FROM THE CROW'S NEST

ON THE BRINK: With wins in three of the first four games of the series, the Marauders are now just one game behind the first-place Tarpons in the West Division standings. Bradenton has had either partial or full possession of second place since May 9, but has not yet touched first place this season.

FLORENCIO'S FINEST: Tonight's starter, **Adrian Florencio**, has received the best run support among Marauders starters this season, averaging 5.3 runs per game. The right-hander has allowed more than one earned run just once in his six starts (3 ER allowed in last start, last Sunday vs Daytona) and is averaging 5.2 strikeouts per start (K/9 rate of 11.2). Opponents are batting just .194 against Florencio.

GREAT ESCOTTO: **Maikol Escotto** drove in five runs in last night's doubleheader, including a three-run homer in the first game. Since returning from the injured list on Tuesday, Escotto is 4-for-10 with five RBI and two walks.

BAD BREEZE: The Marauders struck out a season-high 19 times Tuesday night, breaking the previous season-high of 16 (twice, last on June 1 at Dunedin). Bradenton hitters own the fourth-highest strikeout total in the Low-A Southeast at 441, an average of 11 strikeouts per game.

BASH BROTHERS: **Jase Bowen** and **Endy Rodriguez** are tied for the Low-A Southeast lead with six home runs each. The six homers are career-highs for both men. They are also tied for the team lead with 32 hits each, and are the team's two leaders in multi-hit games (Rodriguez 10, Bowen 8).

THE OPPONENT: The Tarpons lead the Low-A Southeast in a litany of statistical categories, including wins (27), runs (316), home runs (56), walks drawn (253), batting average (.268), on-base percentage (.393), and slugging percentage (.471). Tampa's totals in wins, runs, walks, and OBP are also tops in all of Minor League Baseball. In 2019, the Marauders went 9-8 against the Tarpons, but went just 4-5 at Steinbrenner Field.

TOP PROSPECTS: The Marauders roster currently boasts eight prospects in MLB Pipeline's Top 30 ranking for the organization: **Hudson Head** (#5), **Eddy Yean** (#12), **Jared Jones** (#16), **Sammy Siani** (#18), **Nick Garcia** (#20), **Endy Rodriguez** (#25), **Alexander Mojica** (#28), and **Daniel Lopez** (#29). Three of the eight (Head, Rodriguez, and Yean) came to the organization via blockbuster trades: Head and Rodriguez came from the Padres and Mets, respectively, in the three-team Joe Musgrove deal, and Yean came from Washington in the Josh Bell trade.

UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT: New Jersey native **Jonathan Johnston** is in his first season as Marauders manager. The U.S. Naval Academy graduate spent two seasons as a catcher in the Oakland Athletics system in 2008 and 2011 in between a collective five years in the Navy as a Surface Warfare Officer. Prior to joining the Pirates organization in 2020, he held coaching roles at UC San Diego and UNC Asheville.

MISCELLANEOUS: **Hudson Head** went 0-for-4 with 4 strikeouts in Game 1 of last night's doubleheader, ending a 25-game on-base streak... **Eli Wilson** is in the Low-A Southeast's top 10 in batting average (.370, 5th), OBP (.528, 5th), SLG (.556, 7th), and OPS (1.083, 7th)...
