TUESDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 3-1, in the first game of the homestand at The Diamond. The SeaWolves took a 1-0 lead in the top of the first inning. Trei Cruz led off the game with a triple and scored on a fielding error by Aeverson Arteaga off the bat of Max Anderson. Thayron Liranzo extended the lead to 2-0 with a solo homer in the top of the sixth, the only batter Choate faced in the inning. Choate allowed two runs over five innings and struck out seven. The Flying Squirrels broke the shutout with a run-scoring groundout by Jairo Pomares in the bottom of the eighth.

TODAY'S GAMES: The Flying Squirrels play the second and third of a six-game road series against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. This is the first series between the two teams. The series mark's Erie's only trip to Richmond this year. The Flying Squirrels will play a six-game series at UPMC Park from June 3-8 and again from August 5-10. Richmond has gone 1-1 in both of their previous doubleheader sets this year.

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 6,889 fans per home game, which ranks third among all 120 MiLB clubs. Their average of 7,290 in the season's first month was the highest April attendance in franchise history.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS dropped four-of-six last week in Harrisburg and were outscored 42-8 for the series. Richmond's offense is 11th in the EL in runs scored (109) and the pitching staff is 12th in ERA (5.15). Richmond's 10-24 start is tied for the worst record through 34 games to begin a season in team history, tied with the 2016 Flying Squirrels. That year, the team went 10-25 through 35 games.

THE SEAWOLVES are tied for first place in the Southwest Division with Akron. Last week, they won the first four games of the series against the Curve before dropping the last two. Erie leads the Eastern League in batting average (.256), runs (178), hits (281), homers (32), RBIs (164), OBP (.339), SLG (.413) and OPS (.752). The Erie pitching staff is first in the league in ERA (2.93). The Erie roster includes four players ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including C Thayron Liranza (No. 5), RHP Jayden Hamm (No. 11), RHP Troy Melton (No. 24) and OF Justice Bigbie (No. 26). MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospect list features eight Erie players, including Liranzo (No. 5), Hamm (No. 7), Melton (No. 10), RHP Joseph Montalvo (No. 17), OF Roberto Campos (No. 20), INF Max Anderson (No. 21), Bigbie (No. 25), RHP RJ Petit (No. 28) and RHP Yosber Sanchez (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Joe Whitman** makes his seventh start of the season and his first against Erie in Game 1. On May 3, Whitman threw six perfect innings against the Patriots at The Diamond, retiring all 18 batters he faced, and set a career high with 10 strikeouts. He was named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on May 5. He last pitched last Friday at Harrisburg and allowed four runs over four innings. In his first full professional season last year, Whitman split the year between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, going 3-8 with a 4.63 ERA in 23 starts. He finished the year ranked ninth in the Giants organization in strikeouts (108) and tied for ninth in games started. Whitman was selected in the second round of the 2023 MLB Draft by the Giants out of Kent State, where he was the MAC Pitcher of the Year that season. Before transferring to Kent State near his hometown of Akron, Ohio, Whitman pitched at Purdue. Entering 2025, Whitman was ranked by Baseball America as the No. 10 Giants prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com. **For more on Whitman, see page two.**

Left-hander **Seth Lonsway** makes his seventh start of the season and the first of his career against the SeaWolves in Game 2. He last pitched on Thursday at Harrisburg and threw 5.2 scoreless innings, allowing two hits with seven strikeouts in a win. For the season, Lonsway is ranked ninth in the Eastern League in ERA (2.45) and sixth in BAA (194). Since joining the team last summer, Lonsway has not allowed an earned run eight-of-12 Double-A outings, including three-of-six starts in 2025. His 1.89 career ERA with Richmond is the third-lowest (min. 50 IP) in franchise history. Lonsway was selected by the Giants in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Ohio State. **For more on Lonsway, see page two.**

FOR ERIE: Left-hander Carlos Pena makes his third Double-A start of the year and his sixth appearance this season for the SeaWolves in Game 2. He has also pitched three games this year with Triple-A Toledo. Pena last pitched last Wednesday against the Curve and allowed two runs over 4.2 innings. He opened the year with Toledo and allowed three runs in his first appearance. In his next five outings between Triple-A and Double-A, he combined for 11.0 consecutive scoreless innings, all out of the bullpen. Dating back to 2022, Pena has spent parts of three seasons with the SeaWolves, going 8-7 with a 3.45 ERA in 31 games (21 starts). He was signed by the Tigers as an international free agent in 2019.

Right-hander Garrett Burhenn makes his sixth start of the season and the fourth of his career against the Flying Squirrels. In his last two starts against Binghamton and Altoona, Burhenn went 1-0 with a 1.80 ERA (2 ER/10.0 IP). Burhenn joined the SeaWolves last May and pitched 20 Double-A games to close the season. In his three starts against the Flying Squirrels last year, Burhenn went 0-1 with a 6.01 ERA (9 ER/13.1 IP). Burhenn was selected by the Tigers in the ninth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Ohio State.

