THAT WAS CRAZY: After getting in the win column for the first time in 2025 last night via a walk-off home run from Jackson Ross, the FredNats look to make it two straight victories tonight against Salem. RHP Davian Garcia makes his first professional start and second appearance after pitching 1.2 scoreless relief innings on Saturday at Carolina. Garcia managed to work around three walks issued to avoid allowing a run. Washington's sixth round draft pick out of Florida Gulf Coast faces Salem righty Steven Brooks, who makes his professional debut tonight after being drafted by Boston in the 11th round last summer out of Cal Poly.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Jackson Ross's walk-off homer delivered an 9-8 victory for FXBG on a chilly Opening Night at VACU Stadium. On the mound, Fredericksburg struck out 15 Sox while issuing only three walks. Five hitters had RBIs in the game, and the FredNat bullpen covered the final 7.1 innings allowing only one earned run. Kevin Dowdell, Austin Amaral, Erik Tolman and Merrick Baldo pieced it together after a short start from Angel Roman in which he allowed six runs in one inning.

LOCAL TIES: FredNat starting pitcher Davian Garcia spent some time in the Fredericksburg area in his childhood, playing for the Stafford (VA) little league as a youngster.

DREAM START: FredNat infielder Jackson Ross made his professional debut in Sunday's game at Carolina one day after his 25th birthday, and went 3-for-4 with a go-ahead home run in the 8th inning, an RBI double, and three total RBIs. He followed that up with his second pro homer in last night's game, a walk-off shot to deliver the first win of the year. In two games, Ross is hitting .571 with a 2.271 OPS.

THIS CAN'T BE REAL: This is the second of 24 meetings this year between North Divisional foes Fredericksburg and Salem. Since the FredNats debuted in 2021, the series between these two teams is incredibly close. In 97 games against the Sox, the FredNats are 48-49, and both teams have scored exactly 501 runs. In 2024 alone, Fredericksburg went 7-8 against Salem with the Sox holding a slight 64-61 advantage in the run column. However, since the 2021 season, FXBG is 37-24 against Salem, bouncing back after the Sox went 25-11 against Fredericksburg in the inaugural season that saw the FredNats have the worst record in the Carolina League.

ROSTER BREAKDOWN: While the FredNats don't have a ton of Top-30 prospect talent on this Opening Day roster, the team does have a wealth of experience returning, with 20 players out of 30 on the Opening Day roster having played for the FredNats before, and eight returners who played in the 2024 playoffs. Additionally, nine members of Washington's 2024 draft class appear on the Opening Day roster. Opening Day roster players that participated in the 2024 playoffs include Merritt Beeker, Adam Bloebaum, Robert Cranz, Alexander Meckley, Kevin Bazzell, Jorgelys Mota, Nate Ochoa and Cristhian Vaquero.

NOT TOO FLASHY: In a departure from the last three seasons where the FredNat Opening Day rosters were littered with Top-30 prospects, this year's FredNat Opening Day roster only has two of MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Nationals prospects, No. 14 Kevin Bazzell and No. 27 Cristhian Vaquero. Both are returners from 2024, and both played roles in the 2024 championship. The most returners are on the pitching staff, with 10 returning pitchers - primarily relief pitchers - from the team that had the third best bullpen ERA in the Carolina League, the second most saves, and protected 93% of leads after seven innings and 98% of leads after eight innings.

THIS DAY IN FREDNAT HISTORY: The FredNats opened the 2022 campaign on April 8 on the road at Delmarva, falling by a score of 9-6. Jeremy De La Rosa and Sammy Infante both homered for FXBG, and Brady House went 2-for-4 in his Fredericksburg debut.

2024 CHAMPIONS: The 2024 Fredericksburg Nationals won the franchise's sixth total Carolina League championship last September, defeating the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers two games to one to capture the crown. It was the franchise's first since moving to Fredericksburg in 2020, and the first since the Potomac Nationals won the Carolina League in 2014. The FredNats broke the Charleston RiverDogs' run of three titles in a row, and became the first non-Charleston team to win the league since MiLB realigned to its current leagues in 2021.

NEW SKIPPER IN TOWN: After Jake Lowery's third season as Manager of the FredNats ended in a Carolina League championship in 2024, the FredNats welcome Billy McMillon as the third Manager in Fredericksburg franchise history. McMillon, 53, has spent the last three seasons in the Nationals organization as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. Prior to joining the Nationals, he coached for over a decade in the Boston organization, managing at all four full-season levels and also spending three seasons (2016-18) as the organization's base running and outfield coordinator. He also played parts of six seasons in the Major Leagues with Oakland, Detroit, Philadelphia and Florida. He's joined on the staff by returning Pitching Coach Justin Lord, returning Hitting Coach Mike Habas, Development Coach Luis Ordaz, returning Athletic Trainer Jacob Meyer, Strength & Conditioning Coach Mike Reiskind, and Performance Analyst Samantha Unger.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won six Carolina League championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014. The franchise won its first league title as the Fredericksburg Nationals in 2024.

