ABOUT LAST TIME... The Vancouver Canadians were defeated by the Hillsboro Hops (Diamondbacks) 7-4 Tuesday night at Ron Tonkin Field.

The Hops took the lead for good with four runs in the top of the fourth. Starter Adam Kloffenstein (L, 7-7) was perfect for his first three innings before a hit batter on his first pitch of the fourth put the first runner on base for Hillsboro. A two-run homer two pitches later spoiled the no-hitter and the shutout then the Baby Snakes struck for two more runs on four hits to lead 4-0. Of his six innings of work, Kloffenstein was perfect in four of them and didn't allow a run in five of six.

Vancouver spoiled the no-hitter and the shutout in the bottom of the fifth. Addison Barger doubled, Trevor Schwicke singled in a run and later scored on a sacrifice fly.

Hillsboro responded with two unearned runs in the sixth with a strikeout plus wild pitch, a single and a two-run throwing error on a ground ball that could have ended the inning but instead put the Hops in front 6-2.

A two-run bottom of the sixth helped the C's draw within a pair again. Will Robertson singled, PK Morris was hit by a pitch and Barger singled home a run. Schwicke's RBI groundout made it 6-4 Hillsboro.

In the ninth, the Hops added a run on a walk, a double and a wild pitch to lead 7-4 and eventually win by that score.

Barger, Ray and PK Morris were all promoted from Low-A Dunedin prior to the game to make their High-A debut. Barger finished 2-for-4 with a double, a run scored and an RBI. Ray had a hit and Morris was hit by a pitch and scored a run.

BATTLE FOR THE 'BORO: The Canadians go toe-to-toe with Hillsboro for their fifth and final series of the season. These two teams last met August 24-29 when they split a six-game set; that week, the Hops got the first two, the C's the next pair then they went 50/50 over the weekend. All told, Hillsboro has a 14-11 edge in the season series and needs to win three games to take the inaugural (and hopefully last) Battle for the 'Boro. Vancouver has been outscored 128-12 by the Baby Snakes.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

BIG INNINGS: Vancouver scored two runs in the fifth last night to give them 100 runs in that inning this season. On the flip side, they've allowed 91 runs in the second stanza, the most they've surrendered in any given frame.

PAIN = GAIN: The C's have been hit by a pitch 92 times this year, the most in the High-A West by a wide margin. The second highest total is 76 (Everett/Eugene).

GET 'EM ON, GET 'EM IN: Vancouver hits .279 with runners in scoring position this season, the highest total in the High-A West.

OOPS, HE DID IT AGAIN: Phil Clarke has been named the High-A West Player of the Week for September 7-12, the second consecutive week he's earned the award and the first player in the circuit to go back-to-back this year. After rapping out 13 hits in five games against Everett, the former Vanderbilt Commodore used six hits - including two doubles and a pair of homers - to drive in 12 runs, scored four times and worked two walks. The highlight of his week was an eight RBI game on September 9 against Spokane. That night, he started his line with a bases-clearing double to score three in the bottom of the first, clubbed a three-run bomb in the fifth and doubled home another two in the sixth to lead the Canadians to a 14-5 rout.

ON THE HILL: Alex Nolan makes his sixth start of the year for Vancouver. He last appeared in a game as a reliever on September 10 against Spokane and worked two scoreless innings. Nolan, 25, is 0-3 with an 11.70 ERA in three appearances (two starts) against Hillsboro this year.

Justin Vernia goes for Hillsboro in what will be his fifth turn against the Canadians. The righty is 2-1 with a 7.84 ERA in 20.2 innings of work opposite Vancouver.
