MIRANDA STAYS HOT BUT SAINTS DROP SERIES OPENER VS SCRANTON. Jose Miranda rolled a hot road trip into a fast start at CHS Field as he homered for the second consecutive game, but the Saints weren't ever able to find a way in front after falling behind 5-0 in an 8-5 loss to open the Saints weren't ever able to find a way in front after falling behind 5-0 in an 8-5 loss to open the homestand Tuesday night against Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. After going six up and six down to start the ballgame, St. Paul starter Simeon Woods Richardson was ambushed on a first pitch hack in the third, a blast by Brennen Davis to make it 1-0 Railriders. By the time the inning was over, Braden Shewmake and Everson Pereira both went deep to help Scranton build up a 5-0 lead. The St. Paul offense responded right away, hitting two home runs of their own in the bottom of the inning. With one out, Patrick Winkel unloaded on his fourth of the season in 18 games to cut it to 5-1 and Miranda pounded a two-run homer to lef-center to get the Saints within a pair. In the fourth, the Saints pulled it even at five apiece. Former RailRider Armando Alvarez put one in the gap for a two-run double. A leadoff walk would prove costly for the Saints in the seventh. T.J. Rumfield doubled to left to score Pereira and give the RailRiders a 6-5 lead. Bryan De La Cruz's bloop single padded the lead and Scranton would add insurance in the eighth to take the win.

NO WAY, JOSE!: Jose Miranda has homered in consecutive games for the first time in his career since 2021 (last accomplished in Double-A on June 13 & 15). The Puerto Rico native has never homered in three straight games in his career (majors or minors), although he holds the 1-of-4 three-homer games in Saints franchise history on June 29, 2021 vs Omaha. Aside from just leaving the yard, Miranda collected his third multi-hit game in the past seven contests, a stretch where he's 10-for-29 (3.45), 2 HR, 2 doubles, 6 RBI and a 1.008 OPS. He had just one multi-hit game, a 2-hit performance on May 18 @lowa in his first 25 games of the season between St. Paul and Minnesota when he hit just .183 (15-82) with a .507 OPS.

GOING, GOING, GONE: The Saints have now homered in a season-high ten games in-a-row, the longest stretch for the club since they homered in 11 straight from April 27-May 10 last year (the franchise record is 25 straight games from May 25-June 21, 2023, the longest stretch of any team in the minors from 2021-25). After hitting just 7 homers in their first 12 games of the season, which ranked tied for the 2nd-fewest in the Int'l League at the time, the Saints have touched off for 61 round-trippers in their last 43 games since April 14, which ranks 3rd in the minors in that stretch, trailing only Greensboro (66) and Charlotte (64). The Saints are 15-4 th season when they hit more homers than their opponents and 5-13 when being outhomered.

COMEBACK KIDS: The Saints pulled off a pair of come-from-behinds wins in which they trailed after seven innings on their road trip last week, doing so on Thursday and Friday night at Werner Park. It's the first two wins for the Saints when overcoming a deficit in the seventh inning or later since May 7 and May 8 vs Buffalo when Mike Ford and Mickey Gasper hit walk-off home runs on consecutive nights. St. Paul's 17 come-from-behind wins this year are tied with the Charlotte Knights (CHW) for the most in the International League.

RETURN OF McCRUSHER. Recently returned from his first-ever stint in The Show Saints outfielder RETURN OF McCRUSHER: Recently returned from his first-ever stint in The Show, Saints outfielder Carson McCusker is crushing the ball to open the season and currently ranks 3rd in Triple-A in average exit velocity (see below). Despite recently spending 12 days on the big league roster and sitting out the last three games in Omaha, he still ranks t-9th in the league in homers (10) and leads all qualifiers slugging%. On Sunday May 11 vs Buffalo, he drilled a 115.0 mph laser over the left field wall, recording the fifth-hardest batted ball in Saints franchise history. McCusker has the three hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and five of the top-10, including three batted balls that rank among the top-10 in exit velocity in Saints history. The 6-8 slugger is the first batter in St. Paul Saints franchise history to reach double-digit homers before the end of May.

Gasper has quite simply been one of the best hitters in the minors the last two years. Since the start of 2024 with the Boston org, he ranks as the 2nd best hitter in the minors by wRC+ (weight runs created plus, where 100 is league average, a ballpark and league adjusted measure). PITCHING PARTICULARS: Despite some recent strong pitching performances, the Saints have struggled on the mound recently as they've yielded 113 runs across their last 19 games going back to the start of their road trip at lowa. Since the start of May, St. Paul pitching has produced a 6.09 ERA (160 ER, 236.1 IP), the 4th-worst mark in Minor League Baseball in that span. Despite the pitching struggles, the Saints' team OPS of .823 as an offense is the 5th-highest in MiLB since the start of May, and the best in the Int'l League.

