FOR STARTERS: The Rocket City Trash Pandas continue a six-game series against the Birmingham Barons at Regions Field with a doubleheader on Thursday night. It's the fourth and final matchup between the North Division rivals this season, with Birmingham holding a 12-6 edge in the series. Rocket City looks to bounce back after dropping four of six at home to Knoxville.

PAINFUL ENDING: TRASH PANDAS FALL 4-3 ON WALK-OFF HIT BATTER: The Trash Pandas tied the game in the sixth, but the Birmingham Barons walked off in the ninth when Sam Antonacci was hit by a pitch with the bases loaded for a 4-3 win Tuesday at Regions Field. Mitch Farris struck out three to push his Southern League-leading total to 129, while Oscar Colás extended his on-base streak to 12 games and Korey Holland reached in his sixth straight.

OSCAR PUTTING THE 'COLOSSAL' IN COLÁS: OF Oscar Colás' has reached base in 12 straight games, hitting five home runs during the streak — highlighted by a two-homer performance on August 14 and a grand slam on August 8 in Columbus, the Trash Pandas' second of the season and 11th in franchise history. Since May 30, Colas has been on a tear, leading the Southern League and ranking 3rd in all of Double-A with 13 homers in that span. Overall, he sits T-4th in the league with 14 long balls this year between Birmingham (1) and Rocket City (13).

FARRIS PACING THE SL IN STRIKEOUTS: LHP Mitch Farris leads the Southern League with 129 strikeouts over 22 outings in 2025. Farris is currently 2nd in team history in single-season strikeouts, just passing **Coleman Crow** (128, 2022) on Wednesday, and trailing only franchise record-holder **Caden** Dana, who struck out 147 batters in 2024. Farris ranks among the league leaders in starts (T-4th, 21), innings pitched (2nd, 109.1), and strikeouts (1st, 129).

COLÁS FACING HIS FORMER TEAM: Colás played 51 games with Double-A Birmingham in 2022, hitting .306 with a .364 OBP, .563 slugging, .927 OPS, 14 home runs, and 33 RBI. Entering 2023, he was ranked the Chicago White Sox No. 2 prospect and the No. 85 overall prospect in baseball by MLB Pipeline. He made his Major League debut with the White Sox in 2023, appearing in 75 games and batting .216 with, five home runs, and 19 RBI.

BLASTING OFF IN THE ROCKET CITY: Since July 1, the Trash Pandas lead the Southern League, and rank 9th in Double-A with 34 home runs in 39 games. **Oscar Colás** (11), and **Ben Gobbel** (5) have combined for 16 of those homers. The Pandas matched a club record with five long balls on July 3 vs. Knoxville and had four on August 14 vs. Knoxville.

PANDAS STREAKING: Colás' has reached base safely in 12-straight games, batting .262 with five home runs, 13 RBIs, and a .955 OPS. Korey Holland has reached in 6-straight games, batting .286 with a .423 OBP, two home runs, and five walks. Myles Emmerson has reached in 5-straight games, logging a .364 OBP. Ben Gobbel has reached in 10 of 11 games, including four walks, a home run, four doubles, and four RBIs.

NICHOLSON FINDING HIS GROOVE: Since a slow start following his August 2 call-up from High-A Tri-City, infielder Ryan Nicholson has been on a tear—slashing .278/.395/.500 over his last 10 games with two homers, two doubles, five RBIs, seven walks, and a .898 OPS.

LITTLE LEAGUE WORLD SERIES CONNECTION: Trash Pandas infielder David Mershon, at 11-yearsold, played in the 2015 Little League World Series representing Northwood Little League in Taylors, South Carolina. David's team made history with the state's first appearance since 1950. After going 4-0 to win the Southeast Region Tournament, Northwood opened their Williamsport run with a 7-1 victory over Rhode Island, marking the first-ever LLWS win for a South Carolina team. They then dropped a nail-biter to Pennsylvania, 9-8, sending them to the elimination bracket. A 4-3 loss to Kentucky ended their run, but their debut left a lasting mark as one of the most memorable youth baseball moments in South Carolina history.

