**Tonight:** It's Whiteclaws and Paws, with \$3 White Claws and dogs welcome! On the field, the Nuts look to end a three-game losing streak to Lake County with the debuting **Jeff Criswell** (Portage Central / University of Michigan) on the mound, followed by hard-throwing **Colin Peluse**, opposed by Lake County southpaw Matt Turner. Play ball, and Go Nuts!

**What's New in 2021:** In this, their 25th season in existence, the Lugnuts' stadium name changed from Cooley Law School Stadium to Jackson® Field™, the Nuts moved up to the High-A Central, and they accepted an invitation to affiliate with the Oakland Athletics. The A's are the Lugnuts' fourth MLB partner, following the Kansas City Royals (1996-98), Chicago Cubs (1999-2004) and Toronto Blue Jays (2005-2020).

**Covid-19 Regulations:** Capacity is limited to 20%, with a maximum attendance of 2200 allowed per game. Fans and media members must wear a mask at all times, unless actively eating or drinking at their seat. Beginning this season, Jackson® Field™ is now an entirely cashless facility. No one is permitted within 12 feet of the playing surface. In-game on-field promotions are currently prohibited.

**Last Night: Captains 6, Lugnuts 2.** Right-hander **Tanner Burns** turned in a fine performance in his professional debut, tossing four scoreless innings with six strikeouts, and the Caps captured their third straight victory. **Austen Wade** homered in the winning cause for Lake County, while Lansing received two-hit performances from **Michael Guldberg** and **Lester Maden, Jr.** in defeat.

### LUG•NOTES

**Meet the Boss:** Scott Steinmann is the 16th manager in Lugnuts team history. Born in Dayton, Steinmann joins the Lugnuts after three straight seasons assigned to manage Double-A Midland (though the 2020 season was canceled). Steinmann previously managed against the Lugnuts while with Wisconsin (2005), Clinton (2009, 2014-15) and Beloit (2017).

**Familiar Settings:** 13 of the 30 Lugnuts players came through the Midwest League in Beloit on their way up the Athletics' ladder, and coaching staff members **Scott Steinmann**, **Don Schulze** and **Anthony Phillips** all have experience in the league.

**A Pleasant Peninsula:** The Nuts have three players with Michigan ties: **Max Schuemann** (Portage Northern H.S.) becomes the first Lugnut to come from Eastern Michigan University, plus **Jeff Criswell** (Portage Central H.S.) and **Jack Weisenburger** (Rockford H.S.), who become the fourth and fifth Michigan Wolverine to play in Lansing (following **Troy Miller**, **Jake Fox** and **Rich Hill**).

**Finally:** Pitchers **Jeff Criswell**, **Stevie Emanuels** and **Shohei Tomioka**, catchers **Jared McDonald**, **Drew Millas** and **William Simoneit**, first baseman **Patrick McColl**, and outfielders **Michael Guldberg** and **Jake Suddleson** are all making their pro debut this season.

**Front Office Connections:** Lugnuts pitching coach **Don Schulze** was drafted 11th overall by the Chicago Cubs in 1980, 12 picks before Oakland Executive Vice President of Baseball Operations **Billy Beane** was drafted by the New York Mets. Lugnuts first baseman **Patrick McColl** set a new Harvard baseball single season record with 70 hits in 2019, breaking the previous record held by Athletics General Manager David Forst.

**Clubhouse of Higher Learning:** The Ivy League is well represented on the Lansing roster. Outfielder **Jake Suddleson** and first baseman **Patrick McColl** played for Harvard, reliever **Michael Danielak** was drafted from Dartmouth and catcher **William Simoneit** spent four years at Cornell before grad-transferring to Wake Forest.

**Power Five Baseball:** The Lugnuts also represent the ACC (**Michael Guldberg**, Georgia Tech); Big 12 (**Brady Basso**, Oklahoma State); Big Ten (**Jeff Criswell** and **Jack Weisenburger**, Michigan; **Dalton Sawyer**, Minnesota); and the SEC (**Cobie Vance**, Alabama, and **Ryan Gridley**, Mississippi State); and the Pac-12 (**Stevie Emanuels**, Washington).

**International Appeal:** In addition to the 15 different states represented by Lugnuts players and coaching staff, there are seven nations represented: USA, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Japan, South Africa and Venezuela.

