Trevor Hauver hammered a pair of two-run homers to right field but the Midland RockHounds scored eight runs in the ninth inning to beat the Frisco RoughRiders 13-4 on Wednesday at Riders Field. In a game delayed 1:10 by weather, Midland (6-2, 38-39) took a 5-0 lead on a pair of home runs before Frisco (4-4, 35-41) pulled within 5-4 on Hauver's homers. Hauver's blasts came off the bat at 111 and 110 miles per hour. His fourth-inning homer put the Riders on the board and he replicated the effort in the sixth inning, once again following a leadoff hit from a teammate. **Evan Carter** and **Luisangel Acuña** singled each frame, respectively, to set the table for Hauver. Hauver had snapped a 12-game hitting streak on Tuesday but extended a 14-game on-base streak on Wednesday. **Ryan Garcia** (2-8) allowed five runs in four innings to take the loss. Joey Estes (6-5) lasted six innings for the win for Midland, conceding four runs. The bullpen kept the game close, starting with Aidan Anderson in the fifth. He delivered two innings without a run and handed off to Nick Starr. The right-hander set down the RockHounds in order and gave way to Justin Slaten, who posted a scoreless eighth inning. Batting out of the nine-hole for Frisco, Jax Biggers went 2-for-4 for the second straight game to open the series. Frisco snapped a four-game home winning streak and has split the first two games of the series with Midland.

WELCOME BACK, CARTER:

Evan Carter has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 13 games since his return, he has six multi-hit games, batting .431 (22-for-51)/.492/.706/1.198 with three doubles, one triple, three home runs, 12 RBIs and 11 runs scored. Carter is now third in the Texas League in batting average (.313), tied for first in OBP (.424) and sixth in OPS (.887).

This season, the Riders are just seventh in the 10-team Texas League in batting average with runners in scoring position, hitting .254, though Frisco is fourth with 297 RBIs with RISP. Over the last 18 games (8-10 record), Frisco is hitting .254 (44-for-173) in those situations

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. He had a 15-game hitting streak ended on Thursday. In that streak. Saggese hit .443 (27-for-61)/.507/.803/1.310 with five doubles, five home runs, 17 RBIs, eight walks, 13 runs scored and a steal. For his efforts against Springfield, Saggese was named the Texas League Player of the Week, hitting .591 (13-for-22)/.654/.955/1.609 with three doubles, one triple, one home run, seven RBIs, seven runs scored and four walks. Over his last 25 games, he is hitting .357/.448/.653/1.101 with seven home runs and 22 RBIs.

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, first in the Texas League with a .615 average (16-for-26) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.643 OPS on the first pitch, which is first in the league as well. Luisangel Acuña has also been great, hitting .471 (24-for-51) on the initial offering while his 24 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are second in the

SPEED KILLS:

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 33 and is on pace for a career-best 64 swipes. The RoughRiders are second in Texas League steals with 106 bases in 127 attempts (84 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .306 (90-for-294)/.366/.446/.812 through the first 68 games. In June, Acuña hit .300/.336/.460/.796. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (115).

WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 373 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .354 team OBP is second in the Texas League. The Riders have four in the top seven players in Texas League walk rate this season: **Dustin Harris** (3rd, 15.8%), **Trevor Hauver** (4th, 15.6%), Evan Carter (6th, 15.3%) and Jax Biggers (8th, 14.8%). Though he is not qualified for the standings, Aaron Zavala is walking at a 17.1% rate so far this season.

-Leiter was drafted in the first round (No. 2 overall) in 2021 by the Rangers out of Vanderbilt University. With the Commodores, Leiter was a unanimous First Team All-American and a finalist for both the Golden Spikes Award and the Dick Howser Trophy.

-Threw first regular-season, complete-game no-hitter to start SEC play since 1971 against No.16 South Carolina on March 20th, 2021. He walked the first batter of the game before retiring the last 27 he saw with 16 strikeouts on 124 pitches. Followed up that no-hitter with 7.0 no-hit innings in his next start (20.2 consecutive no-hit innings over three starts from March 20th - April 2nd).

-Drafted in 20th round in 2019 by NYY out of Delbarton School (NJ). Named 2019 New Jersey Gatorade POY, striking out 95 in 57 innings as a senior.

-The family lineage is strong with Jack. His father, Al, pitched in 19 MLB seasons (1987-2005), making two All-Star teams and winning both the 1993 and 1997 World Series. His uncle, Mark, played 11 seasons in the majors (1990-99; 2001) and his cousin, Mark Jr., pitched two seasons (2017-2018) with Philadelphia and Toronto. Al now works as an analyst for MLB Network.

2023 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2023 season as the No. $78\,$ prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. $5\,$ prospect in the Rangers system.

-Over three starts on May 5th, May 11th and May 17th, Leiter allowed just three earned runs over $17.0\,\mathrm{IP}\,(1.59\,\mathrm{ERA})$ while striking out 25 and walking five.

2022 SEASON

-Leiter entered the 2022 season as the No. 17 prospect in baseball according to MLB.com and the No. 1 prospect in the Rangers system.

-Leiter dazzeled in his professional debut, striking out seven over his three innings against the Arkansas Travelers on April 9th. The righty helped draw the largest crowd since 2019 at Riders Field for the debut (9,322).

-Threw the Riders first quality start of the season on May 7th against Arkansas. Leiter retired the last 15 batters he saw, allowing just two hits (one in the first and one in the second inning).

-Leiter came out of the bullpen is a "start" to finish a suspended game on May 31st (game was finished on June 1st) and recorded a career-best eight strikeouts against Wichita over 5.2 innings. The game resulted in a 3-0 win for Frisco, the Riders second shutout win of the season to that point.

-The righty allowed just one home run over his first nine outings before allowing two against Amarillo on June 7th. The two home runs were a grand slam and a two-run shot in a 7-4 loss to the Sod Poodles.

-Leiter was placed on the Development List on June 28th and was activated on July $10 \mathrm{th}$ before his start against San Antonio.

-Pitched a 1-2-3 inning on nine pitches in The SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game from Dodger Stadium on July 16th.

2021 SEASON

-After being drafted second overall in the 2021 draft, Leiter did not pitch in the minor leagues. Instead, he returned to Vanderbilt to workout, continue college and prepare for 2022. Did not finish degree, but got closer.

MORE INFO

-Leiter was high school teammates with Yankees No. 1 prospect (No. 8 in baseball) Anthony Volpe at Delbarton School (NJ).

ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the RoughRiders touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MiLB experience.

2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went $3.2~\mathrm{IP},~2~\mathrm{H},~0~\mathrm{R},~0~\mathrm{ER},~3~\mathrm{BB},~1~\mathrm{K}.$ Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, onehitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
