Tonight's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Ryan Webb** to the mound tonight, as they look to win three straight for the first time since a 5G win streak from 3/28-4/2. Buffalo will counter with RHP **Austin Voth**. Columbus is 11-4 (.733) versus right handers this year. Voth has pitched against the Clippers twice in his career (2016, '18 with Syracuse), going 0-1 with a 4.15ERA (13.0IP, 9H, 6R, 6ER, 2BB, 10K).

vs. the Bisons

Since 5/23/09, the Clippers are 41-65 (.387) against the Bisons, despite being outscored by only 37 runs (477-514). Among those 106G, the Clippers are 19-22 (.463) in games decided by at least four runs and 22-43 (.338) in games decided by three or fewer. In Buffalo, the Clippers have been victorious in 11 of the last 15G, winning both series played since the expansion of the International League.

Let's Do That

Last night's wire-to-wire victory was only the second for Columbus this season (7-0 win at Worcester on 4/11), as the Clippers became the last team in the IL to have multiple no-trail games. On the year, the Clippers are an IL-best 10-10 (.500) when they find themselves trailing at any point in a game, while turning in a 12-3 (.800) mark when leading at any point (2nd in the IL; Syracuse is 12-2, .857).

Walk to the Front

Columbus drew double digits in the walk column (10) last night for the fourth time this season, moving into a tie for the IL lead with Worcester (131). The Columbus OBP stands at .376 (2nd in the IL, a point behind Louisville), pacing for a franchise record (.375 in 1983). Even with all that traffic on the bases, the Clippers have grounded into the least double plays in the IL (7, **Kody Huff** has 3GIDP).

Under the Radar

Petey Halpin extended his hit streak to 8G last night (.297, 11x37, since 4/12), while reaching base in his 10th straight (.313OBP since 4/10). Halpin has reduced his strikeout rate to 17% (8K in 48PA) over the course of his on base streak, compared to 30% (15K in 50PA) through his first 10G of the season. His run scored last night was the 100th of his Clipper career (t-1st in the IL since debut, 3/28/25).

Double Time

Travis Bazzana doubled again Saturday and now leads the IL in two-baggers (9). He has seven of them since last Sunday, to go along with his first homer since 9/7/25 (86AB between), raising his SLG by 148 points in the last week. Bazzana is still looking for his first multi-RBI game of the year (4x21 with RISP), but he is posting a 1.159OPS with nobody on base, including a pair of triples (leads IL).

Gearing Up

Kahliil Watson snapped a 19AB hitless streak on 4/11, going 3x4 with a triple and a couple bombs (second career 2HR game, 6/18/25 with Akron), and had a quartet of doubles to go along with a homer last week (+271 in SLG over last 8G, had 1XBH in first 12G). Watson walked twice last night (third straight 2BB game) and is now tied for 1st in the IL with 21BB (8th with 27K; only IL batter in top ten of both).

Eye is for Ingle

Cooper Ingle has drawn 20BB in his first 52PA (38%) this season, following a Triple-A debut that saw 21BB in 107PA (20%) last season. Though Ingle has hit only .248 (28x113) in his Columbus career, he has a beefy .459OBP and a +17 differential in the walk to strikeout department (41 to 24). Since his Triple-A debut on 8/13/25, his 41BB are tied with **Travis Bazzana** for most in the IL.

Bounce Back

Stuart Fairchild was 4x27 (.148) in 8G (4/4-4/14) after going 4x4 on 4/3 vs. Indy, but is now 10x21 (.476) in his last 5G (hitless in previous 5G, 0x16). **Milan Tolentino** was 6x33 (.182) in 10G (4/3-4/14) after doubling twice on 4/2 vs. Indy, but he is 10x21 (.476) with 4HR and 10RBI in his last 6G (IL Batter of the Week last week). Tolentino's strikeout rate is down to 23% from 34% last season.

Slump Town

Dom Nunez had a pair of hits last time out (4/17 vs. Iowa), including a decisive 2-run HR, but he is still just 4x24 on the season (7% walk rate, compared to 17% last year). **Dayan Frias** was 0x4 last night and is hitless in 17AB since homering on 4/16 vs. Iowa (3x36 in last 10G; 3x4 in game prior, 4/8). Among 105 IL hitters with at least 70PA, Frias ranks 104th in average, 102nd in OBP and 104th in SLG.

This Date in Clipper History

4/22/1977

Dale Berra drove in **Mike Edwards** with the winning run as Columbus beat Pawtucket 6-5 in the first ever Clippers game in Franklin County Stadium. Berra and Edwards would play important roles for Columbus' first baseball team since 1970, with Berra leading the team with 18HR and Edwards pacing the IL with 62 steals. Edwards' 62 swipes are the 2nd highest single season total in Clipper history (**Otis Nixon**, 94, 1983).

Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,417 to 1,368).

Challenging Times

The Clippers are 28-29 (.491) in pitch reviews, with batters going 16-19 (.457) and pitchers/catchers going 12-10 (.545). They have run out of challenges in 12G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 0-1 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 50-34 when playing past regulation (.595, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 84G to require extra play, 67 have been resolved after one frame (including seven DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 15th in the IL this year (.974), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 12G this season (7-5, .583), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

Good Baseball

Milan Tolentino moved a pair of runners into scoring position with a bunt single on 4/7 at Worcester and those runners came around to tie the game in an eventual win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 84-22 (.792) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 1-1 (.500, blew 7-run lead in loss) mark this season (went 23-2 in 2018).

To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

Manager Profile

Andy Tracy made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 398-416 (.489), 368-370 with Columbus (.499).