BUCKEYE BATTLE: Former Ohio State teammates **Seth Lonsway** and **Garrett Burhenn** square off in the second game of today's doubleheader. They were both selected in the 2021 MLB Draft after spending three seasons with the Buckeyes. Lonsway was the first Ohio State player taken in the 2021 Draft. He went 12-11 with a 3.89 ERA in 33 starts for his college career. Burhenn was the second Buckeye taken in the 2021 Draft when the Tigers selected him in the ninth round after a 15-8 record and a 4.34 ERA in his college career. It marked the third straight year an Ohio State player was selected by Detroit in the MLB Draft. Former Erie players Dillon Dingler and Andrew Mango were also teammates of Lonsway and Burhenn at Ohio State before being drafted by the Tigers.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of **Adrián Sugastey** and **Zach Morgan** have combined to throw out 20 stolen base attempts this season, which is tied for first among all 30 Double-A teams and leads the Eastern League. Sugastey is tied for second in Double-A with 11 runners caught stealing, which leads the EL. Morgan is fourth in the EL with nine.

THE BRYCE IS RIGHT: Northern Virginia native **Bryce Eldridge** returned to the Richmond roster on April 22 after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For the year in 116 games, Eldridge hit .291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 22 prospect in baseball. Eldridge is also the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history. After batting .111 (1-for-9) in his first three games of the season, Eldridge is batting .283 (15-for-53) in his last 14 games. On Saturday night, Eldridge drove a two-out, three-run homer against the Senators to give the Flying Squirrels the lead in the eighth for a comeback win.

HOWELL AT THE MOON: **Carter Howell** opened the season batting .189 (14-for-74) in his first 20 games through April 26. In his last 13 games dating back to April 29, Howell is batting .255 (13-for-51) with three homers, two doubles, six RBIs, four walks and seven runs scored. After hitting three homers in his first 136 Double-A games, he homered three times over a five-game span from during the last homestand. Last Monday, he was named Eastern League Player of the Week for the first time. In 2024, Howell was named Richmond's Player of the Year and led the Eastern League in doubles (30) and triples (7) and leading the Flying Squirrels in batting average (.272), OBP (.347), SLG (.391), OPS (.738), hits (121), runs (64) and stolen bases (15).

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, **Jairo Pomares** is tied for seventh in homers (5). **Diego Velasquez** is 10th in batting average (.292) and tied for sixth in hits (35). **Sabin Ceballos** is tied for sixth in walks (19). **Seth Lonsway** is eighth in ERA (2.45) and sixth in BAA (194). **John Michael Bertrand** is tied for first in starts (7) and 10th in innings pitched (32.0). **Jack Choate** is tied for third in strikeouts (41).

TOP SKIPPER: Flying Squirrels manager **Dennis Pelfrey** has led the team to 214 wins in his career, which is two away from tying the franchise's all-time wins record for a manager. From 2011-2013, **Dave Machemer** won 216 games as Richmond's manager, leading the team to the Eastern League postseason for in 2011. Pelfrey, who has been with Richmond since the 2022 season, led the team to back-to-back postseason appearances for the first time in franchise history in 2022 and 2023. He also managed the 2021 Eugene Emeralds to the High-A West championship.

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes seven players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including **Bryce Eldridge** (No. 1), **Joe Whitman** (No. 10), **Diego Velasquez** (No. 13), **Sabin Ceballos** (No. 16), **Trent Harris** (No. 26), **Aeverson Arteaga** (No. 27) and **Jack Choate** (No. 28). There are also seven players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Eldridge, (No. 1), Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27). Eldridge is also ranked No. 22 overall by Baseball America and No. 22 by MLB.com.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND BASEBALL HISTORY

May 14
1962: The Richmond Virginians beat the Syracuse Chiefs, 4-3, at Parker Field. With the score tied 3-3 in the bottom of the ninth, Mike Mathiesen hit a one-out triple, setting the table after his own error had given Syracuse a 3-2 lead in the sixth. Alan Hall fouled off five two-strike pitches before driving the walk-off winning run. **1981:** The Richmond Braves beat the Pawtucket Red Sox, 3-2, to snap a seven-game losing streak. The Paxsxo took a 2-1 lead into the eighth inning. Ken Smith hit a go-ahead, two-run single in the bottom of the eighth to move the R-Braves ahead. Butch Edge closed out the game in the ninth. **1984:** The Richmond Braves beat the Atlanta Braves, 6-3, at Parker Field in front of a crowd of 14,382. It was the R-Braves fourth straight win in the annual series. Atlanta led 2-1 entering the seventh before Richmond scored three runs. Ken Smith hit an RBI single and Mike Reynolds drove in two with a homer into the roped-off crowd in right-center field. In the bottom of the eighth, Brad Kominsky hit an RBI double and Larry Whisenton hit an RBI single. The game was played in one hour and 41 minutes. The Richmond Braves left after the game to begin a series in Pawtucket, where they were slated to face Roger Clemens but he was called up to the majors for his debut. **1999:** The Richmond Braves beat the Rochester Red Wings, 5-4, in 10 innings. Toby Rurnfield won the game with a walk-off homer in the bottom of the 10th. Richmond opened a 3-0 lead in the second inning. George Lombard walked, stole second and scored on a single by Mark DeRosa. Rochester rallied to tie the score in the eighth. Richmond moved ahead 4-3 in the bottom of the seventh before Rochester tied the game again in the eighth.

May 15
1973: The Richmond Braves beat the Tidewater Tides, 6-3, at Parker Field. Andy Thornton hit two homers and the Braves came from behind twice in the win. Guy Rose drove in what became the winning run with a single to extend his hitting streak to 11 games. **1981:** The Richmond Braves beat the Pawtucket Red Sox 2-1 at Parker Field. Randy Johnson hit a walk-off sacrifice fly in the bottom of the ninth.
