**THURSDAY:** The Flying Squirrels split a double-header against the Reading Fightin Phils. In the first game of the night, the Flying Squirrels won, 4-3. The Flying Squirrels scored in the first on a wild pitch before Reading scored two in the bottom of the inning to take a 2-1 lead. Jorge Bonifacio homered in the third to extend Reading's lead to 3-1. In the top of the fourth, **Ronnie Freeman** hit a two-run triple to tie the game and **Vince Fernandez** followed with a pinch-hit sac fly to give the Flying Squirrels the lead. **Luis Amaya, Frank Rubio, Matt Seelinger** and **Raffi Vizcaino** combined for 4.0 scoreless innings out of the bullpen. In the second game, Reading won, 6-4, after Bonifacio hit a go-ahead grand slam in the bottom of the sixth. **Frankie Tostado** and Fernandez gave Richmond 2-0 lead in the first inning. In the third, **David Villar** hit an RBI single and **Jacob Heyward** scored during a rundown to open a 4-0 lead. Bonifacio got Reading on the board with a two-run homer in the third before his go-ahead slam in the sixth.

**TODAY'S GAMES:** The Flying Squirrels play the fourth and fifth of a six-game series against the Reading Fightin Phils, Double-A affiliate of the Philadelphia Phillies, at FirstEnergy Stadium. This series marks the only trip to Reading this season for the Flying Squirrels. The Fightin Phils play six games at The Diamond from August 3-8.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have dropped eight of the last 12 games. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 3.5 games behind first-place Bowie. Over the last 12 games since May 14, the Flying Squirrels are batting .224 (85-for-380) as a team. Over the previous nine games to open the season from May 4-13, the Flying Squirrels hit .273, which was third-best in the Double-A Northeast.

**THE FIGHTIN PHILS** are tied for fifth place in the Double-A Northeast Northeast Division, 11.0 games behind first-place Somerset. They have lost 14 of the last 16 games since May 9. For the season, Reading is ranked 27th of 30 Double-A teams with a .199 team batting average. Their 7.13 team ERA is the highest in Double-A and the second-highest of the 120 affiliated minor league teams. Reading's roster includes four of MLB.com's top-30 Phillies prospects, including RHP Francisco Morales (4), C Rodolfo Durán (19), LHP Ethan Lindow (24) and RHP James McArthur (29).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Caleb Kilian** makes his Double-A debut in Game 1. He opened the season with High-A Eugene, going 3-0 with a 1.25 ERA in four starts with 32 strikeouts in 21.2 innings. He last pitched on Saturday at Tri-Cities and took a perfect game two outs into the seventh inning before allowing his first hit. He finished the seven-inning, scoreless outing with a career-best 10 strikeouts. He was named High-A West Pitcher of the Week twice in the three weeks he spent with the Emeralds. Kilian is currently ranked second in all of the minors in WHIP (0.46) and ninth in BAA (.122). He was drafted by the Giants in the eighth round in 2019 out of Texas Tech, where he was a First-Team All-Big 12 pitcher. **For more on Kilian, see page two.**

In Game 2, right-hander **Sean Hjelle** makes his fifth start of the 2021 season. Last time out, he opened with 5.0 scoreless innings before surrendering an unearned run in the sixth, his lone run allowed in a 5.1-inning outing with a season-high eight strikeouts in a no-decision against the Baysox on Sunday. In 2019, Hjelle climbed three levels in the Giants' system. He began the year with Single-A Augusta for nine starts, made 14 starts with A-Adv. San Jose and joined the Flying Squirrels for five starts at the end of the year. Hjelle finished the year ranked fourth in the Giants organization in strikeouts (139) and fifth in ERA (3.32). He enters the 2021 season rated by *Baseball America* as the Giants' No. 13 prospect. Hjelle was drafted in the second round in 2018 out of the University of Kentucky. **For more on Hjelle, see page three.**

**FOR READING:** Left-hander Ethan Lindow makes his fourth start of the season in Game 1. Last time out, he allowed one run over 3.0 innings in a no-decision at Akron last Friday. He has worked as far as 3.2 innings into a start this season, which came with a scoreless outing on May 9 against Erie. Lindow spent the 2019 season at two levels with the Phillies, making 26 appearances (16 starts) at Low-A Lakewood and High-A Clearwater, combining for a 5-4 record with a 2.52 ERA. Lindow was drafted in the fifth round by the Phillies in 2017 out of Locust Grove (Calif.) High School.

