### TODAY'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Sacramento River Cats (San Francisco Giants affiliate) gear up for the first of their six-game series on Tuesday afternoon at Dell Diamond. Last time out, the Express earned a 3-2 win over the Durham Bulls at Durham Bulls Athletic Park on Sunday afternoon. After being held to one hit through the first four innings, the Express got on the board in the fifth with a pair of runs. 2B Michael Helman launched a solo homer and SS Richie Martin added an RBI single for a 2-0 advantage. In the sixth, an RBI single by C Cooper Johnson extended the lead to three. In the ninth, Durham 3B Cooper Kinney knocked in two runners with a double to make it a 3-2 game. Round Rock RHP Ryan Brasier struck out the next two batters, securing an Express win in the series finale.

### WHERE WE STAND

The Express snapped their 8-game losing skid on Saturday night...8-game losing streak was the longest since the E-Train lost 10 straight from May 7-18, 2023 which was tied for the longest in Express Triple-A history (also 2013)...have won 2 in a row...have lost 10 of their last 15.

### LONG BALL VS GETTING ON

Round Rock has hit the fewest home runs in Triple-A (25) ... Express are 12th in Triple-A in walk rate (12.2%) and 7th in Triple-A in walks (191) but 29th in slugging percentage (.347)... on pace to hit 96 home runs which would be the fewest in the Express Triple-A era (since 2005)... only season where the club has not hit 100 home runs came in 2009 (97) but they played only 144 games.

### CLOSE CALLS

Saturday night's 5-3 win marked the largest margin of victory between the Bulls and the Express in their six-game set...Round Rock had lost the first four games by a run and took Sunday's finale by a margin of 1 (3-2)...the E-Train went 2-4 on the week...out-hit the Bulls 50-39 but were outscored 20-21.

### THROWING CHAIRS

The Express struck out 18 batters on Sunday, the most from any PCL team this season...entered Sunday's matchup with 58 strikeouts through 5 games at Durham Bulls Athletic Park, their most in any series of the season...finished with 76 strikeouts on the week...Round Rock is handing opponents a 31.7% whiff rate in May, the highest mark of any Triple-A team in a single month this season.

### NOT THE PCL PITCHER OF THE WEEK... SOMEHOW... NOT SURE HOW

In two starts at Durham last week, RHP Josh Stephan went 1-0 and tossed a total of 11.0 innings with three earned runs on 10 hits, two walks and 20 strikeouts. On May 4, Stephan tossed 6.0 innings with three runs on six hits, no walks and 11 strikeouts. Since 2005, 13 Round Rock pitchers have struck out 11 or more batters in a game. Stephan is one of three that did not issue a walk. In his second start on Sunday, he paced the Express with 5.0 innings of scoreless baseball with four hits, two walks and nine strikeouts to earn the victory.

### THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - FRIDAY, MAY 12, 1978

After Nolan Ryan threw a complete game one-hitter against the Cleveland Indians a week earlier, Cleveland got its revenge. Ryan went 8.0 innings and allowed four earned runs on seven hits with six walks and five strikeouts in a 4-3 loss at Cleveland Municipal Stadium. Lyman Bostock and Carney Lansford each drove in a run in the third and fourth innings to give California a 2-0 lead. A three-run fifth for the Indians, fueled by RBIs from Johnny Grubb, Willie Horton and Duane Kuiper, made it 3-2 Cleveland. Ron Hassey hit his first major league home run in the eighth to extend the lead to 4-2. Hassey had recently been called up from Triple-A Portland and was appearing in just his fifth major league game. Lansford doubled home a run in the ninth, but Cleveland held on for the win. Mike Paxton earned the victory for Cleveland after tossing 8.0 innings and allowing three runs, two earned, with two walks and three strikeouts. Ryan had his 24-inning scoreless streak snapped in the fifth inning and admitted afterward he did not have his best stuff. "I had no idea where the ball was going tonight. Cleveland has always been a good fastball hitting club," Ryan told reporters postgame. Horton discussed why the Indians fared better against Ryan this time around. "Sometimes you can go out there and give a pitcher too much respect. You can psyche yourself out. That may be what happened last time. We talked about it before tonight's game. You let a guy psyche you out in the first game of a series and he can mess up your next two games. In the '68 Series, we had so much respect for Bob Gibson, a kid could have gone out and got us out."

- Made his first appearance of 2026 as Round Rock's starting pitcher against Gwinnett on Apr. 5...only made two starts (32 G) in all of 2025 (1-ACL Rangers, 1-RR)...his first start since 6/20/25 at STP...threw 3.0 scoreless innings, allowed three hits and struck out four...3.0 IP ties his Triple-A high (4/22/25 vs LV, 9/10/25 vs SUG).
- Acker is in his sixth year with the Rangers organization and is seeking his Major League debut in 2026.
- Led all Rangers farmhands with 10 double plays induced as a reliever.
- Was one of five Round Rock relievers to log 40.0 innings in 2025.
- Was one of just six Round Rock pitchers to appear in 30 or more games and one of nine to throw more than 50.0 innings.
- 30 appearances with the Express marked a single-season career-high...Had 2.45 ERA at home, 8.75 ERA on the road.

- Began rehab assignment with Round Rock on April 23... Placed on the 15-day injured list with a right intercostal strain on April 5.
- Appeared in four games to open 2026 with Texas and held a 3.18 ERA (2 ER/5.2 IP) with six walks and six strikeouts and had posted the most innings among Texas relievers prior to injury.
- Threw a scoreless eighth inning on Saturday April 4 vs Cincinnati with Texas up 2-0. Was scheduled to return in the ninth but the injury flared up. RHP Luis Curvelo took his spot on the roster when he went to IL.
- Was acquired by Texas from Pittsburgh on 12/10/25 after PIT selected the right-hander in the 2025 Rule 5 Draft that same day.
- Major League debut came on Opening Day in Philadelphia. Threw a scoreless inning with his first strikeout coming against Adolis García.
- Found out he made Rangers Opening Day roster when Manager Skip Schumaker made an unorthodox mound visit during exhibition game at Globe Life Field. "Most of the time you see the manager come out, [it's] like, 'OK, you're out of the game.' I turned around, I saw him, I was just caught off guard and didn't know what was going to happen. And then he told me that and it was just a really cool moment. I'm definitely not going to forget that."
- Forewent his commitment to TCU and was a fifth-round selection in 2020 by the Baltimore Orioles out of Dowling Catholic High School in Des Moines, IA where he was classmates with Caitlin Clark.
