LAST GAME

The Baysox took down the Harrisburg Senators by an 11-2 final Thursday afternoon. Bowie jumped out early and plated three runs before even recording an out, as Heston Kjerstad launched his ninth home run of the season on the game's first pitch, before Cesar Prieto tripled home Coby Mayo following a walk, and then scored himself on an RBI double from Zach Watson. The Baysox would continue to pile on, as Mayo and Prieto clobbered back-to-back home runs to open the third inning - chasing Senators' starter Alex Troop after three frames. Bowie would have continued success against the Harrisburg bullpen, as Mayo would add his second RBI of the game off a double in the fourth. Billy Cook, Anthony Servideo, and Noelberth Romero added RBI hits in the fifth. Finally, Zach Watson would triple home his second RBI of the day in the sixth, before crossing the plate himself on a Donta' Williams ground out. On the mound, Harrisburg was held in check by Cade Povich, who pitched five shutout frames with 10 strikeouts for the second time this season for Bowie in the victory.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Harrisburg Senators enter tonight at a record of 13-16. The Double-A affiliate of the Washington Nationals, the Senators currently occupy 5th place in the Southwest division, but are just three games behind first place Richmond. Harrisburg has a .211 team average and has hit the fewest home runs (17) of any team in the Eastern League, but has also allowed the second-fewest (19) to go along with a 4.19 staff ERA. The Senators' roster is highlighted by the No. 2 Nationals prospect and No. 30 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, Robert Hassell III, who recently returned from the injured list. He is one of five Top 30 Nationals prospects on the Harrisburg roster, including right-handed pitchers Jackson Rutledge (No. 11 WSH) and Gerrardo Carrillo (No. 28 WSH), along with left-hander Mitchell Parker (No. 24 WSH) and catcher Drew Millas (No. 30 WSH). The Senators are led by first-year manager Delino DeShields, who has prior coaching and management experience through the various levels of the Reds' organization, in addition to be a former player for the Orioles' organization and playing for the Baysox in 1999.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Michael Cuevas is Harrisburg's projected starter tonight. He's allowed 15 runs (13 earned) through his 20.1 innings thus far in 2023, via 21 hits, 12 walks, and 15 strikeouts. Cuevas has been susceptible to hard contact and walks in the early part of the season, and that has limited the length of his first five starts at times. However, last time out on Sunday against New Hampshire, the right-hander fired five innings and only allowed a single, unearned run, though he did walk four batters to go along with three hits and three strikeouts. Cuevas has progressed steadily through the Nationals' system, progressing a level each year of his professional career. Last season, his 24 starts at High-A Wilmington were most on the Washington farm, while his 114.1 innings were fourth. Cuevas is still only 21, as he was drafted in the 23rd round by the Nationals in 2019 out of Brennan High School in San Antonio, Texas.

OFFENSIVE OUTBURST

The bats broke out in a big way for Bowie in Thursday's 11-2 victory. After managing just three runs in the first two games of the series, and going 1-for-17 with runners in scoring position, leaving a combined 17 runners on base, the Baysox posted their second-highest run and hit total of the season on Thursday. 11 of the 15 Bowie hits were for extra bases, including four triples. The 11 extra-base knocks tied for the most in an Eastern League contest since the Baysox had 12 extra-base hits against Reading on August 29, 2019. Bowie was also the last Eastern League team to have four triples in a game - on May 18 of that same year against Erie.

HESTON IS BESTON

OF/1B Heston Kjerstad has shown out as one of the top bats in the Eastern League so far this season. Kjerstad launched his ninth home run of the season Thursday, as he currently sits second in the Eastern League in that category. Beyond the home runs, the Orioles' No. 5 prospect has also demonstrated plenty offensive consistency - sitting second in the Eastern League in slugging percentage (.657) and OPS (1.042) among qualifiers, while also ranking second in extra-base hits (16) and total bases (67). Kjerstad is tied for the league lead with three triples. Kjerstad has the most home runs and the extra-base hits throughout the Orioles' system, while his slugging percentage is tops on the farm and his OPS ranks third Kjerstad's standout start to the season earned him Orioles Minor League Player of the Month honors for April.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with his 44 hits and a .398 batting average - 69 points above the next-highest qualified average. Prieto is currently riding a nine game hitting streak, while registering multiple hits in his past six starts. Yesterday was Prieto's first four hit performance, as, he finished a double shy of the cycle. It was his sixth game with at least three hits, and he now has 14 multi-hit contests in his first 28 games of 2023. Prieto has shown recent pop as well, with five extra-base hits in his past five games, increasing his slugging percentage (.558) and OPS (.996) to fifth in the Eastern League. Prieto had an 11-game hitting streak last month, which stands as the second-longest in the Eastern League this season and is also the longest streak for any Orioles minor leaguer. Prieto's leads the Baltimore farm in both average and hits as well.

QUICK JUMP

While Bowie has had their issues in bringing runners home, (their batting average with runners in scoring position is the third-lowest in the league) they've still been able to put good work in against starting pitchers. While Bowie has scored the third-fewest runs in the league, they still have the best batting average in the first inning of games this season (.300), and the third-most runs (18).

- Record the fifth-most strikeouts and the second-most starts in the Orioles' system in 2022, all while throwing the second-most innings and giving up the most hits.
- Was a part of the 11th no-hitter in Baysox history on 5/8 against Harrisburg, alongside Morgan McSweeney – pitched six of the seven innings in what was the front end of a doubleheader, allowing just two walks.

CAREER NOTES

- Gave up the second-highest batting average and slugging percentage amongst Baysox arms with at least 30 innings.
- Shifted to the bullpen in July from the rotation after allowing 43 runs in 17 innings from 5/27-6/26. Proceed to win Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month in July, pitching to a 1.46 ERA in 5 appearances (1 start), which included a career-high 10 strikeouts in 4 innings against Richmond on 7/2.
- Held right-handed hitters to a .236 average, as opposed to a .345 average for right-handers. Held opponents to a .176 average in 19 innings as a reliever.
- Began 2021 season in High-A Aberdeen with a 4.39 ERA in 80 innings before being promoted to Bowie on 8/17.
- Traded to the Orioles in December of 2020 in the Jose Iglesias deal alongside fellow Orioles farmhand Jean Pinto.
- Never made an appearance for the Angels' organization after being drafted by them in the fifth round of the 2020 draft.
- Orioles EVP/GM Mike Elias had targeted Stallings in the 2020 draft but was taken earlier by the Angels.
- Threw two complete game shutouts in his junior season at Tennessee. He earned two SEC Pitcher of the Week awards, and was also named to the 2019 SEC All-Defensive team

NOTES BY OUTING*

- Struck out three of the first seven batters faced, but allowed a single and home run to the first two batters of the third inning. Later allowed a triple, but a double play at home prevented a run.
- Thanks to a double play, faced the minimum over his 14 batters. Both hits were singles, and neither reached second base.
- Two of three hits allowed were home runs, including one to the second batter of the game.
- Relieved Peter Van Loon in second game of a DH. After retiring the first batter, gave up four-straight hits, including a triple and two-run home run. Allowed first three batters to reach in the following inning as well.
- Relieved Van Loon again, allowed seven hits to the first eight batters he saw, including another home run.

Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series.
