**TODAY'S GAME:** The Memphis Redbirds wrap up a six-game road trip at the Nashville Sounds (Triple-A, Milwaukee Brewers) on Sunday afternoon at First Horizon Park in Nashville. Right-handed pitcher Ian Bedell gets the start for Memphis opposite right-handed pitcher Tobias Myers for Nashville.

**2024 CAMPAIGN:** The Memphis Redbirds finished the 2024 season with a 74-74 record. It marked the first time since the 2018 season with a record of .500 or better. The Redbirds went 38-38 at AutoZone Park.

**LAST NIGHT'S RECAP:** The Memphis Redbirds fell in game five of a six-game series at the Nashville Sounds (Triple-A, Milwaukee Brewers) by a final score of 6-2 on Saturday night at First Horizon Park in Nashville. Memphis tallied both of its runs in the fourth inning. A third baseman Ryan Vilade single got the Redbirds scoring started for the second straight night. Vilade later scored on a first baseman Gavin Collins sacrifice fly. Shortstop Michael Helman led the way with a 3-for-4 night while designated hitter Mike Antico posted a 2-for-4 effort. Starting pitcher Gordon Graceffo (0-1) allowed four runs on four hits, walked three and struck out five in 4.0 innings of work. Reliever Nick Anderson provided Memphis with 2.0 scoreless innings. The right-handed pitcher allowed one hit, walked one and struck out three.

**2025 HOME SLATE:** The Memphis is scheduled to open the 2025 home slate at AutoZone Park against the Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto Blue Jays) on April 1 to begin a six-game series. The Redbirds are scheduled to host 75 home games. Key home dates include Easter Sunday (April 20), Fourth of July and 13 Saturday games at AutoZone Park. The Cross-state rival Nashville Sounds (Triple-A, Milwaukee Brewers) are on tap to duel Memphis nine times at AutoZone Park during the season, highlighted by a three-game series July 4-6. The Gwinnett Stripers (Triple-A, Atlanta Braves) come to AutoZone Park for a pair of six-game sets, July 22-27 and August 19-24. The Redbirds will play a season-long nine-game homestand July 4-13. The 2024 All-Star Break will span July 14-17. The home slate wraps up with a six-game series against the St. Paul Saints (Triple-A, Minnesota Twins) at AutoZone Park September 16-21. Memphis will host the St. Paul and Rochester Red Wings (Triple-A, Washington Nationals) for the first time since the club moved to the International League before the 2021 season. Other home opponents include the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (Triple-A, Miami Marlins), Louisville Bats (Triple-A, Cincinnati Reds), Indianapolis Indians (Triple-A, Pittsburgh Pirates), Norfolk Tides (Triple-A, Baltimore Orioles), Charlotte Knights (Triple-A, Chicago White Sox), and Durham Bulls (Triple-A, Tampa Bay Rays).

## MANAGER BEN JOHNSON

**Ben Johnson** enters his seventh season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his seventh year in the Cardinals organization.

### COACHING CAREER

- 348 - 367 managerial record entering 202 season
- Oversaw a franchise record 15-game winning streak in 2021 (7/9-7/25); tied for longest in MiLB that season
- Oversaw a franchise record 200 home runs in 2019; team won 29 of final 40 games and were in contention for division until 2nd to last day of the season
- Spent 2018 as third base coach for the Durham Bulls (Rays' Triple-A)
- Spent 2014-2017 as a scout in the Arizona Diamondbacks organization
- Coached at Millenium HS in Goodyear, AZ from 2011-2013
- Previously managed Arizona Centennials in the Independent League in 2012

### PLAYING CAREER

- Drafted by the Cardinals in the 4th Rd. of 1999 Draft; traded to Padres in 2000
- Made MLB debut on June 26, 2005 with the Padres; played 98 games over next three seasons with the Padres and Mets
- Named Padres Minor League Player of the Year in 2005 when he hit a career-high .312 with 25 home runs and 83 RBIs as a member of the Portland Beavers
- Played 901 MiLB games over 10 seasons with Cardinals, Padres, Mets and Tigers; hit .262 with 115 career home runs and 473 RBIs

### PERSONAL

- Born in Memphis and played baseball at Germantown HS; named Memphis-area HS Player of the Year in 1999; lives with his dad during the season
- He and his wife, Elizabeth, have two children, Ethan and Ruby; reside in Phoenix, AZ

## PITCHING COACH DARWIN MARRERO

- Marrero, 44, is beginning his 13th season in the Cardinals organization and third with Memphis.

