YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the Senators, 6-1. Harrisburg took a 2-0 lead with RBIs by Brady Lindsly and Gilbert ara in the second. Wilson Garcia hit a solo homer in the third and added an RBI single in the fourth to open a 4-0 lead. Yasel Antuna hit a solo homer in the fifth and Darren Baker added an RBI single in the eighth to extend the lead to 6-0. Sean Roby oroke the shutout in the bottom of the eighth with a solo homer, his 25th of the season. In his Double-A debut, Evan Gates struck out four batters over two scoreless, hitless innings.

Y'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Harrisburg Senators, Double-A affiliate Washington Nationals. The Flying Squirrels won four-of-six in both series against the Senators in the first half, both in burg. This series is the only trip to Richmond for the Senators this year.

TICKET PUNCHED: The Flying Squirrels clinched the Eastern League Southwest Division First-Half title with a win on May 26 paired with a loss by the Akron RubberDucks against the Harrisburg Senators. Richmond finished the first half tied with Akron, but held the tiebreaker with a 7-5 head-to-head record. The league adopted the split-season format in 2019. After playing a full-season system last year, they returned to the split-season format this year. The Flying Squirrels will play in the Eastern League playoffs for the third time in franchise history. In 2011, they swept the Senators in the division series before falling to the Fisher Cats in the ELCS, three games to one. In 2014, they eliminated the RubberDucks in four games before being swept in the championship series by the Binghamton Mets.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 17-35 in the second half. They are 11-27 in the last 38 games, including a season-high six-game losing streak from July 14-23. The Flying Squirrels have won seven series, lost nine and split five this year. Richmond hitters lead the league with 1,323 strikeouts and rank third with 148 homers. The Flying Squirrels are 30-28 at home this year. Richmond is 24-24 in games decided by two-or-less runs.

THE SENATORS are in fifth place in the Southwest Division in the second-half and last in the overall standings. After losing eight-of-10 entering the series, the Senators have two straight. Harrisburg's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Nationals prospects, including OF Robert Hassell III (No. 1), RHP Gerardo Carrillo (No. 14), OF Yasel Antuna (No. 19), LHP Jose A. Ferrer (No. 23), RHP Zach Brzykcy (No. 24) and C Israel Pineda (No. 26).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Matt Frisbee makes his 23rd start of the season. He last pitched last Friday at Akron and allowed four runs (three earned) with seven strikeouts in a loss. He has made two starts against the Senators this year. On May 12, he allowed six runs (four earned) in 5.1 innings in a loss at FNB Field. On June 17, he worked a season-high 7.2 innings and allowed one run in a win at Harrisburg. In the month of August, Frisbee has struck out 39 batters in 28.0 innings of work. On August 10 at Portland, he set a single-game franchise record with 13 strikeouts, earning Eastern League Pitcher of the Week honors. Last year, he began the season with the Flying Squirrels and went 4-1 with a 1.24 ERA in five starts in the month of May, earning a promotion to Triple-A Sacramento on June 3. In 11 outings (nine starts) with the River Cats, he went 1-6 with a 7.64 ERA and was assigned back to Richmond on August 6. He made six more starts to finish the season with the Flying Squirrels, going 1.3 with a 6.16 ERA. On May 13, 2021 at Harrisburg, Frisbee worked six perfect innings and combined with Joey Marciano, Matt Seelinger and Patrick Ruotolo for the first nine-inning no-hitter in Flying Squirrels franchise history. Frisbee was drafted in the 15th round in 2018 by the Giants out of UNC Greensboro. For more on Frisbee, see page two.

FOR HARRISBURG: Left-hander Alex Troop makes his 15th start and 26th overall appearance of the year. After beginning the year as a reliever, Troop moved into a starting role at the beginning of June. He went 3-1 with a 2.92 ERA in 11 relief outings and has gone 4-3 with a 4.88 ERA in 14 starts. He last pitched on Friday against the SeaWolves and allowed four runs over five innings in a loss. He made two relief appearances against the Flying Squirrels on May 10 and 15, allowing one run over two innings. He made a start against Richmond on June 15 and gave up one run in 4.2 innings in a no-decision. Troop was selected in the ninth round of the 2017 MLB Draft by the Nationals out of Michigan State University.

PACKING THE HOUSE: This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,152) and rank third in total attendance (344,533). Richmond is 14th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night and again on July 4 are the largest crowds in all of Double-A this year.

POWER SURGE: The Richmond offense has hit 148 home runs this season, which is third in the Eastern League. On August 7 in the 101st game of the season, Riley Mahan hit a grand slam to give the Flying Squirrels their 128th homer of the season, breaking the previous franchise record. Last year, the Flying Squirrels broke the team record for homers with 127 in just 113 games, passing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 168 home runs. Sean Roby is third in the league with 25 homers on the season, with 21 coming at The Diamond.

RELYING ON THE LONGBALL: On the year, the Flying Squirrels have scored 254-of-their-559 runs on homers. At 45.43 percent, they have the second-highest total of their runs scored on the year on homers in the Eastern League, trailing Somerset (49.34 percent, 299-of-606 runs). Will Wilson has picked up 94.4 percent (17-of-18) of his Double-A RBIs on home runs this year. Sean Roby has driven in 66.7 percent (36-of-54) and Tyler Fitzgerald has 56.9 percent (33-of-58) of their RBIs on home runs.

