DON'T HOLD ANYTHING BACK - The Wichita Wind Surge will be the final game of the 2026 season. Wichita is 3-2 in season finale games and 4-1 in home finales. Since the All-Star Break, Wichita is 26-25. Wichita will finish with the fewest wins in club history, the team was 58-80 in 2024. Only five teams have fewer wins than Wichita in all of MiLB this season and the 55 wins are fewest in Class AA and only four teams have fewer than the 27 home wins. No Wind Surge team has ever lost greater than 80 games, this team has dropped 80 this season.

VS RIDERS - Wichita won five of six in Frisco in August and lead 2026 season series 8-3. In 2025 the Surge won eight of 12 in the head-to-head matchups. The all-time series has Wichita leading 34-24. In a weird twist Wichita will also host Frisco for the first three games of the 2027 season.

THE CLOSING CHAPTER - The Wind Surge will play their 806th game tonight, the franchise all-time record is 400 wins and 405 losses. The Wind Surge era closes on today. The 2027 season will bring the club will be officially rebranded as the Turbo Tubs.

THE HIT PARADE - In the series at Tulsa, Wichita has out-hit Tulsa 60-41 but were outscored 38-31 and lost five of six games. Wichita has recorded double-digit hits in 22 of its last 50 games and 38 times this season. The team is third in league in that span with 65 home runs, fifth in average. The Surge hitters are not the only ones that flipped the page after the break, Wichita pitching has third best ERA at 4.35 in league over 50 games.

POWER SURGE - The Wind Surge set a new franchise record with most home runs in a season, passing the previous record of 171, set in 2025. The team has 186 home runs, second in the league trailing Tulsa. Wichita led the league last season with a franchise record 171 home runs for the season. The Surge have nine players with double digit homers, a new club record, previous 8 in 2023. The Surge have 15 multi home run games this season. The team has seven grand slam's, one shy of the club record. (Eight, 2025).

SWIPE EM- The Wind Surge set a new stolen base record. The Surge have stolen 237 bases surpassing the previous record of 211 in 2023.

ON THE HILL: Preston Johnson gets the ball for Wichita, his 18th start, 24th game of season. In his last outing he pitched 4 innings allowed two runs in relief vs Frisco. He has named the Texas League pitcher of the Week twice, July 12 and August 10. Overall, Johnson has given up three runs or less in 12 of 15 starts. Finished an impressive August, six games, 25 innings a 1.44 ERA.

PUNCH OUT! - The Wind Surge have 60 games this season with double-digit strikeouts. As a team Wind Surge pitchers have the 7th highest total with 1,244 strikeouts in TL. The club record is 1,311 in 2022. Wichita has matched a club record with three arms that have 100+ strikeouts this season, Sam Armstrong, Preston Johnson, Cory Lewis. The 2025 team had zero and the previous three seasons one pitcher per year. The 2021 team also had three pitchers, Louis Varland, Austin Schuler, and Jordan Balazovic.

SURGE WIN IN FRONT OF BIG HOUSE - The Wichita Wind Surge (30-38) earned a 5-1 victory over the Frisco RoughRiders (33-35) in game five of a six-game series Saturday night at Equity Bank Park, backed by five scoreless innings from Adrian Bohorquez. The crowd of 10,512 is the largest of the season and fourth largest in ballpark history. The Wichita pitching staff was dominant, allowing just one run on four hits. Bohorquez opened the night with five scoreless innings before Sam Armstrong followed with three scoreless frames of his own. Frisco plated its lone run in the ninth before Luis Quiñones recorded the final three outs to secure the victory. Offensively, Graham Brown and Quinn McDaniel led the way with multi-hit performances. Kyle DeBarge drove in a pair of runs, while Marek Houston extended his on-base streak to nine games.

A FULL HOUSE OF MAGIC - The crowd of 10,512 last night was the largest crowd ever to attend a Wind Surge game and the fourth largest crowd in ballpark history. The top four crowds happened this year as the three largest attendances are the three Banana Ball games in May and last night. Ten of the top 42 crowds ever were this season and the attendance of 283,370 this season ranks fourth in the league and third most in franchise history.

HOUSTON, WE HAVE LIFT OFF- Marek Houston extended his on-base streak to nine games. ...Houston has 50 stolen bases this season, 26 with Wichita. Since July 1, he has the 5th most hits in the league, 10th in runs and leads with stolen bases. His 31 game on base streak from June 28-Aug 8 is the longest in Surge history and the third longest in the Texas League this season.

THE PEN- Wichita relievers have pitched a league leading 663.1 innings so far this season. An average of 5 plus innings per game. The teams pen has earned the win in 47 of the 54 team wins, the bullpen has a 5.74 ERA 9th in TL, starters lead the league at 4.47, Surge starters are 7-40, fewest wins in the league, next closest team has 19. Ty Langenberg allowed one run over six innings Thursday night. Langenberg's six-inning start was the longest outing by a Wind Surge pitcher this season. It was also the first Quality Start of the season.

