On April 23, 2010, The Sounds shutout Oklahoma City 3-0 at Herschel Greer Stadium in front of 6,741 fans. Kameron Loe completed eight of the nine scoreless frames for Sounds pitching, allowing six hits while striking out four. Johnny Raburn hit the go-ahead run with a sac fly in the eighth inning. Chris Smith retired the side in order for the save.

vs. Charlotte: The Sounds and Knights are scheduled to play each other 13 more times in 2022 after tonight. with two of the series at First Horizon Park (April 19-24, July 26-31) and one in Charlotte (September 6-11). Nashville won 7 of 12 games last year, the first time the two clubs have met. The two teams split a six-game series in Charlotte June 1-6 and the Sounds won 4 of 6 games June 22-27 at First Horizon Park. Nashville is 10-6 all-time against the Knights.

Hold the Line: Nashville relievers have amassed 18 holds this season for the most in Triple-A baseball (Oklahoma City has the second-most with 14).

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 520-465

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville opened the 2022 season with four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 7 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 21 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 25 prospect.
