Catcher **CJ Rodriguez** drilled an RBI double to left-center to break a 2-2 tie in the seventh inning, **Max Muncy** followed with an important RBI single for insurance, and the Nuts captured their first victory of the series in the third consecutive one-run result between Lansing and Peoria.

This is the Way: Earlier today, 2018 Lugnuts infielder **Samad Taylor** was called up to the Kansas City Royals from Triple-A Omaha. When Taylor makes his MLB debut, he will be the 178th Nut all-time to reach the Majors and the fifth this year.

The Fear of Loss is a Path to the Dark Side: Ten of the Nuts' last 14 games have been decided by one run (Lansing is 5-5 in those contests.)

It's a Trap! When the opposition puts runners aboard, that simply sets up Lansing for success. The Lugnuts have turned 11 double plays in their last five games, one more yesterday, and lead the Midwest League with 55 for the year. The Nuts also lead the league with a mere 41 errors.

The Kessel Run: Earlier today, infielder **Joshwan Wright** was promoted to Double-A Midland while pitcher **Stevie Emanuels** was transferred to Lansing. Emanuels, drafted in the fifth round in 2020 from Washington, pitched for the Lugnuts each of the last two years.

In My Experience, There's No Such Thing as Luck: Among the Midwest League leaders, closer **Tyler Baum** is tied for third in the MWL with six saves; outfielder **Jonny Butler** is second in the league with five triples; catcher **Daniel Susac** is fifth with 57 hits and seventh with a .286 average; and outfielder **Junior Pérez** is tied for eighth with 15 steals.

Great, Kid. Don't Get Cocky: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 22-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C **Tyler Soderstrom**.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2015: Jason Leblebician homered twice and Richard Ureña and Chris Carlson homered once apiece, as the Lugnuts destroyed Bowling Green, 13-3, at Cooley Law School Stadium. With five games left in the first half, the Lugs broke a first-place tie and took a one-game lead on the Hot Rods. Anthony Alford went 4-for-5 with a double and a triple, and Starlyn Surlie pitched six shutout innings.

2017: Bo Bichette singled, doubled, homered and singled. Then he singled, doubled, struck out and singled again. Eight at-bats, seven hits, five runs batted in, all in a double-header's worth of excitement at South Bend, swept by the Lugnuts 8-5 and 6-1. In the process, Bichette brought his batting average up to an even .400. Game 1 included a wacky five-run sixth inning that brought the Nuts from 5-3 down, taking the lead on a fluke Nick Sinay RBI single – Sinay did not swing the bat, but Jared Cheek's fastball smacked off the knob and rebounded into play, bringing in Christian Williams with the tie-breaking run.

In a Nutshell: Makes fifth Lugnuts start after opening season with Single-A Stockton... debuted with a gem on May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win over the Captains... one of ten starting pitchers for Lansing this season... @JakeGarland25.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg).

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... only two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.
