### GAME RECAP:

The Reading Fightin Phils routed the Akron RubberDucks 12-3 under the Friday night lights at Canal Park. The R-Phils went tit-for-tat with Akron's run scoring before coming alive in the fifth and sixth innings. Jhailyn Ortiz hit two home runs in back-to-back at-bats to opposite sides of the ballpark. Every player in the lineup got on base tonight and all but one scored a run.

### UNUSUAL OFF TIME:

The R-Phils will have two consecutive off days this Sunday and Monday. Akron slated a doubleheader for Saturday to rest on Easter Sunday and Monday will be the on-going off day throughout the season. Other than the All-Star break in late July, this is the only time the R-Phils will have two scheduled off days consecutively.

### SWINGING STREAK:

Three players have hit streaks greater than three games going into Sunday's contest. Jonathan Guzman and Madison Stokes have gotten hits in five consecutive games, while Wendell Rijo has notched a hit in six straight contests.

### ORTIZ EXPLODES:

The Phillies #12 prospect, Jhailyn Ortiz launched two balls to opposite sides of the field last night. The last time a Fightin had two homers in teh same game was on August 22, 2021 when Matt Kroon had two long balls versus Bowie. Ortiz recorded a team-high five RBI. This was the first time a player had done this since Darick Hall did so against New Hampshire on April 25, 2019.

### RIJO RUNS:

Wendell Rijo has put up big numbers so far this summer, but keep an eye on his base running speed. Last night, Rijo stole two bases to get himself into scoring position. Prior to this season, he had swiped a career 62 bases.

### BIG LEAGUE CLUB WATCH:

The Phillies fell to the Miami Marlins 7-1 with the only run coming off of Nick Castellanos. Zach Eflin took the loss giving up six hits and four earned. Simon Muzziotti got the start in centerfield making a very impressive catch against the wall. He also recorded a hit, along with teammate Matt Vierling who notched his first of the season.

### ON THIS DAY IN BASEBALLTOWN HISTORY:

**April 16, 2018:** At Harrisburg, Ranger Suarez picks up his first Double-A victory as the Fightin Phils blank the Senators, 6-0. Suarez allows 6 hits and strikes out 10 over 8.0 innings and does not issue a walk. Zach Coppola goes 3-for-5 with 2 runs and a stolen base while Kyle Martin connects for a grand slam in the 5th inning.
