LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox were handed a second extra inning defeat on Saturday night in a 7-6 loss to Altoona in 11 innings. Bowie came back from a four run deficit as **Ryan Higgins** hit his first homer of the season and **TT Bowers** hit a game-tying three-run homer in the bottom of the ninth. After trading a run each in the 10th, Joe Perez lined a go-ahead RBI single in the 11th and Bowie stranded the tying run at third in the bottom of the 11th to lose their fourth in a row and the series to the Curve.

BASALLO BITS

C/1B **Samuel Basallo** has reached base safely in 24 of his last 26 games dating back to May 21. His 19-game on-base streak from May 21 to June 12 is the longest Baysox on-base streak this season and is tied for the fourth-longest in the Eastern League. Since May 21, the 19-year-old is slashing .320/.387/.937 with five homers and 17 RBI. He is currently tied for the fourth-most hits (68) in the Eastern League and the 10th-most in all of Double-A.

RHODES IS ROLLING

In the month of June, OF/1B **John Rhodes** is batting a team-high .327 with a team-leading 15 RBI after going 2-for-4 with two RBI on Thursday night, including the game-tying hit in the 10th to send the game to the 11th. The Orioles No. 23 prospect has 11 hits and nine RBI over his last six games.

THE FANTASTIC FABIAN

OF **Jud Fabian** is tied for second among active Eastern League players in home runs (12). Fabian hit a league-high six homers in the month of May and has four thus far in June - including three last week in Harrisburg. On Thursday night, Fabian reached base five times and drove in four RBI, his seventh career 4+ RBI game. He's hitting .244 through 57 games after hitting just .176 in 64 AA games last season.

WELCOME MR. ETZEL

OF/1B **Matthew Etzel** has collected a hit in eight of 10 games played for the Baysox thus far and has five stolen bases since being promoted from High-A Aberdeen. His 36 steals on the season between High-A Aberdeen and Double-A Bowie is tied for third most in all of MiLB. He is the first Orioles '23 draft pick to be promoted to Double-A after being selected in the 10th round out of Southern Miss.

COLLECTING K'S

Bowie's pitching staff combined for a season-high 19 strikeouts last night against Altoona. The Baysox lead all of Double-A and the Eastern League in strikeouts (691) and own nearly a 30 strikeout lead against the next best Eastern League team in Richmond (663).

BUILT BY THE BULLPEN

Bowie's bullpen leads the Eastern League and all of Double-A in innings pitched (331.1) and strikeouts (385). The Baysox bullpen owns a 1.20 WHIP, which is the third-lowest in Double-A. In the 50 innings pitched in this series by Bowie, 31.1 innings have come from the bullpen (62.6%).

ASSESSING ALTOONA

Entering this week, the Altoona Curve sit in last place in the Southwest Division at 24-39 on the season. However, the Double-A affiliate of the Pittsburgh Pirates has won their last four in a row and eight of their last 10, including back-to-back series victories over Richmond and Erie. Altoona's roster includes six of the Pirates' top 30 prospects (per MLB Pipeline) - RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 3), LHP Anthony Solomoto (No. 4), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 5), SS Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 8), OF Jase Bowen (No. 19), OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 26)

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Po-Yu Chen makes his 12th start of the season for Altoona. The Taiwanese right-hander threw six innings and gave up three runs (two earned) on seven hits across five walks and two strikeouts in the loss on Tuesday vs the Baysox. In three outings against Bowie this year, Chen has a 6.39 ERA with 19 hits and 10 runs allowed over 12.2 innings pitched. The 22-year-old has a 2.92 ERA over 24.2 innings pitched in June.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmayer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmayer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