In Game 2, right-hander James McArthur takes the mound for his fifth appearance and fourth start of the year. Last time out, he was hit with his second loss after allowing three runs in 3.2 inning at Akron on Sunday. In each of his previous two starts on May 11 at Bowie and May 18 at Akron, he tossed 4.0 innings and allowed one run. In 2019, McArthur played for Low-A Lakewood and High-A Clearwater, going 3-7 with a 4.96 ERA in 25 outings (13 starts).

**STRONG ARMS:** This season, the Flying Squirrels rank second in all of Double-A in ERA (3.24), which is first in the Double-A Northeast. The Richmond pitching staff also ranks tied for first in Double-A in saves (9), third-fewest hits (133), fifth in WHIP (1.18) and fourth in BAA (.203). Starting pitcher **Matt Frisbee** is first among qualified pitchers in WHIP (0.50).

**THE 'PEN IS MIGHTY:** The Flying Squirrels' relievers have the third-best bullpen ERA in all of Minor League Baseball at 2.38 on the season. The bullpen is tied for third in the minors and tied for first in Double-A with nine saves. Richmond relievers second-fewest runs (29) and have the third-best BAA (.161) in the minors. **Patrick Ruotolo** is tied for second in Double-A with four saves and tied for third with nine appearances.

**ANTI-THEFT SECURITY:** The Richmond catchers have combined to throw out 67 percent of stolen base attempts, which leads all of Minor League Baseball. The Flying Squirrels have thrown out a total of 12 stolen base attempts this season, which is tied for the fourth-most in the minors and leads Double-A. **Andres Angulo** is leading all Double-A catchers in caught stealing percentage (min. 10 attempts) at 63.6 percent (7-for-11).

**STRONG START:** The Flying Squirrels' 12-9 record is the second-best start in team history through 21 games, trailing only a 13-8 start in 2018.

**HITTERS' HAVEN:** From 2010-2019, Reading's FirstEnergy Stadium allowed home runs at a higher rate than any other park in the Eastern League. Over that stretch, the ballpark allowed a rate of 2.08 home runs per game (1,482 total homers). In comparison, The Diamond in Richmond has been the toughest park to homer in at 0.96 per game (677 total home runs). FirstEnergy Stadium was the second-highest park for scoring in that stretch at 9.34 runs per game. The Diamond was the lowest-scoring field in the circuit at 7.60 runs per game.

**A BUNCH OF SELLOUTS:** The Flying Squirrels have sold out their maximum capacity crowds at The Diamond for 10 of their 11 openings this year. For the first homestand, the Flying Squirrels drew the maximum allotted crowd of 2,943 for all five openings. In the current homestand, the maximum capacity is 3,448. After drawing 3,057 fans last Tuesday (89%), the Flying Squirrels have sold out their last five home games.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have four players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12), **Sean Hjelle** (13) and **Jose Marte** (30). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Four players, Ramos (3), Hjelle (11), Beck (20) and **Caleb Kilian** (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

**GOING FOR GOLD:** Flying Squirrels manager **José Alguacil** is taking an absence from his position in Richmond to manage the Venezuelan national team for the WBSC Baseball Americas Olympic Qualifier at Clover Park in St. Lucie, Fla. and The Ballpark of the Palm Beaches in West Palm Beach, Fla. Venezuela is playing in Group B with Canada, Colombia and Cuba. After scrimmage games against the Dominican Republic and the United States, Venezuela will play its first game of the Qualifier on May 31 against Cuba in West Palm Beach. The top two teams from each group will play in a super round on June 4 and 5, with the team holding the best record from that round earning a spot in the Olympics in Japan. **Tony Diggs** will manage the Flying Squirrels for this week's series in Reading. Diggs, who is the Giants' Minor League Field Coordinator, previously spent 16 seasons with the Milwaukee Brewers organization, including managing in the Arizona League from 2008 to 2012 and 2016, as well as with the Helena Brewers from 2013 to 2015. Catcher **Andres Angulo** will also be in Florida to play for his home country, Colombia, in the Qualifier.
