**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels swept the Sea Dogs in a doubleheader. In Game 1, the Flying Squirrels won, 4-3. Portland struck first with a two-run double by Tyler McDonough in the bottom of the second. In the top of the fifth, **Will Wilson** brought in a run with a sacrifice fly, **Victor Bericoto** tied the game with a single and **Andy Thomas** moved Richmond ahead, 3-2, with a single. Kyle Teel tied the game with a sac fly in the bottom of the fifth. **Christian Koss** moved the Flying Squirrels ahead for good with an RBI double in the top of the sixth. **Dylan Cumming** started and allowed two runs in four innings. **Seth Corry** picked up his first Double-A win, allowing one run over two innings. **Tyler Myrick** closed his fifth save of the year, striking out two in a scoreless seventh. In Game 2, the Flying Squirrels won, 9-8. Richmond scored six runs in the first inning, including an RBI single by Bericoto, a two-run single by Thomas and a three-run homer by **Luis Toribio**. In the second, **Jairo Pomares** stole third and scored on an error and Thomas added an RBI single to open an 8-0 lead. Phillip Sikes hit a two-run homer in the second. In the third, Kristian Campbell hit a two-run single and Blaze Jordan hit a three-run homer to close the Sea Dogs back within two runs. Wilson hit a solo homer in the fourth to open a 9-6 lead. Teel hit a two-run homer in the bottom of the fourth to close Portland within a run. **Kyle Cody** pitched 1.2 scoreless innings and **Mat Olsen** closed his first Double-A save with 1.2 scoreless innings.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox, in the fifth of a six-game series on the second leg of a 12-game road trip to New England. This week's series is the final road set for the Flying Squirrels this year against the Northeast Division. It is also the only series between these two teams this year. The Flying Squirrels are 13-6 this year against teams from the Northeast.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 6-1 dating back to last Friday. They had gone 4-10 in their previous 14 games from May 29-June 11 and 11-2 in the previous 13 games from May 25-28. That stretch came following a span where they went 1-12 over a 13-game span from April 28-May 12, including 1-11 on their road trip to Akron and Erie. They have won three-of-their-last-five series, taking five-of-six in back-to-back series against Reading from May 15-19 and on the road at Bowie from May 21-26, before dropping four-of-six against Erie at The Diamond from May 28-June 2 and again against Altoona from June 4-9 and then winning four-of-six last week at New Hampshire.

**THE SEA DOGS** are tied for second place in the Northeast Division, 1.5 games behind first-place Hartford with two games remaining in the season's first half. For the season, the Sea Dogs lead the league in batting average (.270), runs (376), hits (602), doubles (158), RBIs (347), walks (278), OBP (.358), SLG (.441) and OPS (.799). Portland's roster includes nine of Baseball America's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including OF Roman Anthony (No. 1), SS Marcelo Meyer (No. 2), C Kyle Teel (No. 3), RHP Wikelman Gonzalez (No. 5), 3B Blaze Jordan (No. 17), INF/OF Eddinson Paulino (No. 20), RHP Hunter Dobbins (No. 25), RHP Angel Bastardo (No. 26) and INF Kristian Campbell (No. 30). The roster also includes 10 players ranked on MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospects list, including Mayer (No. 1), Anthony (No. 2), Teel (No. 3), Gonzalez (No. 5), Jordan (No. 19), Paulino (No. 22), Dobbins (No. 25), Bastardo (No. 26), RHP Bryan Mata (No. 27) and Campbell (No. 30).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Carson Ragsdale** makes 14th start of the season and his third of the current road trip.. He last pitched on Sunday afternoon at New Hampshire and allowed one hit over six scoreless innings. It was his longest start since his debut season in 2021. In his last three starts dating back to June 5, Ragsdale is 2-1 with a 1.62 ERA (3 ER/16.2 IP/21 SO/5 BB). Against Northeast Division opponents this year, Ragsdale has posted a 1.35 ERA (3 ER/20.0 IP) in four starts. In the Eastern League this season, he is ranked second in strikeouts (80), second in K/9 (11.8), second in strikeout percentage (32.7%) and third in BAA (.198). Last season, he made seven starts for High-A Eugene, going 0-1 with a 2.93 ERA. His season ended in May with an oblique injury. At the time of the injury, he was leading the Northwest League in strikeouts (42) and ranked third in innings pitched (27.2). In 2022, he made five appearances in the Arizona Complex League but missed most of the year after having Thoracic Outlet Syndrome surgery in the spring. Ragsdale was selected by the Philadelphia Phillies in the fourth round of the 2020 MLB Draft out of the University of South Florida. Before making his professional debut, he was traded to the San Francisco Giants on January 9, 2021 for pitcher Sam Coonrod. **For more on Ragsdale, see page two.**

**FOR PORTLAND:** Right-hander Jacob Webb makes his second start of the season and his third in his professional career. He faced the Flying Squirrels on Tuesday and allowed one run over two innings, picking up a winning decision. In his first 13 outings of the year through May 22, Webb had a 2.55 ERA. In his last seven appearances since May 25, Webb has a 6.59 ERA (10 ER/13.2 IP). Webb was selected in the 14th round of the 2021 MLB Draft by the Red Sox out of Miami (OH).