WELCOME TO FXBG: Davian Abdiel Garcia...was selected by the Nationals with the 170th overall pick in the 2024 MLB Draft out of Florida Gulf Coast last summer.

PRO MOMENT: Garcia pitched in relief for Billy McMillon during the FredNats' second game of the season at Carolina. The right fired 1.2 scoreless innings in his pro debut, striking out two Mudcats. Tonight is Garcia's first professional start.

COLLEGE EDUCATED: Garcia threw for two different schools over the course of his collegiate career. He was an All-ASUN First Team selection at Florida Gulf Coast University as a junior in 2024 after transferring in from Pasco Hernandez State. He finished the 2024 college season as FGCU's Friday night starter after starting the season as a reliever. All in all, he went 6-3 for the Eagles last year, spinning a 3.10 ERA across 61.0 IP and striking out 71 batters. He led the ASUN with a 2.89 conference ERA

BILLY MCMILLON - MANAGER

1st Season | Previously: Development Coach, Triple-A Rochester

McMillon, 53, joined Washington in 2022 and has spent the last three seasons as the Development Coach for Triple-A Rochester. McMillon played parts of six Major League seasons with four different organizations, including the Oakland Athletics (2001-04), Detroit Tigers (2000-01), Philadelphia Phillies (1997), and Florida Marlins (1996-97). The former Clemson Tiger was a three-time International League All-Star and the 1996 IL Rookie of the Year with Charlotte, earning him induction into the IL Hall of Fame in 2019 and Charlotte's Round Table of Honor in 2022. McMillon was initially selected in the eighth round of the 1993 MLB Draft by Florida. He replaces Jake Lowery, who managed the FredNats the last three seasons, culminating in a championship last year. Lowery will manage High-A Wilmington in 2025.

Prior to joining Washington, McMillon coached in the Boston Red Sox organization for over a decade. He managed the Worcester Red Sox (Triple-A) in their inaugural season in 2021 after managing Boston's former Triple-A affiliate Pawtucket in 2019. He was set to lead the PawSox again in 2020 before the cancellation of the MiLB season. Prior to managing at the Triple-A level, McMillon was the Minor League Outfield and Baserunning Coordinator for Boston from 2016-18 after managing for six seasons in the organization with Double-A Portland (2014-15), High-A Salem (2012-13), and Single-A Greenville (2010-11). His coaching career began in 2008 when he was Greenville's Hitting Coach.



JUSTIN LORD - PITCHING COACH

3rd Season | Previously: Pitching Coach, Double-A Harrisburg

Lord, 45, returns to Fredericksburg for a third season in 2025 after leading the FredNats' championship pitching staff last season, including the 2024 Carolina League Pitcher of the Year Travis Sykora.

This is Lord's fifth total season coaching in the Washington organization after a six-year professional playing career and several seasons coaching in the Baltimore system. The Alabama native and Florida State alum was scheduled to be the Fredericksburg Pitching Coach in the canceled 2020 season, and was the Pitching Coach for one season in Double-A Harrisburg prior to joining the FredNats in 2023.



MIKE HABAS - HITTING COACH

2nd Season | Previously: Hitting Coach, ACL Brewers

Habas, 34, returns to Fredericksburg from the 2024 championship staff for his second season with Washington after leading the FredNat offense to a highly successful season, finishing in the top third of the league in virtually every meaningful offensive category.

Prior to joining the Nationals, he spent spending the previous four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization, most recently as the Hitting Coach for the ACL Brewers in 2022 and 2023. Prior to joining Milwaukee, he was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats. While coaching with Gary, he was also the Head Coach at Prairie State College, a Junior College in the Chicago area.



LUIS ORDAZ - DEVELOPMENT COACH

1st Season | Previously: Manager, FCL Nationals

Ordaz, 49, joins the FredNat coaching staff in the Development Coach role after managing the Florida Complex League Nationals in 2024.

He played parts of seven seasons in the Major Leagues, appearing in 206 career games with the St. Louis Cardinals, Kansas City Royals and Tampa Bay Devil Rays. Ordaz has coached in the Washington organization for over a decade, and was the Hitting Coach for the Potomac Nationals for four seasons from 2016-19. He replaces Carmelo Jaime, who will manage the FCL Nationals in 2025 after three seasons in Fredericksburg.
