How about Hartford: The Patriots have taken each of the first four games of this six-game set against the Yard Goats. Somerset got a two-run home run from Dermis Garcia to earn a come-from-behind 2-1 win Tuesday night. After taking Wednesday's game 6-4 in extras, the Patriots have outscored the Yard Goats 25-4 in their last two games with 11-1 and 14-3 wins, respectively.

Don't miss Dermis: INF Dermis Garcia went 3-for-4 with a home run, two runs scored and a season-high four RBI last night in Hartford. Garcia has now hit safely in eight-straight games, the longest hit streak for a Patriot this season. Over this stretch, Garcia is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with five home runs, seven runs scored, and 13 RBI. The power-hitting righty began the season 1-for-24 (.042) in his first seven games before beginning his current hit streak.

Offensive Explosion: One night after tallying a season-high 11 runs on 17 hits, the Patriots had another dominant encore performance Friday evening. The team plated a season-high 14 runs on 16 hits. For the second-straight night, every Patriots batter recorded a hit. Additionally, every Patriots scored a run last night as well - a first for the 2021 season. It also marked the first time this season the team not ony scored 10+ runs in back-to-back games, but also recorded 10+ hits on consecutive nights.

Hits and Misses: The Patriots pitching staff leads all of Double-A with 199 strikeouts, 20 more than the next closest team (Bowie). The pitchers have struck out double digit batters in 13 of 16 contests this season, including nine of their last 10 games.

Quite the debut: OF Aaron Palensky made his professional debut Thursday night in Hartford and went 2-for-5 with two RBI, including a run-scoring double in his first pro plate appearance. The 2020 Yankees free agent signing went 3-for-4 with another two RBI in his second game on Friday. Palensky is 5-for-9 with four RBI over his first two professional games.

On the Beltway: Michael Beltre is 7-for-12 with five runs and five RBI over his last two games. He has now hit safely in four-straight, raising his batting average from .167 to .280 in the process.

Start me up: Each of Somerset's starting pitchers in the current Hartford series have not allowed a run. Matt Krook, Janson Junk, Glen Otto, and Luis Gil have combined to toss 19 scoreless innings while allowing just seven walks and eight hits with 35 strikeouts.

Not Dunn Yet: Oliver Dunn is 5-for-10 (.500) from the plate over his last two games with three RBI and seven runs scored. Despite playing in only four games with Somerset, Dunn is already tied for third on the team in runs scored (8).