**Teammates Then, Teammates Now:** Several of the Nuts are quite familiar with one another. **Jake Suddleson** and **Patrick McColl** played together at Harvard, **Reid Birlingmair** and **Charlie Cerny** pitched together at the University of Illinois at Chicago, and **Jeff Criswell** and **Jack Weisenburger** pitched together in Ann Arbor. The Lugnuts also have a pair of Wake Forest Demon Deacons, but **William Simoneit** played only one year at Wake, 2020, thus missing **Colin Peluse** by a year.

### TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

**2010:** The Nuts brought a 4-0 lead to the bottom of the 9th at Parkview Field, but the TinCaps rallied to tie the game thanks to errors by 2B Ryan Schimpf and 3B Sean Ochinko and a passed ball by A.J. Jimenez. In the 10th, a surprise storm blew in, causing Casey Beck to throw back-to-back wild pitches with a wet ball, bringing in Jonathan Galvez with the winning run in a frustrating 5-4 TinCaps win. Less than ten minutes after the game had ended, the sky was clear and blue again.

**2013:** A battle of top prospects in Dayton was determined decisively: The Nuts' Daniel Norris allowed eight runs (six earned) in 1 1/3 innings, while the Dragons' Robert Stephenson struck out nine batters in six scoreless innings, allowing three hits, in an 11-4 Dragons win..

**Prospecting:** Criswell is considered the best lower-level pitching prospect in the Athletics' organization, rated Keith Law's No. 5 overall A's prospect, MLB.com's No. 8 prospect and Baseball America's No. 14 prospect. Wrote Law, "Criswell was mostly a two-pitch guy up to 95 mph at Michigan, but was showing four pitches and hitting 97 mph in instructs, with a cleaner delivery than the violent one he'd had before the shutdown. Criswell's slider was a swing-and-miss pitch in college and it's gotten sharper now, while his changeup, which he barely used in school, was flashing plus in instructs too."

**All in the Family:** Jeff's father, Brian, was drafted by the A's in the 17th round in 1984 from Western Michigan and pitched in the Midwest League for the Madison Muskies, today's West Michigan Whitecaps, eventually reaching Double-A Huntsville, where he was teammates in 1986 with Mark McGwire... Jeff's mother, Patti, has written books for the American Girl company... Jeff's sister, Natalie, was a record-setting swimmer at Bowling Green State University.

**Success on the Field:** Rated Perfect Game's No. 1 high school right-hander in Michigan in 2017, Criswell was drafted by the Tigers in the 35th round in 2017... turned them down and went to Ann Arbor... named All-Big Ten First Team as a sophomore (2.72, 116 K in 106 IP) and was a key contributor in leading the Wolverines on their run to College World Series Runner-Up to national champion Vanderbilt.

**Prospecting:** Rated Baseball America's No. 26 A's prospect... "Not assigned to the alternate training site, Peluse committed to an at-home workout plan tailored to increase his leg strength and added 10 pounds of muscle. He arrived at instructional league showing significant velocity gains, much to the A's surprise... Peluse's fastball sat 96 mph and touched 98 at instructs, a marked increase from his low-90s readings in college. His slider was already a plus pitch, showing late life and more drop than a typical slider."

**Professional Career:** Taken 284th overall in the 9th round, 2019, and signed for \$149,300... made pro debut with SS-A Vermont on June 28th... made four straight starts, not throwing more than three innings in any of them, and then moved to the pen, with five scoreless innings in relief July 27th... in final outing, struck out six in 3 2/3 at Lowell on August 8th.

**College:** Began as a Tuesday starter as freshman before moving to bullpen and pitching effectively, with three NCAA shutout Super Regional appearances at Florida... served as Sunday starter as sophomore and was Wake Forest's top starter statistically (3.87, 16 G, 14 GS)... Friday starter as a junior.

**High School:** At Middletown H.S., spent one year on wrestling team, also a member of Sports Medicine and ROTC... as junior, tossed no-hitter in 2nd start, 11 K's, at Blue Rocks' Frawley Stadium, but woke up the next day and couldn't move his arm; underwent Tommy John surgery and missed senior season... still was rated No. 2 player in Delaware by Perfect Game.
