### RIDERS EXPLODE EARLY, TAKE SATURDAY GAME OVER MIDLAND:

The Frisco RoughRiders took down the Midland RockHounds 7-3 from Momentum Bank Ballpark on Saturday night. Frisco (26-24, 57-61) jumped out in front with four runs in the first inning and it started on the first pitch of the game against Joelvis Del Rosario (1-1). On the initial offering, **Jax Biggers** tripled into right-center field and scored on a throwing error for a Little League home run. **Trevor Hauer** then added an RBI single before **Liam Hicks** hit a sacrifice fly and **Frainyer Chavez** capped the inning with another RBI single. Midland (28-22, 60-59) struck back in the third with a run, but Chavez crushed a two-run homer in the fourth, his second with the Riders, and Hicks tallied another RBI with a run-scoring single in the fifth to make it 7-1. Lazara Armenteros left the yard for a two-run, fifth-inning homer against **Grant Wolfram** (10-0), who earned his team-best 10th win, but that ended the scoring for the night. The RoughRiders bullpen was strong the rest of the way. **Andy Rodriguez** worked a 1-2-3 inning with two strikeouts in his Double-A debut before **Danny Duffy** and **Michael Brewer** finished off the game with scoreless innings. Biggers, **Evan Carter** and Chavez all had two hits to lead the offense.

### WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

For almost the entire season, the RoughRiders have lead the Texas League in walks as an offense. Frisco has already shattered their franchise record for most walks in a season with 589 and counting (5.0 per game). Frisco's .357 on-base percentage is on pace to set a new franchise record as well. In the first five games of this series, the Riders have walked 29 times (5.8 per game) with **Chris Seise** leading the way with five.

### HE'S DOING BIG(GERS) THINGS:

RoughRiders infielder **Jax Biggers** has been showing off in the power department this season for Frisco. Entering 2023, his career high in home runs was four and on Wednesday, he hit his 11th long ball of the season. In his last 25 games, he has clubbed six homers while hitting .312 (29-for-93)/.429/.581/1.010 with three doubles, one triple, six home runs, 17 RBIs, 18 walks and 18 runs scored. In August, he has a 1.015 OPS, which leads the team.

### NEW MONTH, NEW ME:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they have been fantastic. In the 23 games in August, (11-12 record) the RoughRiders are third in the Texas League with a 4.15 ERA while allowing a league-low 17 home runs. **Ryan Garcia** was brilliant two Tuesdays ago in Corpus, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. **Nick Krauth** then followed up with a second quality start, giving the RoughRiders their first back-to-back quality starts since May 31st and June 1st when **Owen White** and **Jack Leiter** completed the feat. On the offensive side in the month, Frisco is second-to-last in the Texas League with a .724 OPS and second-to-last in runs per game with 4.7 per contest.

### HAAV YOURSELF A YEAR:

**Trevor Hauer** has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting .218/.337/.368/.705, but in the 52 games since, he is batting .292/.407/.467/.874 with 14 doubles, six home runs, 31 RBIs and 39 walks. In those games, he has raised his average 39 points and his OPS 89 points.

### CARTER WALKS SO THE ROUGHRIDERS CAN RUN:

**Evan Carter** has been fantastic at drawing walks and getting on base this season. Carter's 72 walks are second in the Texas League despite only playing in 77 percent of the RoughRiders games this year. His 15.8 percent walk rate this year is fifth-highest in the league as well. He has walked 21 times in his last 23 games. His .409 OBP on the season is seventh in all of Double-A and among all nine players in Double-A with a .400 OBP or better, Carter is the youngest at 20 years old.

### HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK:

**Liam Hicks** has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 33 games, Hicks is batting .321 (36-for-112)/.435/.420/.855 with six doubles, a triple, a home run, 18 RBIs, 21 walks and 15 runs scored. In his last 20 games, he is batting .333 (22-for-66) with a .870 OPS.

### K'S BY KELLY:

RoughRiders reliever **Antoine Kelly** has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He allowed an earned run for the first time on Thursday in his last 21.2 innings. During that stretch, he had 25 strikeouts to three walks while recording four saves. He has converted on all 10 save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

### ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Evan Carter** hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (**Liam Hicks**, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauer**, **Thomas Saggese** (3) and **Evan Carter**). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

### ABOUT JACK

-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No.16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 57 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2005), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

### 2023 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2023 season as the No. 78 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. 5 prospect in the Rangers system.

-In May, Leiter went 2-1 over five starts with a 1.67 ERA. Over 27.0 innings, Leiter struck out 33 while walking 13.

-After his July 7th start against Midland (0.1 IP, 6R, 5 ER), Leiter was placed on the Development List and stayed there for 44 days.

### 2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system.

-Leiter dazzled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

-Threw the Riders first quality start of the season on May 7th against Arkansas. Leiter retired the last 15 batters he saw, allowing just two hits (one in the first and one in the second inning).

-Leiter came out of the bullpen in a "start" to finish a suspended game on May 31st (game was finished on June 1st) and recorded a career-best eight strikeouts against Wichita over 5.2 innings. The game resulted in a 3-0 win for Frisco, the Riders second shutout win of the season to that point.

-The righty allowed just one home run over his first nine outings before allowing two against Amarillo on June 7th. The two home runs were a grand slam and a two-run shot in a 7-4 loss to the Sod Poodles.

-Leiter was placed on the Development List on June 28th and was activated on July 10th before his start against San Antonio.

-Pitched a 1-2-3 inning on nine pitches in The SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game from Dodger Stadium on July 16th.

### 2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.

### MORE INFO

-Leiter was high school teammates with Yankees No. 1 prospect (No. 8 in baseball) Anthony Volpe at Delbarton School (NJ).