TWINS REPORT: The Twins (33-27) won their second straight in Sacramento with a 10-3 victory over the A's last night. After firing 5.0 innings of two-run ball, Pablo Lopez pulled himself out of the game after throwing one warmup pitch prior to the sixth. Willi Castro homered twice and now has multiple hits in four of the last five games, two of which have been multi-homer efforts. Minnesota are 4-4 on the 11-day, 3-city road trip so far. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (27-25) won their series opener at Northwest Arkansas (SEA) 2-1 behind six shutout innings from Burnsville native Aaron Rozek. OF Gabriel Gonzalez was named the Twins Minor League Player of the Month after hitting .364 (36-99), 3 HR, 7 2B, 9 BB in 24 games in May. High-A Cedar Rapids (30-20) were rained out in Appleton and play a doubleheader today vs the Timber Rattlers (MIL) with the Kernels having won five straight entering play Wednesday. Low-A Fort Myers (24-28) won their third straight by topping Palm Beach (STL) 4-3. Jay Thomason, a 17th-rounder out of the Air Force Academy by the Twins last year, went 3-for-4 including his 7th HR; he ranks second only to Carson McCusker in the Twins system in qualified OPS (1.007).

LAST APPEARANCE: Made his fourth consecutive appearance out of the bullIpen since coming off the IL and pitched Saturday night, finishing the penultimate game of the series behind starter Andrew Morris in a 5-2 loss. After allowing a leadoff single in the sixth, retired 9 of the last 11 men he faced, giving up his lone run on a solo shot to MJ Melenedez in the eighth. Threw 18 sliders (39%), 13 changeups (28%), 11 sinkers (24%), and 4 four-seamers (9%). Generated six whiffs, led by three on the sinker. Recorded two punchouts on the changeup, one on the sinker, and one on the slider.

THAT'S MISTER SAINT TO YOU: In 2024, Dobnak eclipsed several single-season pitching records for the Saints franchise. Both Caleb Boushley (134.1) and Dobnak (133.1) exceeded the previous record for innings thrown in a single-season (126.1 by Dobnak in '23), while Dobnak set new single-season franchise marks with 12 wins and 134 strikeouts. Dobnak still holds the single season mark for starts in a season, when he began 33 games on the bump in 2023, four more than Simeon Woods-Richardson's total that same season. Dobnak's 281 Career Strikeouts and 297.2 IP in a St. Paul uniform are both the most in the club's cent Triple A history exterior 2026. short Triple-A history entering 2025

KNOW ANY GOOD PIRATE JOKES? NEITHER DO AYYYYE: Dobnak grew up a huge Pittsburgh Pirates fan and we would often fo to PNC Park. His favorite food to get there was nachos with pulled pork and cheese. He finally pitched at PNC Park on August 5, 2020. The irony was no fans were allowed in, not even his parents. He tossed 6.0 shutout innings allowing three hits and striking out one.

A BATTLE(R) OF WILLS: You can be forgiven if you've never heard of the DII school that Dobnak attended from 2014-17. He spent four years at Alderson Broadus (WV) University, located in Philippi, a town of 3,380. During his time with the Battlers he finished his career as the conference's all-time leader in ERA (2,61) and strikeouts (284). In his sophomore season in 2015, Dobnak threw a no-hitter against Bluefield State.

TWILIGHT SPARKLE, MEET BUTTERCUP: Upon graduating from Alderson Broadus, Dobnak went undrafted and was looking for a way to continue his career. He got his break with the Utica Unicorns in the United Shore Professional Baseball League (a four team league where all four teams play in the same ballpark in Utica, MI near Detroit). He signed with them because he caught the eye of manager Jim Essian (a one time Cubs manager in 1981 & also played from 1973-84 in the Majors), whose son played with Dobnak at Alderson Broadus. Dobnak would become the only player to reach the Major League's out of the USPBL.

THERE'S ALWAYS THAT ONE PERSON: In order to make ends meet in the USPBL, Dobnak drove for Uber and Lyft. He began driving for both in October, 2017. His Uber rating was stellar, but not perfect. He had a 4.99/5.0 rating which meant he received all five-star ratings with the exception of one four-star rating. According to Dobnak, "I have one four-star. I'm hoping it was a mistake. I don't remember doing anything bad."

NOTE QUITE MIKE ROWE: Just prior to joining the big leagues, Dobnak worked as a consultant for Jordan Tax & Accounting Services in Bethel Park, PA (2017), an accounting clerk at Accountant and Associates in PA (2017), pizza delivery for Italian Village Pizza in South Park, PA (2012-13) and supermarket stocker at Foodland in Pittsburgh (2010-12).

WE'RE BETTER THAN YOU, AND WE KNOW IT: Dobnak got married to Aerial Munson on September 28, 2019, never thinking he'd be in the Major Leagues. He returned home after the Twins finished a series in Detroit and got married on a Saturday. He wasn't exempt from the rookie ritual of having to dress up in a crazy costume. He had to dress up in a Globo Gym outfit and flew commercial home instead of the chartered flight. He showed up to his fiancées in full attire.