SAM'S ROLLING THROUGH STARTS LIKE FRESH PASTA DOUGH: LHP Sam Aldegheri has five quality starts in his last seven outings since July 2. The Verona, Italy native has gone 4-2 over that stretch with a 2.16 ERA (10 ER/41.2 IP), 16 walks, and 32 strikeouts. His 2.16 ERA ranks 4th in the Southern League. Aldegheri ranks among the league leaders in starts (T-7th, 20), innings pitched (2nd, 108.1), strikeouts (T-9th, 93), and ERA (10th, 4.07).

FEELING CALABREEZY IN ROCKET CITY: OF David Calabrese is back for his fourth stint in Rocket City since 2023, and is now 4th on the all-time list in games played for the Trash Pandas with 214. He sits behind **Orlando Martinez** (296), **Tucker Flint** (244), and **Bryce Teodosio** (230). In 10 games since returning from High-A Tri-City, Calabrese is batting .278.

MURPHY MAKES HIS MARK: RHP Luke Murphy, back for his second stint in Rocket City in 2025, tossed a scoreless inning in Friday's game to extend his franchise-record 114 appearances from 2022-2025. The Vanderbilt product also ranks 3rd in team history with 10 wins, is tied for first with 21 holds, and sits 3rd in team history with 162 strikeouts.

COSMIC SHAKEUP: 26 ROSTER MOVES MADE IN AUGUST: On August 6, RHP Luke Murphy and RHP Kenyon Yovan were transferred to Rocket City from Triple-A Salt Lake, OF David Calabrese returned from High-A Tri-City, RHP Bryce Osmond was reinstated from the 60-day IL, and C Yeremi Villahermosa was moved from BCA to the Development List. LHP AJ Block, RHP Endry's Briceno, INF Evan Edwards, and C Jaxx Groshans were released.

On August 2, the Angels made 16 roster moves affecting Rocket City, highlighted by the promotions of RHP **Brady Choban**, INF **Denzer Guzman**, and OF **Nelson Rad**a to Triple-A Salt Lake. OF **Joe Redfield**, RHP **Jordan Holloway**, and INF **Evan White** went to the 60-day IL, while RHP **Sean Poppen** was released. OF **Korey Holland** joined from Salt Lake, and seven players came from High-A Tri-City. INF **Matt Coutney**, RHP **Max Gieg**, INF **Ryan Nicholson**, RHP **Roman Phansalkar**, LHP **Dylan Phillips**, RHP **Jake Smith**, and INF **Arol Vera**.

ADDITIONAL NOTES (CONT)

