SAINT PAUL, MINN. – Down by five after the second inning, the Omaha Storm Chasers stormed back to score five runs and tie the game in the ninth inning, but promptly lost to the St. Paul Saints 6-5, on a walk-off in the bottom of the ninth.

Anthony Veneziano looked stellar in the first inning of his Triple-A debut, with a scoreless first and 11 of 12 pitches for strikes ... but the lefty labored through a 47-pitch second inning and surrendered five runs in the frame to give the Saints a comfortable lead.

Behind Veneziano, the bullpen was solid for nearly the rest of the night, as **Jonah Dipoto**, **James McArthur**, **Walter Pennington** and **Dylan Coleman** combined for six scoreless innings with just one hit allowed and 12 strikeouts ... McArthur got five of his seven outs via the strikeout, while Pennington retired all four batters he faced and Coleman stranded two on with a pair of strikeouts.

The strong bullpen effort provided the offense with a chance to come back and **Nick Loftin** promptly gave Omaha a chance to get back in the game, as he connected on a three-run homer in the top of the third inning, scoring **Drew Waters** and **Samad Taylor**, who had back-to-back singles ahead of Loftin.

With Loftin nearly immediately putting the Chasers within striking distance, Taylor made it a one-run game in the fourth with an RBI single that plated **Jackson Reetz** to put the score at 5-4 in favor of the Saints.

Omaha stayed within one until the ninth, as with two outs, **Logan Porter** singled and **Brewer Hicklen** reached on an error to put the tying run on third base ... Dairon Blanco quickly singled in Porter to tie the game at 5-5, forcing a bottom of the ninth.

The tie did not last long, however, as St. Paul opened the bottom of the ninth with three straight singles off **Brooks Kriske** (0-3), who couldn't even record an out, for a walk-off 6-5 loss.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

RELIEF AID

Over the last 11 games, Omaha has had one of the best bullpens in Triple-A.

- Since May 12, Omaha's relievers have combined for a 2.86 ERA (16 ER in 50.1 IP) that is good for 4th among all Triple-A teams.
- 7 of the 10 relievers last week did not allow an earned run, giving Omaha its best bullpen ERA of any six-game series this season, 2.54 (7 have been played).
- Since May 12, 27 of 38 relievers that have come into a game have had a scoreless outing, including 11 of more than one inning and 9 perfect appearances.

IT'S GONNA BE MAY

While April was a slow month offensively for the Chasers, much of the lineup has turned things up in the month of May, including **Nick Loftin** and **Dairon Blanco**.

- In May, Loftin is slashing .333/.402/.533 (25-for-75) with 20 runs batted ... that contrasts to a .220/.244/.402 (18-for-82) slashline last month, with 11 RBI ... this month, he leads Omaha with 20 RBI, 25 hits and 40 total bases, tied 6th in the league in RBI.
- Loftin's active 8-game hitting streak and 12-game on base streak are his longest of the season and the longest active streaks amongst Storm Chasers hitters ... his 9-game hitting streak is Omaha's longest this year ... since his 12-game on-base streak started on May 10, he has 16 hits and 7 walks, it is Omaha's 2nd-longest this year.
- In May, Blanco is slashing .372/.534/.605 (16-for-43) with 13 walks ... that contrasts to a .265/.359/.368 (18-for-68) slashline last month, with 7 walks ... this month, he leads Omaha with 13 walks and 16 steals, plus a .372 average, .534 OBP and 1.139 OPS.

YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

With one steal yesterday, the Chasers have 83 steals in 45 games (average of 1.86 SB/game) and have been caught just 15 times for a success rate of 84.54%.

- 83 steals rank 2nd in the International League, 2nd among all Triple-A teams and 10th in Minor League Baseball ... among Triple-A teams, only the Worcester Red Sox (85) have more steals, while the Lynchburg Hillcats lead the minors (125) and Kansas City's Single-A affiliate, the Columbia Fireflies are 2nd in MiLB (108).
- With one steal yesterday, outfielder **Dairon Blanco** has 29 stolen bases this season (in 32 tries), which is 1st in the league, 1st in Triple-A and tied 3rd in MiLB ... Blanco has stolen 16 bases in 14 games this month ... he already has six games of 2+ steals this year.
- Samad Taylor** added a steal Sunday and is 2nd on the team behind Blanco with 22 steals (in 26 attempts) and ranks 4th in the league and 4th in Triple-A and is tied 11th in the Minors ... he's stolen 10 bases in 19 games this month.
- The Chasers have stolen at least one base in 31 of 45 games (69%), with multiple steals in 27 games and five occasions of 5+ steals.
- Omaha's average sprint speed of 29.1ft/sec is tied 2nd among all Triple-A squads.
- Dairon Blanco's** average sprint speed of 31.1 ft/sec is tied second among all Triple-A hitters, while Brewer Hicklen and Nate Eaton are tied 33rd at 29.8 ft/sec.
- Blanco's sprint speed would make him the 4th-fastest player in MLB, ahead of **Bobby Witt Jr.'s** 30.8 ft/sec spring speed.

