After a two-run double off the bat of Jonah Bride gave Jacksonville an early advantage in the bottom of the first frame, Andrés Alvarez smacked a bases-loaded, two-run single to center to tie the contest at two apiece. In the next at-bat, Liover Peguero followed with a go-ahead RBI single to give Indianapolis a lead it would not relinquish. The Indians' offense continued rolling with a pair of solo home runs from Matt Gorski and Joshua Palacios in the fourth and eighth innings, respectively. Palacios' long ball was his first of the season. It was the first time they have won three straight games since April 30-May 2 vs. Buffalo. Their longest winning streak of the season came in four games from April 4-6 (2) vs. Memphis. The last time the Indians won three consecutive games in a single road series was Sept. 13-15, 2023, at Omaha.</li> <li>ANOTHER ONE FOR ALVAREZ: Andrés Alvarez matched his career-high with four hits last night, going 4-for-4 and reaching base safely in all five of his plate appearances with a walk. Down by two runs in the top of the second inning, the infielder tied the game with a two-out, bases-loaded single through the heart of the infield. It was his second multi-hit game in his past three contests, and he leads the Indians with a two-out, bases-loaded single through the heart of the infield. In 11 June games, he is hitting .300 (12-for-40) with six runs, a triple, home run, five RBI, six walks and two stolen bases.</li> <li>JP GOES DEEP: In his third game back from the injured list, Joshua Palacios launched his first home run with Indianapolis this season to plate an insurance run in the eighth inning. He went 2-for-5 with a double and home run, marking his second multi-hit performance of the series after going 2-for-4 on Tuesday. The long ball was Palacios' third overall of the season after he hit two in four games of his rehab assignment with High-A Greensboro. In 21 total games this season between Single-A Bradenton, Greensboro and Indy, Palacios owns a .250 batting average (18-for-72) with eight runs, five doubles, three home runs and nine RBI. Countering for the Jumbo Shrimp will be Tuesday's starter, RHP Kyle Tyler (3-2, 3.32), who took a no-decision while logging his second consecutive outing of 6.0 shutout frames. <b>ROAD SERIES:</b> With wins in their last three games, the Indians have a chance to win their first road trip of the season in today's series finale. The Indians won three games in their last road trip at Iowa from May 21-26, going 3-3. It was the first time they had won more than one game in five road trips this season. <b>AFFILIATES TO ADVERSARIES:</b> This week marks the first time the Indians have played a team from Jacksonville since they last faced a different franchise in the International League during the 1963 season. The current Jacksonville franchise served under Indianapolis as the Double-A affiliate to the Montreal Expos from 1985-90, with a roster boasting future Hall of Famers Randy Johnson and Larry Walker before they became Indians. With the realignment of Minor League Baseball in 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp moved from the Double-A Southern League to the International League. <b>THIS DATE IN 2007:</b> Southpaw Shane Youman fanned 10 Durham Bulls over 7.1 one-run innings for the first 10-plus strikeout outing by an Indians pitcher in the 2007 season, and the first in consecutive days. With Youman's third win of the season, the Indians improved to 40-27 on the season. The next day, right-hander John Wasdin also stretched his outing into the eighth inning and fanned 12 batters, but the Indians lost via a four-run eighth inning 7-3.