ALTERNATE LOOKS- The Wind Surge are 1-3 this season as the Honkers, 4-13 at Tubs and dropped to 1-5 as the Tumba Vacas and 5-8 in miscellaneous.

ICT NOTES - Kyle DeBarge extended his on-base streak to nine games and drove in two runs. 48 of the Wind Surge 55 wins the team has scored five runs or more.. The Surge have been outscored 121-75 in the 6th inning this season...Garrett Spain is 8th in XBH 8th in runs, 10th in Total Bases, and Kyle DeBarge is 4th with 34SB. The Surge are 14-20 in one run games. Wichita is 9th in the league in batting average, 4th in walks, 1st HBP (6th in all of MiLB), and 9th in ERA, and have allowed the most SB's in all of AA. The team has 113 errors, 10th most in the league.

LIGHT THE KENDLE - Caden Kendle on-base streak ended at seven games and launched his 10th and 11th home runs of the season on Tuesday, joining the Surge Double Digit Club. Kendle recorded his 20th multi-hit performance of the season and tied his Double-A career high with four RBIs. Kendle logged his first multi-homer game at the Double-A level. He has been on base in 41 of his 45 games.

CENTURY MARK FOR NICO- Wichita Wind Surge manager Nico Giarratano won his 100th career game on July 12, 2026 vs NW Arkansas. The manager has a career record of: 125-127

TO THE SHOW! – Emmanuel Rodriguez got the call today, becoming the 52nd player. Ben Ross joined the Minnesota Twins on September 1st, becoming the 51st Wind Surge player to make it to Major League Baseball and the second from this years team, joining Mike Paredes. Nine players from the 2025 team have made their MLB debut this season. The 2026 Twins debuts are Andrew Morris, Connor Prielipp, John Klein, Gabby Gonzalez, Mike Paredes, Tyler Fedko, Marco Raya, Kaelen Culpepper, Walker Jenkins and Ben Ross. Tanner Andrews made his MLB debut with the defending AL Champion Toronto Blue Jays.

AWARD WINNING - The Wichita Wind Surge had five Texas League awards during the season, Ricardo Olivar - Player of the Week- 4/27, Preston Johnson – Pitcher of the Week- 7/12, Marek Houston – Player of the Week- 7/27, Preston Johnson – Pitcher of the Week- 8/10, Ty Langenberg – Pitcher of the Month – August.

MORE HONOURS – The Minnesota Twins named Ben Ross Minor League Player of the Month for April, and Adrian Bohorquez August Pitcher of the Month.

FLY EAGLE FLY – Andrew Cossetti became the franchise record holder for walks with 172 and is amongst the leagues top six. He also is second in club history with 40 home runs.

MLB LEAD OFF BOMBS!- Emmanuel Rodriguez made his MLB debut on Saturday and homered in his first at bat, it's the fourth former Surge player to accomplish the feat. Spencer Steer, Matt Wallner, Kaelen Culpepper and now Emma.

THE TIME IS NOW- Jaylen Nowlin moved to the top of the charts for most games pitched in (109), strikeouts (255) and tied for third with 14 all-time wins.

ATTENDANCE – Wichita will finish fourth in the Texas League in attendance and will be third best season in club history. Ten of the top 42 attendances of all – time happened this season plus the three straight Banana Ball games, which would make it the most fans in the ballpark in a single season.

SALAMI SANDWICH - The Wichita Wind Surge have crushed eight grand slams this season, led by Andrew Cossetti's three.

RUCK EM UP – Jake Rucker returned to the team and is tops in hits, doubles, XBH, total bases, runs and finished the season with 199 career Wind Surge RBI, tops in club history.

THE RUN FOR THE ROSES - Aaron Rozek returned for a sixth season, the only player to have appeared in uniform in all six seasons of Wind Surge baseball. He is the all-time leader in wins (16).

FOR THE WIN – Brandon Winokur scored a run in nine straight games, August 18-27. It's the second longest in club history (10) and third longest this season in The Texas League.

GETTING ON BASE – Marek Houston set a new franchise record with a 31 game on base streak from June 28-Aug 8 is the longest in Surge history and the third longest in the Texas League this season.

THE HIT MAN- Khadim Diaw 17 game hit streak from July 11- August 6th fell one game short of the club record, Tanner Schobel (18). The team had four players have streaks of 12 or more this season.

A HOMER OF A DAY (MAY 7) - The Wind Surge have had two players hit three home runs in a game, both of happened on May 7th! Garrett Spain hit three home runs on May 7th at Amarillo, Carson McCusker hit three in Wichita on May 7, 2023 vs Arkansas.

