LUG•NOTES

Welcome to the Club: Today's Lansing starting pitcher is 20-year-old **Luis Morales**, just joining the ballclub two days ago from Single-A Stockton. A native of Cuba, Morales signed for \$3 million in January as the top international pitching prospect. Lansing marks his fourth stop along the Athletics' organizational ladder, rising from the Dominican Summer League to the Arizona Complex League to the California League to, now, the Midwest League. In total: 12 appearances, 11 starts, he has posted a 2.72 ERA and has struck out 45 batters while walking 12 in 36 1/3 innings, holding the opposition to a .201 batting average. Morales, the A's No. 7 overall prospect and No. 2 pitching prospect behind 2022 Lugnut **Mason Miller**, is expected to be followed to the mound by **Jake Garland**.

Roll Call: The Lugnuts have used 25 position players this year and 26 pitchers (not including **Danny Bautista, Jr.**, who tossed one inning as a position-player-pitching). 16 players have hit at least one home run, 16 players have stolen at least one base, 15 pitchers have made at least one start, 19 pitchers have won at least one game, and 13 pitchers have recorded at least one save.

Two for the Price of One: Lansing leads the league with 111 double plays turned, nine more than second-place Peoria.

Starting Strong: **James González's** strong outing yesterday (5 1/3 IP, 4 H, 3 R, 3 BB, 8 K) continued the Lugnuts' stretch of improved starting pitching. Over the last nine games, Lugnuts starters have allowed 11 runs on 23 hits in 45 innings while striking out 56.

Jerome Holtzman, Represent: The Lugnuts have been playing closer and closer games as the season has gone on. By month: seven saves in 20 games in April (35%), nine in 27 games in May (33%), 15 in 24 in June (63%), 20 in 24 games in July (83%), and 22 in 27 games played in August (81%).

Historic on the 4th: A crowd of 11,521 packed in to Jackson Field on July 4, the largest home attendance in Lansing since July 4, 2013. It was also the largest single game crowd in all of High-A, let alone the Midwest League, and an attendance larger than any crowd drawn by every Minor League Baseball team save for six Triple-A teams (Buffalo, Albuquerque, Salt Lake, Indianapolis, Norfolk and Round Rock) and one Double-A team (Frisco).

The Cycle: On June 21 at Wisconsin, **Jack Winkler** went 4-for-4 with a single, double, triple, home run and four RBIs, becoming the eighth player in team history to hit for the cycle. The other cycles: **Corey Patterson** (7/5/99 at South Bend); **Donnie Hood** (4/21/03 vs. Dayton); **Chip Cannon** (6/2/05 vs. Clinton); **Travis Snider** (7/7/07 at Fort Wayne); **Brad Glenn** (7/26/10 vs. Clinton); **Edward Olivares** (4/24/17 vs. South Bend); and **Ryan Gold** (4/18/19 vs. Dayton).

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired via trade by the Oakland Athletics on its roster. Chronologically, working backwards: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea, and a 2021 member of the Fort Wayne TinCaps); **Gunnar Hoglund** (Toronto Blue Jays, 3/16/22, for Matt Chapman); and **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster has two current first-rounders: shortstop **Jacob Wilson**, the sixth overall pick this year from Grand Canyon University, and the Blue Jays' 2021 first-round selection, 19th overall, **Gunnar Hoglund**, acquired via trade in March 2022 for Matt Chapman. The A's 2021 first-round selection, shortstop **Max Muncy**, opened the year on the Lugnuts' roster and is now with Double-A Midland and the 2022 first-round pick, catcher **Daniel Susac**, was promoted today.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2012: Philip Brua hit Leonardo Castillo with a pitch with the bases loaded in the top of the 13th, and Lake County won in Lansing, 3-2. Lugnuts DH Kevin Patterson went 0-for-6 with three strikeouts, ending his streak of reaching base in home games at 31 consecutive games, the longest home on-base streak in the Midwest League by seven.

2014: The season ended disappointingly, two outs into the sixth inning, shortened due to rain, with a 4-3 South Bend victory at Cooley Law School Stadium. 19-year-old 1B Rowdy Tellez went 3-for-3 with his second home run, finishing with a .357 batting average in a 12-game stint with the Lugnuts. The Nuts finish 62-77.

2018: In a heartbreaker, the Lugnuts blew 7-0 and 9-3 leads at Lake County, as Will Benson launched a three-run homer in the sixth and a two-run homer to ignite a five-run ninth inning for a 10-9 Captains walk-off winner. The Caps completed the comeback on a two-run Miguel Eladio homer to left on a 1-2 pitch from Dalton Rodriguez. In the loss, Ryan Gold went 4-for-4 with two RBIs and two runs scored.

In a Nutshell: Added to the Lansing roster from Stockton on August 30, 2023... in starting today's game, he becomes the 922nd Lugnut in franchise history... he is the 15th different starting pitcher for Lansing this season and the 51st different player used... signing bonus of \$3 million broke the record given to Sandy Gaston by Tampa Bay in 2018 (\$2.61m)... declared a free agent on August 25, 2022... signed on the first day of the international signing period, January 15, 2023... joins Pedro Santos as native Cubans on the Lugnuts.

Prospecting: Morales is ranked the A's no. 7 prospect by MLB Pipeline, which grades his fastball at 60, his curve at 50, his slider at 55, his change at 50 and his control at 50...

They write, "Considered the top pitching prospect of the 2023 international signing period, Morales signed for \$3 million with the A's in January of 2023. After setting a U-18 record for strikeouts with 161 across 82 2/3 innings between 2019 and 2020 in Cuba's Serie Nacional, he defected from Cuba in 2021 to Mexico, where he trained with Maels Rodriguez, a former Cuban National team pitcher and Olympian who regularly threw 100 mph fastballs.

"Morales boasts an electric arm with a fastball that has clocked as high as 99 mph in the past and sits 94-97. He also utilizes a slider, changeup and curveball as secondary pitches that are still developing, and the A's will look to get to work on helping him refine those offerings as he enters the system.

"Morales has worked hard on preparing his body by adding about 10 pounds of muscle to his 6-foot-3 frame, which should help his durability. Command is going to be key to his success, as he's struggled with controlling his pitches in the past. If he can improve that aspect of his game, he should be able to move through the organization rather quickly and could be a frontline starter in the future if he can fulfill his potential."

Path to Lansing: Luis opened the 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League, making his professional debut on June 6 with 1 2/3 hitless innings vs. DSL Astros Blue, striking out three... struck out six batters in three one-hit innings on June 20... struck out five batters in four one-hit innings on June 27... made four appearances in DSL before he was promoted to the Arizona Complex League Athletics on July 2, debuting on July 4 with three innings, allowing one run with three strikeouts vs. D-Backs Black... made three starts in AzCL before he was promoted to the Stockton Ports on July 24, debuting on July 28 with three one-hit innings and five strikeouts vs. Lake Elsinore... in last of five California League starts, tossed four two-hit scoreless innings at Fresno on August 25... promoted to Lansing on August 30, his fourth different stop along the ladder... innings high: 4 IP, 2x; strikeouts high: 6, 6/20.

In a Nutshell: Opened season with Single-A Stockton... debuted in the MWL May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win over the Captains... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands all root for Boston-area teams... @JakeGarland25.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg).

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Professional Debut: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings.

2023 Season: Opened the current campaign pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of **California League Pitcher of the Week** with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15.