- DENZER GUZMAN NAMED SL PLAYER OF THE MONTH: On Wednesday, MiLB named Denzer Guzman the Southern League Player of the Month for July, becoming just the sixth player in Trash Pandas history to earn the honor—and the first since Gustavo Campero in July 2024. Guzman was one of the league's most consistent and productive hitters throughout the month. He led the Southern League in OPS (1.020), slugging percentage (.580), extra-base hits (13), and total bases (47). He also finished second in batting average (.333), on-base percentage (.440), and doubles (9), while his 27 hits tied for fifth. Guzman was promoted to Triple-A Salt Lake on August 2.
- KLASSEN AND ALDEGHERI DEALT IN JULY: LHP Sam Aldegheri and RHP George Klassen were two of the Southern League's best starters in July. Aldegheri led the league with a 0.78 ERA. In four starts, the lefthander went 3-0, allowing just four earned runs over 23.0 innings while recording 19 strikeouts and 10 walks. Klassen finished T-1st in the league with 26 strikeouts over four starts, finishing with a 3.32 ERA, striking out 26 and walking seven across 21.2 innings.
- PITCHING STAFF PACKED A PUNCH IN JULY: The Rocket City pitching staff racked up 213 strikeouts over 24 games in July—an average of 8.9 strikeouts per game—ranking 3rd in the Southern League and 9th across all of Double-A.
- SAM BROWN TRADED TO NATS: On Wednesday, the Angels traded Trash Pandas first baseman Sam Brown to the Washington Nationals as part of a four-player deal. A 2023 12th-round pick out of Washington State, Brown hit. 244 with 12 doubles, five homers, and 40 RBI in 92 games for Rocket City this season. He was named Southern League Player of the Week in mid-July and ranked fourth in batting average in May. In return, the Angels received LHP Andrew Chafin and RHP Luis García, while LHP Jake Eder also goes to Washington. José Quijada was designated for assignment.
- ROCKET CITY LIVED UP TO ITS NAME IN JULY. In July, the Trash Pandas launched 19 home runs over 24 games, 3rd in the Southern League and ranking T-10th in all of Double-A baseball. That stretch included a five-homer outburst on July 3 against Knoxville at Toyota Field, tying a franchise record. The surge was fueled by Oscar Colás and Ben Gobbel, who combined for 10 of the 19 homers. Colás led the league in that span with six, while Gobbel was T-4th.
- SOUND THE BLANKENHORN: OF Travis Blankenhorn has reached base in 32 of 41 games since returning from the Injured List on June 13. The veteran outfielder is tied for the league with eight home runs, and ranks 9th in the Southern League with an .752 OPS with six doubles, a triple, eight home runs, 20 RBIs, and 19 walks over that span.
- COLÁS BROUGHT THE BOOM IN JULY: Rocket City outfielder Oscar Colás finished July, 4th in all of Double-A with six home runs, plus he has three doubles, 15 RBIs, and 11 runs scored. On July 3 vs. Knoxville, Colás recorded his first career three-homer game, hitting solo home runs to lead off the third, fourth, and sixth innings. That marked only the second three-homer game in franchise history, the first being Orlando Martinez's performance on May 7, 2021, at Chattanooga.
- RADA REPORT: CF Nelson Rada, moved to Triple-A on August 2 after being the youngest player in the Southern League the past two seasons, He ranked 3rd in the league and 5th in all of Double-A with 34 stolen bases at the time of his promotion on August 2—19 of which came in a blistering month of May. His 34 steals ranked 3rd in Trash Pandas single-season history, trailing only his own mark of 35 from last year and Kyren Parris' franchise record of 44 set in 2023. Rada ranked among the league leaders at the time of his promotion in stolen bases (3rd, 34), OBP (5th, 380), batting average (12th, 277), and hits (T-9th, 91). Rada had a team-best 26 multi-hit games, including five three-hit games.
- GUZMAN BLAZED THROUGH JULY. The San Pedro de Macorís native, also moved to Triple-A on August 2, was named the Trash Pandas Player of the Month, and was one of the hottest hitters in Double-A last month, leading the Southern League—and was 5th in all of Double-A—with a 1.020 OPS, 47 total bases, and 13 extra-base hits. He ranked 2nd in the league with a .333 batting average and is also was tops in slugging (.580) and 2nd in on-base percentage (.440). His nine doubles rank 2nd in the league, and his 27 hits were T-5th. On July 13 in Chattanooga, he recorded the second five-hit game in Trash Pandas history, going 5-for-5 with three doubles, a home run, and four RBIs. He ranked among the league leaders at the time of his promotion in several categories, including doubles (2nd, 23), extra-base hits (T-1st, 35), RBIs (6th, 53), total bases (T-6th, 139), home runs (T-7th, 11), and slugging (7th, .415), and OPS (12th, .749). Guzman led the team with 16 multi-RBI games.