HISTORY CRUSHED – Wichita's 10 home runs set a modern-day record for Texas League games played in regulation ball parks. Dating back to 2005, there have only been four other teams to reach that mark in a game, most recently done by Triple-A Omaha on August 23, 2025. The overall TL record of 21 set by Corsicana vs Texarkana on June 15, 1902 was set in a ball park in Ennis, Texas that had short fences. It was played there due to blue laws in Corsicana that didn't allow Sunday baseball. The previous record set in a regulation field was 9 set by Paris vs Corsicana, May 14, 1903, played in Corsicana and tied by Tulsa vs Amarillo, May 17, 2022. Yesterday's game tied the home runs between two teams record on a regulation field of 13 Tulsa (9) vs Amarillo (4), May 17, 2022, Wichita(10) vs Amarillo (3), May 7, 2026. The Tulsa vs Amarillo game was also played in Amarillo.

THE YELLOW HIGHLIGHTER - Wichita had many memorable highlights last week in the yellow city of Amarillo. The team set a new franchise record with 10 home runs in a single game. Previous record was 7, happened three times in club history. Also set a franchise record with 19 runs scored in a game, 18 had been record (7/27/21) at NW Arkansas.

THE COMEBACK- The five run ninth inning deficit on August 25th, matched the largest comeback of the season, the teams largest comeback ever was a seven run deficit on July 6, 2025 vs Tulsa. The walk-off win is the 8th against the Arkansas Travelers in six seasons. The Wind Surge win their 3rd game when trailing after 8 innings and second time in a week.

ROAD W's – The Wind Surge set a new season high and franchise record, seven game road win streak on Saturday night in Frisco, the prior record of six straight August 18-31, 2021.

MAN OF THE PEOPLE- Andrew Cossetti was named by the Minnesota Twins and Wichita Wind Surge as the 2026 recipient of the Harmon Killebrew Award for Community Service.

THE DUST BOWL – Wichita dropped 37 of 46 games from May 19- July 11 and were outscored 317-212 in the stretch.

BOMBS AWAY - The Wind Surge hit a franchise home-record eight home runs on Sunday July 26th, the most in a home game in club history, Ten different Wind Surge players recorded at least one hit on Sunday and the 19 hits is the season high.

HO HO HO A NO NO- A trio of pitchers dealt the franchise second no-hitter on July 25, 2026 and their first since Aug. 19, 2022, against Tulsa. Wichita recorded the first and only no-hitter in the Texas League this season. Chris Vallimont, Darren Bowen and Ruddy Gomez combined in the effort.

RUNNING WILD - Wichita stole a season-high eight bases on August 6th in Northwest Arkansas. The franchise record for stolen bases is nine, July 3, 2025 vs Tulsa. The team did set a franchise record for most stolen bases in a season in 2026.

FAREWELL BILLY - The MLB trade deadline hit the Wichita Wind Surge and the team leader in home runs and RBI was dealt to the NY Mets organization. His season is one to remember as he is fourth in the league in HR, fourth in RBI, 7th in extra base hits. The 23 homers and 72 RBI are the second highest in a season for Wichita. The club record for home runs and RBI in a season is 25 hammered last season by Kalai Rosario with 83 RBI.

WHAT A STRANGE WEEKEND – The Surge won five of six at home vs Midland from July 21-26, the team fired a no hitter, had an eight home run game.... Scored a run on the benefit of a Texas League record 4 balks in an inning and a game where three Wind Surge people were ejected by three different umpires.

THE FORCE HAS BEEN WITH WICHITA - The team improved to an incredible 6-0 on Star Wars night. The team has two walk off wins and pitched a no hitter. The crowd of 8,379 on Star Wars Night was the largest crowd of 2026 and 11th of all time. Three Star Wars Nights are in the top 30 attendances of all time.

WBC - The World Baseball Classic (WBC) was played prior to the 2026 season. The Surge had six former Wichita Wind Surge players participating representing four different teams. Aaron Whitefield – Australia, Jordan Balazovic – Canada, Edouard Julien – Canada, Tyler Viza - Great Britain, Jovani Moran - Puerto Rico, Ricardo Velez - Puerto Rico. 2026 Surge pitcher Luis Quiones also pitched in the event for Puerto Rico.

MID SUMMER CLASSIC – Former Wind Surge pitcher Louie Varland was named to the American League All Star team. It's the second Wind Surge alumni to play as Yennier Cano pitched in the 2023 game.

THE FUTURE! A pair of former Wind Surge players will be represented in the 2026 MLB Futures Game! Kaelen Culpepper and Walker Jenkins. Culpepper didn't play due to injury.

A WILD ROSTER DAY – The Surge made 11 roster moves in a two day stretch on May 19-20 and for the first time in club history received a player from all levels of the Twins Organization. FCL, Fort Myers, Cedar Rapids and St Paul.

FLUSH THE MOUSE Wichita set a franchise record by losing ten in a row from June 25-July 5 and matched it again dropping ten in a row from August 26-September 5th.

JUNE BLUES – The team finished the month with five wins in the month of June, fewest wins, most losses in a month in franchise history (5-20). Its also the fewest wins for the month amongst all MiLB teams. The team was outlit in 18 of the 28 games and batted .208 with RISP for the month (48x230). The month with fewest wins/most losses had been April 2024 (7-15).