CASEY AT THE BAT: Infielder Casey Schmitt was promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 9. After going 0-for-3 in his Double-A debut on August 10, Schmitt has hit .354 (23-for-65) with one homer, six doubles, a triple and six RBIs in his last 16 games since August 11. On August 19, he tied a career high with four hits against the Rumble Ponies. On Friday night in Akron, he collected three hits, including his first Double-A home run.

SMITH STREAKING: Armani Smith is currently riding a 23-game on-base streak since July 29, which is the second-longest active streak in the Eastern League. It is also the second-longest on-base streak for a Richmond player this year, trailing a 24-game streak by Shane Matheny in May and June. During the streak, Smith is batting .271 (23-for-85) with three doubles, a homer, seven RBIs and 15 walks.

FITZ ON FIRE: Over his last 37 games since July 10, Tyler Fitzgerald has homered 11 times. He now has 21 homers this season, which ranks as the second-most in a season in franchise history, one homer ahead of David Villar's previous franchise record of 20 set last year and trailing 24 by Sean Roby this year. Over his last 27 games since July 28, Fitzgerald is batting .311 (33-for-106) with six homers, six doubles, one triple and 23 RBIs, which has raised his season batting average from .194 to .226. On August 20, Fitzgerald hit a solo homer in the first inning and added an inside-the-park homer in the seventh. Fitzgerald is the third player in franchise history to hit an inside-the-park homer, joining Brandon Crawford (2010) and Tyler Graham (2014). He was named Eastern League Player of the Week on August 22.

ROBUST: Sean Roby hit his 21st homer of the year on July 4 against the Fightin Phils, moving him ahead of David Villar for the most home runs in a season in Flying Squirrels franchise history. He added his 22nd homer on July 7 and his 23rd on July 9 before hitting the IL for two separate stretches. On Tuesday night in his first game at The Diamond Since July 10, Roby hit his 24th home run of the season. He went deep again with a solo homer on Wednesday night. Roby is third in the EL this year in homers. He has hit 21 homers at The Diamond this season, which is a new record for the most at home for a Flying Squirrels player in franchise history, ahead of 10 by Adam Duvall in 2013. It is also a new franchise record for the most career homers at The Diamond. He has also set the franchise record for the most multi-homer games in a season and a career with four.

SAY HEY: Jacob Heyward is currently on a 17-game on-base streak since August 3. In that span, he is batting .250 (13-for-52) with 12 walks. He has extended his career franchise record to 153 walks. Heyward has homered four times in his last 14 games, giving him 30 for his Richmond career, which is tied for the second-most homers in franchise history with Jarrett Parker (2013-14), trailing only 37 by Ricky Oropesa (2013-16).

BRETT BASHING: From July 30-August 3, Brett Auerbach homered in three straight games played. Over his last 21 games since July 30, Auerbach is batting .296 (24-for-81) with six homers, six doubles and 17 RBIs. He has homered in two-of-his-last-three games played since Saturday. In Saturday's game on his 24th birthday, Auerbach hit a homer and made a catch on a pop-up behind home plate where he bounced into the netting behind home plate, landing him the No. 1 spot on ESPN's SportsCenter Top 10 Plays.

DAH-NUH, DAH-NUH: In landing the top spot on SportsCenter's Top 10 Plays on Saturday, Brett Auerbach gave the Flying Squirrels their fifth appearance on the list this year. Plays earlier in the year by Simon Whiteman, Michael Gigliotti and Shane Watheny made Top 10 Plays as well as a catch made by the Flying Squirrels' production team of a hot dog tossed by Flingo the Flamingo and the Wacky Hot Dog Vendor.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Sean Roby is third in homers (24) and sixth in SLG (.487). Mike Gigliotti is tied for sixth in stolen bases (24). Tyler Fitzgerald is ninth in homers (21) and is tied for seventh in runs scored (64). Matt Frisbee is tied for seventh in strikeouts (111), tied for fourth in games started (22), tied for first in complete games (1), second in innings pitched (120.1) and ninth in WHIP (1.31).

WHERE THE SENATORS RANK: In the Eastern League, Jake Alu is seventh in doubles (25). Wilson Garcia is fourth in batting average (.278), ninth in RBIs (67), ninth in SLG (.481), eighth in hits (108) and seventh in total bases (187). Matt Brill is sixth in saves (9) and Zach Brzykcy is tied for seventh (8). Alex Troop is sixth in ERA (4.38), tied for seventh in strikeouts (111) 10th in BAA (.260), eighth in WHIP (1.27) and third in winning percentage (.636).

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have six players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including Kyle Harrison (2), Casey Schmitt (2), Vaun Brown (10), Ryan Murphy (15 - on IL), Will Wilson (22) and Ricardo Genoves (30). Franklin Labour is rated by Baseball America as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Harrison is rated by Baseball America as having the "Best Stider" in the organization. Schmitt is listed as the "Best Defensive Infielder" and "Best Infield Arm." MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Schmitt (6), Murphy (15), Tristan Peters (21), Will Wilson (26) and Landen Roupp (28). Harrison is Baseball America's No. 20 overall prospect and MLB.com's No. 22 overall prospect.
