RAJCIC SHINES, CARDINALS EARN SPLIT WITH 3-2 WIN: Max Rajcic fired 6 innigns of one-run ball and relievers Nick Raquet and Matt Svanson slammed the door allowing just one run in three innings as the Cards defeated the Amarillo Sod Poodles 3-2 on Sunday to earn a split in the series finale at Hodgetown. All three of the Cardinal runs came in the 3rd inning on an RBI double by Matt Lloyd and a two-run double off the bat of Jeremy Rivas. Noah Mendlinger had two hits to extend his hitting streak to 10, and Nathan Church extended his streak to seven with a single in the seventh inning.



DPPDSING STARTER: Right-hander Logan Evans makes his fourth start of the season for the Travelers...Last pitched on Wednesday, April 17 at home against Frisco and got the win allowing a run on 4 H with 1 K over a season-high 6.0 IP...Threw 66 pitches, 39 for strikes...Took the loss on opening day against the Cardinals at Dickey-Stephens Park allowing an unearned run on 2 H over 4.0 IP with 3 BB, a HBP and 2 K...Springfield won the game, 6-1...Making just his 10th career start...Went 1-0 with a 0.75 era in 3 starts with the Modesto Nuts of the Low-A California League last season, racking up 13 K's and allowing just 7 H in 12.0 IP...Made two starts in the Arizona Complex League after signing with Seattle and allowed 3 H with 3 K in 3.0 scoreless innings...Selected by the Mariners in the 12th round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of Pittsburgh...As a junior with the Panthers went 5-3 with a 5.88 ERA in 11 appearances (9 starts)...Went 4-8 with a 7.42 ERA in 14 starts as a sophomore in 2022...Opponents batted .298 against the right-hander in his two seasons at Pitt...Spent his first two collegiate seasons (2020-21) at Penn State...Also played football and basketball in high school...22 years old

CARDINALS, TRAVELERS CLASH FOR SECOND TIME IN FOUR WEEKS: The Arkansas Travelers (Double-A, Seattle Mariners) make their first of two trips this season to Hammons Field for a six-game series. The Cardinals swept a three-game series in North Little Rock to start the 2024 campaign and went 7-5 against the Travelers at home last season.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME

For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

CARDS OFF TO BEST 15-GAME START SINCE 2008: With a 12-3 record over their first 15 games, the Cardinals are off to the Texas League's best 15-game start since 2008 when the Frisco RoughRiders also started 12-3. The Cards entered Saturday night's game 11-2, the best 13-game start since at least

The Cardinals opened the season with a 9-game winning streak, the longest in franchise history.

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: Cardinals outfielder Nathan Church was named Texas League Player of the Week after a big series in Amarillo. The UC Irvine product went 9-for-25 with 2 HR and 8 RBIs to go along with 6 BB. Church leads the Texas league in hits (22) and RBIs (15), and also ranks in the top 10 in batting average, OBP, SLG, OPS, total bases, and runs scored. In 71 plate appearances this year, he has struck out just four times.

REDMOND INCHING CLOSER TO SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: Cardinals slugger Chandler Redmond hit his 58th career home run with Springfield on Saturday night, bringing him to within one longball of the Cardinals' franchise record held by Xavier Scruggs (59). Redmond already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 202.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING!: With a two hits on Sunday afternoon, Cardinals utility man Noah Mendlinger extended his hitting streak to 10 games, second-longest on the club this season behind RJ Yeager's 11-gamer which ended with an 0-for-5 outing on Saturday night in Amarillo. Nathan Church is riding a 7-game hitting streak, and has hit safely in 13 of the 14 games he has played in so far this season.

TORRES ATOP OF LEADER BOARD IN HITTING, BAGS: After going 1-for-3 on Friday night and leaving the game early with an apparent injury, Cardinals OF Bryan Torres is leads the Texas League in batting average among qualified hitters with a mark of .381. His 7 SB is tied for 3rd in the league lead behind Jakob Marsee of the San Antonio Missions and Emmaunel Rodriguez of the Wichita Wind Surge. **Torres** racked up 71 bags for the Milwaukee Milkmen of the American Association in 2023. Torres also leads the league among active Texas League players in OBP after the promotion of Emmanuel Rodriguez from Wichita to Triple-A St. Paul at .462.

BIRDS' BATS TOP TEXAS LEAGUE EARLY: Springfield's lineup sits atop the league in several offensive categories. Through 15 games the Cardinals lead the Texas League with a .287 batting average, a mark that also leads all of Double-A; the Bowie Baysox are next with a .278 average. The Cards also lead the Texas League in OBP (.384), OPS (.790), RBIs (87) and runs scored (94). Springfield has also been particularly prodcutive hitting situationally, with a league-high 9 sacrifice flies this season.

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats. The Cardinals have struck out just 108 times in 15 games, the 2nd-fewest total in MiLB. The Fresno Grizzlies have K'd the fewest times in the minor leagues (103), but have also done it in just 13 games, two less than Springfield. The Cards are averaging just 7.2 K's per game.

VICTIMS OF THE LONG BALL: Despite an overall solid season so far in which the Cardinal pitching staff has posted a 4.02 ERA, the Birds have fallen victim to the home run ball early in the 2024 season. Springfield pitchers have allowed 17 HR so far this year, second most in the Texas League behind the Amarillo Sod Poodles, who have allowed 19.

FAMILIAR FACES: Of the 28 players on the Cardinals' Opening Day roster, 13 donned a Springfield uniform in 2023. Of the newcomers, only two Cards, Bryan Torres (Richmond, 2021) and Matt Lloyd (Chattanooga, 2021-22), have Double-A experience. Slugger **Chandler Redmond** returns for another season in Springfield after coming up one home run shy of the SprIngfield franchise record in 2023 with 31 longballs. Redmond also sits two home runs shy of Springfield's franchise career record of 59 by Xavier Scruggs.


