ALLEN HOMERS IN 8-2 JUMBO SHRIMP WIN

Jeff Lindgren (4-2) tossed six strong innings of one-run baseball and Austin Allen homered to lead the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp over the Norfolk Tides 8-2. Allen (6) knotted the game at one apiece with a solo home run of his own in the second frame and Jacksonville never looked back. The Jumbo Shrimp took their first lead in 21.0 innings when Jacob Amaya doubled and scored two batters later on a single from Jerar Encarnacion to give the Jumbo Shrimp a 2-1 lead. Jacksonville plated six more runs throughout the game en route to a commanding 8-2 win.

DOCTOR, DOCTOR GIVE ME THE NEWS

Jacksonville starting pitching seemed to find their footing over their previous 20 games. From April 13-May 5, Jacksonville starters yielded 42 runs, 35 earned on 90 hits (8.2 H/9) in 98.2 innings for a 3.19 ERA. Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have struggled in seven of their last eight games. They've allowed 34 runs, 33 earned on 40 hits (12.9 H/9) in 28.0 innings for a 10.61 ERA with 21 walks (6.8 BB/9) and 21 strikeouts (6.8 K/9).

WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Over the season's first eight games, Jacksonville mustered only 25 walks, the second-fewest such total in the International League. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have shown a significant amount of patience of late; Jacksonville has registered 149 free passes over the last 29 games since April 11, a figure that ranks tied for third in the International League. During this stretch, the club has walked in 12.9 percent of their plate appearances. The Jumbo Shrimp walked in just 7.6 percent of plate appearances in their first eight games. Jacksonville's 11 walks on April 30 were their most in a game since tallying 12 against Birmingham on 6/15/19. The last time the club tallied 11 walks at home was 8/6/15 vs. Pensacola.

"DOUBLE AA" BAT-TERY

Austin "Double AA" Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 10 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 12-for-32 (.375/.459/.719/1.178) at the plate with two doubles, three home runs, seven RBIs, five walks and seven runs scored. Allen has raised his season line to .177/.286/.392/.678 with his recent hot stretch.

KING CHARLES

Over an eight-game stretch from April 14-27, Charles Leblanc went just 1-for-26 (.038) at the plate. The native of Laval in Canada has been absurdly hot at the plate since. Over the last 15 games dating back to April 28, Leblanc is a scorching 16-for-48 (.333/.515/.479/.994) with two doubles, one triple, one home run, five RBIs and a remarkable 18 walks. On the campaign, the 26-year-old has walked (30) nearly as much he has struck out (30). Leblanc ranks third in the International League in walk percentage (22.6 percent) and fifth in total walks (30). His swinging-strike rate of 7.1 percent ranks 15th-lowest out of the circuit's 133 qualified hitters.

'PEN PALS

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a seven-game stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe, Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. However, in the 15 games since, Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede 27 runs, 21 earned, on 54 hits (6.3 H/9) in 77.0 innings for a 2.45 ERA. The Shrimp bullpen has combined for 85 strikeouts (9.9 K/9) against 50 walks (5.8 BB/9) during this recent run.

LONG TIME, NO SEE

Heading in to play on Tuesday, Jacksonville will take on a Cincinnati Reds affiliate for the first time since August 22, 2008 when they played the Chattanooga Lookouts at AT&T Field. That contest ended in a 6-5 win for the Jacksonville Suns. This will be the first matchup for Jacksonville against a Cincinnati affiliate in the International League.

SHRIMP BITES

The Jumbo Shrimp have walked at least five opposing hitters in six of the last seven games... Jacksonville avoided dropping their fourth game in a row, with an 8-2 win against Norfolk on Sunday. They suffered through a four-game skid just once (May 14-18) in 2022...With Jacksonville traveling to Louisville this week, they will be playing a Reds affiliate for the first time since 2008 and playing in Kentucky for the first time since they were members of the IL in 1968...The IL comprised of Toledo (DET), Columbus (PIT), Rochester (BAL), Jacksonville (NYM), Louisville (BOS), Syracuse (NYY), Buffalo (WSA) and Richmond (ATL).
