoff race is heating up with five series remaining in the first half of the season, which ends on Sunday, June 21.

A Historic Win on Saturday

The Fightin Phils 20-0 win over New Hampshire on Saturday marked the largest run differential in a game for Reading since at least as far back as the 1992 season. It also marked Reading's third 20+ run game since at least 2005 and first since July 8, 2016, a 21-4 win vs Bowie. The other 20+ run instance for the R-Phils was July 2, 2007, a 21-4 win vs New Britain. The game also featured fourth-career four-hit game for Alex Binelas (LAST: 6/11/24, with Portland at Reading) and the third-career four-hit game for Austin Murr (LAST: 6/13/25, with West Michigan at Lansing). Murr also secured his second-career four-run game and the first four-hit/four-run game of his career. Bryan Rincon also had his second-career four-run game, with the other coming on May 1 of this year at Hartford.

Wood You Believe It

The Philadelphia Phillies announced on Monday that No. 2 Prospect, and top-pitching prospect, Gage Wood was promoted to Reading from Clearwater (A), skipping Jersey Shore (A+). Wood joins the Fightin Phils after just nine-career starts with Clearwater. This season, Wood is 0-2, with a 3.42 ERA (10 ER, 26.1 IP) over eight starts. He has sent down 40 batters on stikes, good for a 13.67 SO/9.0 IP mark, which was 7th in the FSL amongst pitchers with at least 20.0 IP. At the time of his promotion, Wood was seventh in the Florida State League in strikeouts. Wood joins the Fightin Phils less than one year following his selection in the first round (26th overall) by the Phillies out of Arkansas, where he pitched from 2023-25. His college career was highlighted by a no-hitter in the 2025 College World Series against Murray State. Wood is currently scheduled to make his Double-A debut on Friday at Portland.

Pitching Powers

The Fightin Phils pitching staff continued their recent strong stretch with another good week at New Hampshire. Over their last nine games (dating back to May 8), Reading leads the Eastern League with a 2.81 ERA (24 ER, 77.0 IP). On the season, the R-Phils team 4.48 ERA ranks third in the Eastern League, which comes after finishing last in the league with a 4.58 ERA in 2025. Reading's pitching staff has also showcased some of the best control in the league as well, issuing the fewest walks in the league at 122, which is well behind the second fewest, Portland with 145. Strong fielding has helped out the Fightin Phils pitching staff, as Reading enters play on Tuesday with a .980 fielding percentage, which is tied for best in the Eastern League.

Get a Lead and Hold It

Getting to the seventh inning with a lead has been a strong indicator of success for the Fightin Phils this season. When leading after seven innings this season, Reading is 16-0 and they are 15-0 when holding a lead following the eighth inning this year.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 19, 1967: At Pawtucket, Robin Roberts' scoreless streak ends after 22 innings, but the Phillies still hold off the Indians for a 4-3 win. Jim Campbell's 3-run homer capped a 4-run 3rd that gave Roberts just enough cushion to go the distance for his third straight victory.

From the Cats to the Dogs

Portland enters play today with a 17-21 record, which is fifth in the Northeast Division, 2.5 games behind Reading, and 5.5 games behind first place New Hampshire. The Sea Dogs most recently split a six-game series at Hartford, and following this week, will be back on the road to face Binghamton. Portland's roster features 10 of the Red Sox top-30 prospects: Franklin Arias (1), Anthony Eyanson (2), John Holobetz (12), Hayden Mullins (14), Miguel Bleis (15), Jedixson Paez (19), Gage Ziehl (20), Nelly Taylor (21), Johanfran Garcia (26) and Yordanny Monegro (28).

Portland Pitcher

Righty, and Red Sox No. 2 prospect, Anthony Eyanson makes his second Double-A start tonight for Portland. He allowed one run on three hits over four innings, with four strikeouts, in his debut on May 10 at Hartford. 2026 is his first pro season and Eyanson began the year with Greenville (A+), posting a 0.44 ERA (1 ER, 20.1 IP) prior to his promotion. Boston drafted Eyanson in the third round of the 2025 draft out of LSU. Eyanson went 12-2, with a 3.25 ERA over 20 appearances (18 starts) with LSU in 2025. He began his collegiate career at UC San Diego in the 2023-24 and spent the summer of 2024 with Cotuit in the Cape Cod Baseball League. The 21-year old is originally from Long Beach, California.