**HIT PARADE:** In Over the last nine games since June 12, the Flying Squirrels offense is leading the league in batting average (.324), runs (71), hits (106), total bases (163), RBIs (66), walks (39), OBP (.399) and OPS (.897) while ranking second in doubles (22) and SLG (.498). In those nine games, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 7.9 runs per game and 11.8 hits per game.

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last 11 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .393 (22-for-56) with three homers, four doubles, five walks and 13 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again last Friday night at New Hampshire and added a homer on Tuesday at Portland. In his last 21 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .341 (30-for-88) with six homers, five doubles, 11 walks and 22 RBIs. His current 11-game hitting streak dating back to June 8 is the second-longest active streak in the Eastern League. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in five consecutive games dating back to last Saturday and is batting .524 (11-for-21) in that stretch.

**HELLO, JAIRO:** In the current road trip, **Jairo Pomares** is batting .382 (13-for-34) with four homers, three doubles and 10 RBIs in nine games. Last Tuesday, he picked up a pair of hits, including a double, and set a season high with three RBIs. He matched the three RBIs and homered last Thursday night, adding a double. Pomares homered for the second straight game on Friday night, one of his two hits in that game. He homered again on Sunday, his third homer of the series in New Hampshire. Pomares went 3-for-5 with a double to open the series at Portland on Tuesday and hit a two-run homer on Wednesday.

**WILL POWER:** **Will Wilson** is batting .478 (11-for-23) with a homer, a double and seven RBIs over his last five games dating back to Sunday. He has picked up multiple hits in four-of-his-last-five games, including three hits on Sunday, Wednesday and in the second game of Friday's doubleheader. He also has at least one RBI in six consecutive games since June 14, which is the longest active streak in the Eastern League. He hit a solo homer in the second game of Friday's doubleheader, the 27th of his Flying Squirrels career. He is tied for fourth in franchise history with his 27 home runs, even with **Shane Matheny**, **Sean Roby** and **Devin Harris** while trailing only **Ricky Oropesa** (37), **Jacob Heyward** (33) and **Jarrett Parker** (30).

**THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:** **Andy Thomas** is batting .330 (33-for-100) over his last 29 games since May 15 with two homers, seven doubles, a triple and 23 RBIs, raising his batting average for the year from .193 to .266. On May 24 at Bowie, he clubbed his first homer of the year, a grand slam, and finished the game with six RBIs, tying his career high. Last Wednesday at New Hampshire, he went 3-for-3 with a walk and caught a shutout. He finished the series with seven hits in five games started. He has picked up a hit in four straight games. In Friday's doubleheader, he drove in four runs.

**KOSS-OME:** In his return to Portland, **Christian Koss** has hit .727 (8-for-11) with four doubles, six RBIs and a steal in his first three games of this week's series. Koss played for the Sea Dogs the last two seasons and was named the team's MVP in 2022. In those two seasons, he played 163 games for the Sea Dogs, batting .252. Koss started the season with Richmond and played three games before an injury placed him on the injured list from mid-April through early-June. In his 16 games for the Flying Squirrels this year, he is batting .418 (23-for-55), which is second-highest in the Eastern League (min. 50 PA) this season, trailing only Portland's Kristian Campbell (.419).

**SERVING UP THE DONUTS:** On Sunday, the Flying Squirrels threw their ninth shutout win of the season, which is tied with Akron and Harrisburg for the most in the Eastern League. The Flying Squirrels have pitched shutouts in six-of-their-last-13 wins dating back to May 25. Last week, they started and ended the series in New Hampshire with 5-0 shutout wins on Tuesday and Sunday.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 10), RHP **Eric Silva** (No. 20), C **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 23), RHP **Ryan Murphy** (No. 26) and LHP **José Cruz** (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes five Richmond players, including Brown (No. 15), OF/1B **Victor Bericoto** (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23), OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26) and RHP **Carson Ragsdale** (No. 30).