- GUZMAN AND BROWN GO BACK-TO-BACK FOR LEAGUE POW: INF Denzer Guzman was named Southern League Player of the Week for July 1-6 after leading the league with a 1.316 OPS and seven extra-base hits, along with six RBIs and six walks during a six-game series against Knoxville. One week later, INF Sam Brown earned the honor for July 8-13, posting a league-best .444 batting average (8-for-18) over five games in Rocket City's road series at Chattanooga. Brown added four extra-base hits, six RBIs, five walks, four runs scored, and a 1.398 OPS—also the highest in the league that week. Guzman and Brown became the 13th and 14th players in Trash Pandas history to win the award, and for the second consecutive season, Rocket City produced back-to-back weekly honorees, following Tucker Flint (Aug. 12-18) and Christian Moore (Aug. 5-11) in 2023.
- BACK FROM THE FUTURES GAME: RHP George Klassen made a brief but electric appearance for the American League squad at the Futures Game on July 19, throwing 11 pitches in the bottom of the third inning. He fired two 99 mph heaters—striking out Chicago's Owen Caissie. The No. 3 prospect for the Angels was the only representative for the Angels and became the sixth Rocket City player to earn a Futures Game selection, joining RHP Caden Dana ('24), OF Kyren Paris ('23), C Edgar Quero ('23), RHP Ky Bush ('22), and LHP Reid Detmers ('21).
- KEEPIN' IT QUALITY: Starter Joel Hurtado, has not made a start since June 20, but still ranks third in the Southern League with seven quality starts, and ranks fifth in the Southern League with a 3.10 ERA.
- ANOTHER ONE LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE: INF Jeremiah Jackson became the 44th Rocket City Trash Pandas alumnus to reach the Major Leagues, and eighth this season, when he made his MLB debut on August 1, with the Baltimore Orioles. Over his time in Madison, Jackson appeared in 169 games between 2022 and 2023, earning recognition for his power and versatility before being traded to the Mets and later landing with Baltimore. He joins former Pandas Chad Stevens (debuted o July 3), Robinson Piña (debuted on June 20), Christian Moore (debuted on June 13), Alan Rangel (June 6), José Fermin (April 26), Edgar Quero (April 16), and Michael Darrell-Hicks (April 17), who all debuted this year.
- THE STREAK IS OVER!!!: The Trash Pandas dropped a Southern League record 16 straight games from June 14 to July
 2. The streak was the longest in Minor League Baseball this season. The streak surpassed the previous Southern
 League mark set by the Columbus (GA) Astros in 1971, dropping 15-straight games from May 17-June 1, 1971. That
 season, the Southern League and Texas League played an interlocking schedule and referred to the agreement as the
 "Divia Ascericitien"
- **DELAYING THE LAUNCH:** From June 12-29, the Trash Pandas endured 9 hours and 20 minutes of weather delays, and during the last homestand, June 10-25, they faced delays that totaled 6 hours and 20 minutes. This season, Rocket City has had 14 home games impacted by rain delays or postponements, adding up to 9 hours and 2 minutes of total delay time. According to wunderground.com, rain has been recorded on 22 out of 37 home game days.

2024 in Review: Sam Aldegheri went 1-2 with a 4.85 ERA and 10 strikeouts over three starts for the Angels after making his Major League debut on Aug. 30 vs. Seattle. He earned his first MLB win in his second start, Sept. 6 at Texas, becoming the first Italian-born player to record a big league win since 1949 and the first pitcher born and raised in Italy to reach the Majors. He is the eighth Italian-born player in MLB history and the first for the Angels franchise.

Aldegheri was acquired from the Phillies on July 27 in the Carlos Estévez trade, after posting a 6-9 record and 3.59 ERA with 134 strikeouts in 19 starts between High-A Jersey Shore, Double-A Reading, and Rocket City. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, he led the South Atlantic League with 95 strikeouts and paced all High-A pitchers (min. 60 IP) with 12.57 K/9. He was named SAL Pitcher of the Week for June 10–16 after tossing 6.0 shutout innings with nine strikeouts against Wilmington.
