PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today's game 29 games over .500 with an overall 73-44 record (.624 winning percentage).

- 73 wins are the 2nd-most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, just behind 74 from the Sugar Land Space Cowboys, Houston's Triple-A affiliate.
- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .624 winning percentage overall this year is the 2nd-best in the Minors ... the top team in Minor League Baseball is Sugar Land (.627).
- The Storm Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.
- Omaha is currently on pace for 92 wins ... the franchise record is 86 wins from the Omaha Royals in 1990 ... the best winning percentage in Triple-A Omaha history was .607 (85-55) in the inaugural 1969 season ... over 54 seasons of Triple-A Omaha baseball, there have been seven 80-win seasons, most recently the 2012 (83 wins) and 2015 (80 wins) Storm Chasers.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

71 of Omaha's 117 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less (61%), including 28 of 44 losses in 2024, with 15 of 44 losses by just one run (34%).

- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 12 of its last 24 save opportunities, since June 5 (50%).
- Omaha is 22-15 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as tied for the 4th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team ... two teams lead MiLB with 24 1-run wins.
- Omaha's 32 saves are tied for the most in the league, tied 2nd-most at the Triple-A level and tied 8th in the Minors ... Evan Sisk has recorded the team's last 6 saves.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

- Omaha has outscored its opponents 648 to 520 this season, a +128 run differential.
- A +128 run differential this year ranks as the both the mark in the International League and at the Triple-A level as well, well ahead of Tacoma (+104).
- Omaha is 7th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers lead the Minors in run differential at +146 (575 to 429).

COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 40 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (55%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.

- Omaha has trailed for 3 innings or more in 16 of the 40 comeback wins.
- The Storm Chasers have 6 wins where the club had to overcome multiple deficits.
- Omaha has 11 victories in games where the Chasers trailed after the 6th inning.
- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 11 occasions.

KICKSTART MY GAME

Storm Chaser starting pitchers have been some of the best in Triple-A in August.

- Omaha's starters have combined for a 2.19 ERA (19 ER in 78.0 IP) over 15 games this month, best in Triple-A this month ... a 1.01 WHIP is also the best in Triple-A.
- Omaha has a quality start in 6 of 15 games this month, with 2 each from Daniel Lynch IV and Noah Cameron ... 11 of 15 August starts have been at least 5.0 innings.
- 78.0 innings this month from Omaha's starters rank as the 5th-most in Minor League Baseball ... in the 2nd half, 28 of Omaha's 44 starts have been at least 5.0 innings.

WEEKEND AT STORMY'S

Throughout 2024, weekend games have been Omaha's strongest time of the week but especially so recently.

- Omaha has combined to go 30-8 in Saturday & Sunday games in 2024.
- Over the last five weeks, the Storm Chasers have kept a near-perfect 10-1 record on Saturday and Sunday dating back to July 13 and the team has gone 12-2 on those two days in the second half of the season.
- Since July 13, Omaha has outscored its opponents 88-29 in the weekend games.
- Omaha has won Saturday AND Sunday in 13 of the team's 16 6-game series this year.

TODAY'S START

- Cameron is making his 4th start with Omaha and his 20th overall start this season ... after opening the season in Double-A with NW Arkansas, Noah made 16 starts for the Naturals before being promoted to Omaha on Sunday, July 28.
In 2024, ranked tied 1st among Royals Minor League pitchers in strikeouts (110), tied 4th in starts (19) and 8th in innings pitched (93.2) ... among qualified Royals full-season arms, ranks 3rd in ERA (3.17), 7th in WHIP (1.26) and 10th in opponents' average (.251).
Ranked by MLB Pipeline as the No. 12 Royals prospect ... Ranked by Baseball America as the No. 14 Royals prospect.

LAST OUTING: TUESDAY, AUGUST 13 VS. LOUISVILLE

Made his 3rd Triple-A start and threw his 3rd quality start with Omaha, his 5th quality start of 2024 ... opened the game with 6 scoreless innings, including 1-2-3 innings in the 3rd and 6th ... allowed his first walk since July 11 (29.2 IP) in the 4th inning ... allowed a 1-out homer in the 7th to P.J. Higgins, got the 2nd out of the 7th but allowed a two-out single and was removed, took a no-decision.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Started opening day for Double-A Northwest Arkansas, but took the loss, allowed 2 earned runs over 4.2 innings on April 5 vs. Tulsa (LAD) ... finished 5.0 innings in 10 of 16 starts with the Naturals, including five straight after the season opener.
On the Injured List from May 10 to May 30 with left forearm tightness, only missed 18 games.
Threw a pair of quality starts with NWA: June 29 @ Wichita (MIN) and July 19 vs. Tulsa (LAD), both within the span of his last 5 at the Double-A level ... struck out 7+ on 6 occasions ... worked 3 scoreless starts with NW Arkansas.
Compiled a streak of 29.1 inning without walking a batter between July 11 (3rd inning) and August 13 (3rd inning) ... streak spanned 4 full starts (last 2 in AA, first 2 in AAA) and parts of 2 more starts ... his previous best in 2024 was 8.0 innings in April.

CAREER NOTES

- Split the season between Quad Cities (A+) and NW Arkansas (AA) and combined to go 5-12 over 24 starts between the two levels, with a 5.28 ERA (63 ER in 107.1 IP) and 132 strikeouts to just 35 walks (3.77 K/BB).
Ranked 3rd among Royals Minor League pitchers in strikeouts (132), tied 4th in starts (24) and tied 9th in innings pitched (107.1) ... among those in the system with at least 100.0 innings pitched, ranked 1st in K/9 (11.07) and K/BB (3.77).
In High-A, walked just 9 to 58 strikeouts (6.44 K/BB), but after being promoted to Double-A on May 19, walked 26 compared to 74 strikeouts (2.85 K/BB) with NWA.
Made the first 4 quality starts of his professional career, two with each the River Bandits and Naturals ... in his Double-A debut on May 24 at Tulsa (LAD), threw a career-high 7.0 shutout innings with just 3 hits and 1 walk allowed and 6 strikeouts.
After taking a no-decision in his Double-A debut, lost his next seven NWA starts, between May 30 and July 20 ... in that span where he went 0-7, produced a 8.03 ERA (22 ER in 24.2 IP) with a .317 opponents' average (32-for-101).

- Made his professional debut and largely split the season between Columbia (A) and Quad Cities (A+), with a stint on the 7-Day Injured List and rehab stint with the ACL Royals (R) as well ... between the three levels, combined to go 2-3 across 19 starts, with a 3.56 ERA (26 ER in 65.2 IP) with 16 walks to 99 strikeouts (6.19 K/BB).
Named a Royals MiLB.com Organization All-Star, tied for 7th in the system in strikeouts (99) ... among Royals Minor Leaguers with at least 60.0 innings, ranked 1st in K/9 (13.57), K/BB, 9% (36.7%) and had the 2nd-lowest WHIP (1.13) and 3rd-lowest ERA.
