LAST GAME

The Baysox won their fifth-consecutive series opener on Tuesday night, as they came from behind to take down the Richmond Flying Squirrels, 7-5. Bowie fell behind 4-0 early, as Richmond plated three in the top of the first, including a leadoff home run from Shane Matheny. The Flying Squirrels added another on a solo blast from Carter Aldrete in the third inning, as Baysox starter Carlos Tavera was only able to go three frames on the night. Bowie bounced back with four in the bottom of the fourth. A two-out, two-run single from Zach Watson got the Baysox on the board before Billy Cook launched a two-run home run to tie the game and chase Richmond starter Carson Whisenhunt. Houston Roth took over on the mound for the Baysox, allowing just one run across three frames via a bases loaded walk in the fifth, before Bowie took the lead in the bottom half of the sixth on a two-out, bases clearing triple from Coby Mayo, giving the Baysox a 7-5 lead. The bullpen would hold steady in the final three frames, after two scoreless innings from Kade Strowd and a scoreless ninth from Wandisson Charles secured the victory.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter today with a record of 25-32 - fifth place in the Southwest division and only a half-game ahead of the Baysox. Since entering their series in Bowie against the Baysox in late April atop the division standings, the Flying Squirrels are 12-25, having lost three of their series, while splitting the other three, and dropping 5.5 games out of first place in the process. Richmond has the second-fewest errors (41) in the Eastern League and the fewest home runs hit away from home (21) of any team in Double-A, but are going against a Baysox team with the second-most errors (56) and home runs allowed at home (58) in the league. The Flying Squirrels roster includes 10 of the Giants' top 30 prospects (via MLB Pipeline) - INF Marco Luciano (No. 2 SF/No. 18 overall), OF Vaun Brown (No. 5 SF), LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 8 SF), RHP Mason Black (No. 10 SF), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 13 SF), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 17 SF), RHP Randy Rodriguez (No. 25 SF), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 26 SF), RHP Jose Cruz (No. 29 SF), and OF Wade Meckler (No. 30 SF).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Richmond will begin game one of today's double-header by sending right-hander Mason Black to the mound. The No. 10 prospect in the Giants' system, per MLB Pipeline, has allowed seven home runs through 40.2 innings this season - second most on the staff, but has struck out 51 batters, compared to just 15 walks. Black last pitched on Thursday, where he tossed four shutout innings, striking out six against Altoona. He threw four innings against Bowie back on 4/27, striking out a season-high eight batters and allowing two runs in the process. A third round pick for the Giants in 2021 out of Lehigh University, in his home state of Pennsylvania, Black features a fastball that sits mid-90s, but can touch 98. He also uses a mid-80s slider with sweep and depth, in addition to a low-80s fading changeup. Game two's projected starter for Richmond is right-hander Kai-Wei Teng, who started the front end of a doubleheader against the Baysox back on 4/29. In that game, Teng went 3.2 innings, allowing a run on four hits with two walks and five strikeouts. In six career starts against Bowie, Teng owns a 6.12 ERA, but just a 2.37 ERA in four starts at the hitter-friendly Prince George's Stadium (5 ER in 19 IP). The Taiwan native, who was acquired by the Giants in the Sam Dyson trade with the Twins in July of 2019 features a mid-90s fastball, along with a changeup, slider, and curveball.

DOUBLE THE MAYO!

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. After a pair of extra-base hits last night, including a go-ahead, bases-clearing triple in the sixth inning, Mayo leads the Double-A level with 20 doubles and is second with 30 extra-base hits. The No. 8 Orioles' No. 99 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, also has 10 walks in his last nine contests and nine multi-walk games this season. Mayo leads the Baysox with 35 walks, 29 RBI, and a .936 OPS. He is in the midst of a 26-game on-base streak - third-longest by a member of the Baysox this season (John Rhodes - 29 [Active], Heston Kjerstad - 29) and the fourth-longest such streak in the Eastern League.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with 76 hits and a .360 average. The No. 16 Orioles' prospect went 11-for-23 with 9 RBI last week in Erie, with at least three-hits in three of the five games, including his second four-hit performance of 2023 this past Thursday. Prieto has nine contests on the season with at least three knocks through his first 52 games. In addition, Prieto sits fifth in the Eastern League with his .409 on-base percentage.

TWO OUT MAGIC

The Baysox won their sixth game in their last seven last night, scoring all seven of their runs with two outs. Two out magic has been synonymous during this run for Bowie. In this current seven-game stretch, the Baysox are averaging seven runs per contest (49 runs total). Out of the 49 runs scored, 22 of them have been plated with two outs, accounting for 45% of the offensive production for the Baysox. Bowie is hitting .252 as a team this season with two outs, tied for the second-highest average in the Eastern League.

CAREER NOTES

- 4th most strikeouts (126), 3rd most innings (117.0), and 2nd most starts (22) across the Orioles' system in 2022.
- Named an Orioles Organization All-Star in 2022 after successful stints in High-A Aberdeen and Bowie. Pitched to a 3.69 ERA in 14 appearances/10 starts across 63.1 innings for the Baysox, including a 2.08 ERA in August with a .137 BAA.
- Named Mountain West Pitcher of the Year in 2021.
- Nearly quit baseball before when only team offering him a roster spot out of high school was Division III Pacific Lutheran, "I honestly almost gave up baseball at the end of my high school career, I didn't really know if I loved it, but then I got that one opportunity ... and kind of found this new passion toward baseball."

NOTES BY OUTING*

- Baysox Opening Day starter. Allowed two singles in the first inning, and was saved from allowing a run with an outfield assist. Allowed one base hit in every inning besides the third, but never worked with multiple runners on base.
- Allowed first run of the season in the fourth inning after a double and a single. Walked the first two batters of the fifth inning and was lifted.
- Allowed runners into scoring position in three different innings, but none reached third base. Mixed six flyouts and four groundouts.
- Third pitch thrown was hit for a solo home run. Walked and hit a batter later in the frame, but did not see another runner in scoring position. Left game tied at one, bullpen allowed six runs.
- Allowed three consecutive batters to reach in the first inning, and again in the second. An error and a walk lead to another run in the fifth inning.
- Allowed a solo home run to the third batter of the game. Only other runner to reach scoring position was a stolen base with two outs in the fifth.
- Second pitch thrown went for a double, but faced the minimum over the next 17 batters. With two outs in the sixth, a double, error, and three-run home run cost him the shutout performance
- Gave up a leadoff single, but stranded two runners in the first, followed by two perfect innings. Allowed a solo home run in the fourth, and had a runner thrown out at home in the fifth.
- Only allowed five baserunners, and only allowed two in an inning once.
- Allowed a run three batters into the game on a single and double. Allowed a leadoff single in the second inning that scored on a wild pitch, but only other baserunner across five innings was an error.
- Gave up a two-run home run to the fourth batter of the game after Bowie had scored twice in the top of the first. Allowed four-straight to reach safely in the fifth. Career highs in hits and earned runs.

Johnson's playing career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.	Forrest Herrmann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Herrmann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Herrmann spent two seasons as a pitching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Herrmann also served as a pitching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria.
