ABOUT LAST TIME: A five-run fifth inning and sparkling relief earned the Vancouver Canadians a 7-1 win and a series split with the Everett AquaSox (Mariners) Sunday afternoon at Ron Tonkin Field.

Tied 1-1 after four innings, Vancouver sent all nine men to the plate and scored five runs on four hits in the bottom of the fifth. DJ Neal got things started with a single and a stolen base before Tanner Kirwer worked a walk. Phil Clarke singled home the first run of the frame - and the eventual game winner - then Spencer Horwitz followed suit with a run-scoring single that made it 3-1. Clarke would score on an error that put the C's up by three and Sebastian Espino brought in the final two runs of the inning with a two-out, two-RBI double.

Everett started the scoring with a solo home run from Connor Hoover in the bottom of the second, but the Canadians responded to tie the game in the bottom of the inning when Espino singled with two outs and scored after Rafael Lantigua tripled him home.

Right-hander Paxton Schultz got the start and managed to escape a bases loaded, one-out jam in the first and went on to work 3.1 innings in which he allowed one run on five hits with three walks and three strikeouts. He left the game with runners at the corners and one out in the fourth, but Brandon Eisert (W, 3-0) managed to induce an inning-ending double play to keep the game tied.

Eisert allowed runs in consecutive outings before today, when he was lights out for 3.2 innings in which he scattered three hits, walked a batter and struck out four while keeping the 'Sox off the scoreboard. Parker Caracci was perfect for his two innings of relief and K'd three.

Lantigua belted his second home run in as many games this week in the bottom of the eighth to ice the game as the C's went on to win 7-1.

Four different Canadians - Clarke, Horwitz, Espino and Lantigua - finished with two hits apiece and seven of nine starters had a base knock. With the win, Vancouver has now split both series with Everett and remains perfect on Sundays this season.

THE EMERALDS CITY: Vancouver arrives at PK Park this week for their first and only visit to Central Oregon. These two teams last met June 1-6 at Ron Tonkin Field when the Ems took four of six from the C's, when the Giants affiliate outscored the Canadians 38-29.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

ON THIS DATE IN BASEBALL HISTORY: June 22, 1932 - After refusing to follow suit, probably due to opposing players and fans harassing the Cardinals when they wore numerals on their sleeves in 1923, the National League finally approves the use of uniform numbers to identify players. Some American League teams regularly implemented digits on their jerseys a few seasons ago.

GO DEEP: The C's are 12-6 when they hit at least one home run but are 12-12 when they're kept in the ballpark.

ONE SIDED: Vancouver has played more games decided by four runs or more (22) than all other results combined (20). They're 10-12 in the former and 14-6 in the latter.

ON THE HILL: Right-hander Brian Rapp makes his system debut for the Blue Jays after he was signed as a free agent out of independent ball yesterday. Prior to signing with Toronto, the Mendham, NJ native was playing with the New York Boulders where he pitched to a 3.15 ERA in four Frontier League starts across 20 innings. He K'd 23 and walked only eight. Rapp, 25, played collegiately at Boston College and was originally drafted by Minnesota in the 26th round in 2018 and spent two seasons in the Twins system.

Kai-Wei Teng goes for Eugene. In his last turn on June 16 against Hillsboro, the right-hander went five innings in which he allowed two runs on two hits with three walks and ten strikeouts. Teng, 22, was originally signed by Minnesota before he was acquired by San Francisco in 2019 in a trade that sent Sam Dyson to the Twins.
