RIDERS FALL IN TIGHT BATTLE WITH CARDINALS:

The Frisco RoughRiders rallied in the ninth inning but dropped a 3-2 decision to the Springfield Cardinals on Thursday night in front of 6,060 fans at Riders Field. Springfield (34-32) took a 3-0 lead after scoring runs in the third and fourth innings. Frisco (28-37) threatened in multiple innings down the stretch but only got one run in the sixth and ninth innings. **Kellen Strahm** singled and scored in the ninth to make it a one-run game. **Scott Kapers** had the RBI on his single, **Jax Biggers** pinch ran and got to second on a wild pitch but was stranded there. Andre Granillo pitched the ninth inning with one run allowed for the save. Logan Gragg (2-4) went six innings with one run conceded for the win. **Ryan Garcia** (2-6) allowed three runs in 3.1 innings to suffer the loss. Strahm's single extended his hitting streak to 12 games, while **Thomas Saggese** upped his streak to 11 games on Thursday night. He doubled in the first inning, singled for an RBI in the sixth, and also drew a walk. His base hit scored Luisangel Acuña, who had singled earlier in the inning. The Frisco bullpen kept the game close, totaling 5.2 innings without a run. Alex Speas entered with the bases loaded and one out in the fourth inning, allowed just one run on a fielder's choice and struck out the next batter on a 102-mile-an-hour fastball. **Justin Slaten** followed with two scoreless innings, including three strikeouts. **Theo McDowell** pitched a hitless eighth inning and **Antoine Kelly** put up a zero in the ninth.

IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

Outfielder Kellen Strahm has been hot lately, hitting safely in 12-straight games while batting .347 (17-for-49)/.407/.429/.836 with one double, one home run, five RBIs, seven runs, five walks and a steal. Over the last 12 games, he has raised his average from .200 to .234 and his OPS from .612 to .662.

RISP-ECT THIS:

This season, the Riders are just eighth in the 10-team Texas League in batting average with runners in scoring position, hitting .250, though Frisco is fourth with 252 RBIs with RISP. Over the last eight games (2-6 record), Frisco is hitting just .218 (17-for-78) in those situations.

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over a 11-game hitting streak, Saggese is hitting .435 (20-for-46)/.491/.783/1.274 with two doubles, four home runs, 13 RBIs, five walks, nine runs scored and a steal. Among those who have played at least 50 games, Saggese is first on the team with a .302 batting average and .842 OPS.

THE SPEAS THAT PLEASES:

Reliever **Alex Speas** now has an ERA under 1.00 at 0.68 over 22 appearances. In 26.2 innings, he has struck out 45 to 12 walks. Opponents are hitting just .140 against him and he has not allowed an earned run over his last 13 outings. During that span, he has struck out 30 to five walks over 16.1 innings. On the season, righties are just hitting .121 (8-for-66) against him on the season with a .374 OPS.

POWER SURGE:

After only hitting two home runs over a two-week span, the RoughRiders have hit 16 long balls over their last 15 games. In the 15 games, Frisco is hitting .252/.351/.410/.761 with 27 doubles, 16 home runs and averaging 5.5 runs per game. **Thomas Saggese** led the way, batting .355 (22-for-62)/.417/.661/1.078 and has hit five home runs, the second most in the league over that span (Jorge Bonifacio with Northwest Arkansas,

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, tied for first in the Texas League with a .600 average (12-for-20) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.619 OPS on the first pitch after homering on the first pitch on Saturday, which is second in the league. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .455 (20-for-44) on the initial offering while his 20 hits on the first pitch lead the league.

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 29 and is on pace for a career-best 61 swipes. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League steals with 96 bases in 112 attempts (85 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE, AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season on last Friday. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese (2)).

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .301 (74-for-246)/.366/.447/.813 through the first 57 games. Over his last 52 games, he is batting .311/.380/.469/.849. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (116).

On the season, Frisco's 322 walks are tied for first among Texas League teams while their .352 team OBP is third in the Texas League. **Dustin** Harris is still first in the league with 44 walks despite being promoted to Triple-A Round Rock on Tuesday.