BIG BLASTS

Two of Omaha's three furthest-hit home runs this season have come in this series, while the top 3 have all come in the last week and 6 of the top 10 have come in May.

On Tuesday, **Dairon Blanco's** 455-foot solo shot was the Chasers' longest of the season, while **Nick Loftin's** 433-foot 3-run homer yesterday was the 3rd-longest.



MANAGER: MIKE JIRSCHOLE • #23

- Mike Jirschele returns for his 15th season as Omaha's manager, his 18th season managing in Minor League Baseball and 32nd season overall with the Royals organization, named to the position of Storm Chasers manager on January 13, 2023, after previously managing Triple-A Omaha from 1995-97 and 2003-13.
- Jirschele served on the Kansas City Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015. Jirschele most recently served as the bench coach under manager Chris Widger during the 2022 season with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals. He spent the 2021 season as Widger's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.
- In his second stint as Omaha's manager, over 11 years from 2003 to 2013, he led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for *outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field* and he is a four-time recipient of the Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), recognizing outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.
- Prior to his time with Omaha and Kansas City, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years, from 1998-2002, and he held managerial positions with Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- He appeared 999 games in the Minor Leagues across 13 years, between 1977 and 1990, including 22 games with the Omaha Royals between 1988 and 1989.



PITCHING COACH: DANE JOHNSON • #59

- Dane Johnson enters his fourth year in the Royals organization and as the Storm Chasers pitching coach, after joining Kansas City ahead of the 2020 season. 2023 marks his 24th season coaching overall.
- He previously spent one season in the Miami Marlins organization (2019) as a Pitching Consultant and 19 seasons with the Toronto Blue Jays as a Minor League Pitching Coach from 2000-03, Pitching Coordinator from 2004-14 and Major League Bullpen Coach from 2015-18.
- Prior to entering coaching, spent 15 years as a player, including over 280 games in the Minor Leagues and parts of three seasons in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox (1994), Blue Jays (1996) and Oakland Athletics (1997), also playing two seasons (1990-1991) in the Chinese Professional Baseball League.
- Johnson and his wife, Gina, reside in Palm Harbor, Florida. They have two children: a daughter, Madison (31), and son, Cobi (27).



HITTING COACH: BIJAN RADEMACHER • #52

- Bijan Rademacher (*bi-ZHON RAH-de-moch-err*) joins the Royals as the Omaha Storm Chasers Hitting Coach this year after spending the last two years with the Arizona Diamondbacks as their Minor League Hitting Coordinator (2021) and ACL Hitting Coach (2022).
- Prior to coaching, he spent eight years playing professionally (2012-2019), spanning seven seasons in the Chicago Cubs organization (2012-18) and slashed .280/.361/.402 over 702 career MiLB games, reaching as high as Triple-A. He also played one season in independent baseball (2019) with the New Britain Bees in the Atlantic League, in addition to an offseason in the Mexican Pacific Winter League.
- Over 243 career Triple-A games with the Iowa Cubs, he played 11 games at Werner Park and was a .378 hitter (14-for-37) with one homer and 5 runs batted in while playing in Omaha.
- Rademacher lives in Tempe, Arizona with his wife Melissa.



BENCH COACH: DAVID NOWORYTA • #33 (3RD BASE COACH)

- David Noworyta (*Nova-REE-tah*) enters his second year in the Royals organization and first as Omaha's Bench Coach, after making his coaching debut in 2022 as the Assistant Hitting Coach for the River Bandits Kansas City's High-A affiliate.
- Prior to coaching, he spent four years playing professionally (2018-21), including three minor league seasons in the Detroit Tigers organization (2018-20), and one with the Independent Pioneer League's Billings Mustangs in 2021. Before signing with Detroit in 2018, Noworyta graduated from the University of Hawaii with a bachelor's degree in communications and journalism, and played in parts of three seasons for their baseball team.
- Noworyta attended Holy Cross Academy (N.J.), where he played baseball and basketball, and was selected by the Royals in the 37th round of the 2014 MLB Draft. He resides in Hainesport, N.J. in the offseason.



CERTIFIED ATHLETIC TRAINER: JAMES STONE

- James Stone is entering his fifth season as the Certified Athletic Trainer for the Storm Chasers after serving the previous seven seasons with the Wilmington Blue Rocks (Royals High-A), including the 2015 season, in which he was named Carolina League Athletic Trainer of the Year.
- He joined the Kansas City organization in 2010 as the athletic trainer for the Class-A Burlington Bees. He came to the Royals after spending one season with the Central Valley Coyotes (Fresno, California) in Arena Football 2.
- Stone worked three seasons in the Florida Marlins organization, with stops in Jupiter (2008), Greensboro (2007) and Jamestown (2006), winning New York-Penn League Trainer of the Year honors in 2006.
- He was the Strength and Conditioning Coach for the Baltimore Orioles Class-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, in 2005.
- Stone graduated with a bachelor's of science in kinesiology from Cal State-Northridge. He resides in Simi Valley, California with his dog, Ozzie.