### COACHING CAREER

- Joined the Memphis Redbirds coaching staff following five seasons (2018-22) with Double-A Springfield Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

### PLAYING CAREER

- Marrero's playing career spanned seven seasons from 1998-2004 with the Montreal Expos organization, attaining his highest level at Double-A with the Harrisburg Senators in 2002 and 2004.

## HITTING COACH HOWIE CLARK

- Clark is beginning his third season in the Cardinals organization and second with Memphis

### COACHING CAREER

- In 2015, Clark was named the hitting coach of the Delmarva Shorebirds, the Class-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. In February 2017, Clark was named the assistant hitting coach for the Orioles. He was named hitting coach of the Charlotte Knights, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, for the 2020 season. [9] On December 1, 2020, Clark was named assistant hitting coach for the Chicago White Sox.

### PLAYING CAREER

- Clark played parts of six seasons in MLB with the Baltimore Orioles, Minnesota Twins and Toronto Blue Jays from 2002 to 2008.
- Clark batted .262 with three home runs and 26 RBI in his career

- CAREER
  - Selected to Major League Spring Training as a non-roster invitee for the first time in his career.
  - Joins Jordan Walker, Masyn Winn, Tink Hence, and Alec Burtleson as one of five Cardinals selections from the 2020 MLB Draft in Major League Camp.
  - Led all 2023 Cardinals minor league pitchers in ERA while ranking fifth in the organization in WHIP, sixth in strikeouts and 10th in opponent batting average.
  - Paced the 2023 Peoria staff with a career-high106 strikeouts and ranked second with 96.0 innings pitched.
  - Posted career bests in wins (4), appearances (27) and opp. batting average (.218) in 2023 with Peoria.
  - Held opponents to one earned run or fewer in each of his first 11 outings (5 starts) to open the 2023 campaign with High-A Peoria, going 2-1 with a 1.44 ERA (5 ER/31.1 IP), 44 strikeouts and a 1.18 WHIP.
  - Compiled an 18.1-inning scoreless streak across five appearances (4 starts) from June 14-July 8, 2023.
  - Started Game 2 of the 2023 Midwest League Semifinals at Cedar Rapids (3.0 IP, 5 ER, 4 SO).

  - Participated in early workouts and seminars as part of the team's Spring Training Early Program (STEP Camp).
  - Matched a career high with 19 starts (also 2023) and set career-high marks in innings pitched (107.2) and strikeouts (110) between Double-A Springfield and Triple-A Memphis.
  - Began the season at Springfield and made 12 appearances (10 starts) before he received a promotion June 20 to Memphis.
  - Struck out a career-high 11 batters with no walks and one run allowed through 5.1 innings June 9 at Arkansas in his penultimate start with Springfield.
  - Pitched at least 7.0 innings with one run allowed or fewer career-high four times (2 w/ SPR; 2 w/ MEM).
  - His two 7.0+ inning starts with Memphis came in back-to-back starts July 12 vs. Norfolk (7.0 IP, 0 ER) and July 20 vs. Iowa (7.2 IP, 1 ER).
  - Spent time on the 7-day Injured List from Aug. 7-Sept. 20 and returned to throw 1.0 inning of scoreless relief in the season finale Sept. 22 vs. Durham.
  - Notched eight-or-more strikeouts in three consecutive starts from May 29-June 9 and led all MiLB pitchers with 28 strikeouts during that stretch.
- BACKGROUND/PERSONAL
  - Won the 2019 Cape Cod League "Most Outstanding Pitching Award" after going 4-0 with a 0.59 ERA in six starts with 36 strikeouts for Wareham.
  - Was the starting pitcher for the West All-Star Team in the 2019 Cape Cod All-Star Game.
  - Bypassed his senior year at Davenport (IA) Central High School to enroll early at the University of Missouri.
  - Made four starts with a 34-5 strikeout-to-walk ratio and 12.95 strikeouts/9.0 IP as a junior at Mizzou in 2020 before the season ended early because of the COVID-19 pandemic.
  - Participated in the 2017 Perfect Game National Showcase in Fort Myers, Fla.
  - Has an identical twin brother, Connor

- Signed by the Cardinals as a non-drafted free agent with an invitation to 2025 Major League Spring Training, four days prior to pitchers and catchers reporting. St. Louis become his eighth organization (Twins, Marlins, Rays, Braves, Royals, Dodgers and Orioles) and fifth in the last three years.
- Originally drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in 2012, but did not sign.
