vs. the Indianapolis Indians (Pittsburgh Pirates) at Coolray Field, the only series between the two clubs this season. Today is Sunday Funday, presented by Georgia United Credit Union, as well as Father's Day and Juneteenth.

SEEKING WIN IN SERIES FINALE: The Stripers can snap a five-game losing streak in series finales with a win today. Gwinnett is 3-7 (.300) in finales overall this year, having last won on 5/8 vs. Charlotte (6-5). Since then, they've lost on 5/15 (6-5 at DUR), 5/22 (10-4 vs. MEM), 5/29 (8-4 at NOR), 6/5 (6-0 vs. LOU), and 6/12 (7-3 at JAX).

VS. INDIANAPOLIS: Gwinnett is 35-22 (.614) all-time vs. Indianapolis at Coolray Field. The Stripers have won 10 of their last 11 home games againt the Indians dating back to 4/23/19. Gwinnett claimed the season series victory with last night's win, improving to 4-4-4 in season series vs. Indianapolis since 2009 (3-0 since 2018).

STIFLING STAFF: Gwinnett leads Triple-A in ERA in the month of June with a 3.51 mark in 16 games. That's 0.21 points lower than Scranton/WB (2nd, 3.72 in 16G). Stripers' starters Tucker Davidson, Bryce Elder, Nolan Kingham, Kyle Muller, and Huascar Ynoa have combined to post a 3.65 ERA (36 ER in 88.2 IP), 9.54 SO/9.0 IP ratio (94 SO), and seven quality starts this month.

KINGS OF THE "K": Gwinnett's pitching staff is tied for the Triple-A lead in strikeouts with 665 in 65 games (10.23 SO per game). Sacramento of the Pacific Coast League also has 665 strikeouts in 65 games. Kyle Muller (1st, 84), Tucker Davidson (T-6th, 57), and Huascar Ynoa (T-6th, 57) all rank in the IL top 10 in strikeouts.

ROBERTSON STREAKING: Kramer Robertson is riding a six-game hitting streak, batting .364 (8-for-22, 2 2B, 1 HR, 6 R, 5 RBI, 4 SB, 1.091 OPS) since 6/12. He has scored a run in each of his last four games (5 total) since 6/15.

· Giddy Up: Robertson blasted his first Gwinnett homer on Friday (#6 overall), a solo shot to center on the first pitch of the game from RHP Jerad Eickhoff. It was the fourth clout by a Stripers player leading off a game this year (Drew Waters has 2, Phil Gosselin has 1).

DESHIELDS KEEPS REACHING: Delino DeShields Jr. has posted an eight-game on-base streak since 6/3, batting .429 (9-for-21, 1 2B, 1 HR, 7 R, 3 RBI, 5 SB, 1.200 OPS) in that span. Overall with Gwinnett, he has reached base safely in 38 of 45 games (84.4%), batting .276 (35-for-127, 5 2B, 1 HR, 21 R, 13 RBI). He currently ranks among IL leaders in stolen bases (T-7th, 15) and walks (T-11th, 33).

WATERS WATCH: In 30 games since being activated from Gwinnett's 7-day IL on 5/3, Atlanta Braves No. 2 prospect Drew Waters is batting .244 (29-for-119, 6 2B, 1 3B, 3 HR, 16 R, 10 RBI, 1 SB), including .447 (5 XBH, 1.107 OPS) vs. LHP and .148 (5 XBH, .474 OPS) vs. RHP.

- Start it With a Bang: Waters has three XBH on the first pitch of the game this year, including leadoff homers on 5/3 vs. Charlotte (off LHP Wes Benjamin) and 5/11 at Durham (off RHP Tommy Romero), and a leadoff triple on 6/11 at Jacksonville (off RHP Bryan Hoeing).
- **GWN Career:** Since making his Triple-A debut in 2019, Waters is batting .246 (155-for-630, 33 2B, 2 3B, 16 HR, 103 R, 58 RBI, 32 SB, .703 OPS) in 160 games.

TODAY: The Stripers play the finale of a six-game series **MULLDOZING:** Today's scheduled starting pitcher **Kyle** Muller enters play looking to continue his dominance in June. He has recorded three straight quality starts since 6/2, going 2-0 with a 0.90 ERA (2 ER in 20.0 IP), 0.90 WHIP, .194 BAA, and 12.60 SO/9.0 IP ratio (28 SO). Muller has fanned eight-plus batters in all three starts, including 11 over 7.0 IP in his last start on 6/14 vs. Indianapolis.

- IL Leaderboard: Muller leads the league in strikeouts (84) and is among the top 10 in ERA (3rd, 2.89), BAA (6th, .230), WHIP (6th, 1.19), and innings (T-7th, 62.1).
- GWN Career: Since making his Triple-A debut in 2021, he is 9-7 with a 3.17 ERA (50 ER in 142.0 IP), .226 BAA, and 177 strikeouts (11.22 SO/9.0 IP ratio) in 28 starts.

DEMERITTE RETURNS: Travis Demeritte is batting .125 (2for-16, 4 R, 1 RBI, 1 SB) in four games with Gwinnett since being optioned by Atlanta on 5/28. He hit .213 (19-for-89, 2 2B, 3 HR, 9 R, 6 RBI) in 26 games during his first career stint with the Braves from 4/22-5/27.

• GWN Career: Demeritte has reached base safely in 164 of 193 games (85.0%) with the Stripers since 2019, batting .280 (187-for-667, 49 2B, 4 3B, 43 HR, 130 R, 138 RBI, 14 SB, .932 OPS). He is one of three players in Gwinnett history with two 20-homer seasons, joining Stefan Gartrell and Ernesto Mejia.

TUIASOSOPO REACHES 100-WIN MARK: Matt Tuiasosopo earned his 100th win as a Triple-A manager on 6/9 at Jacksonville (won 5-1). He is the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 wins, joining Dave Brundage (293 from 2009-12), Brian Snitker (161 from 2014-16), and Damon Berryhill (221 from 2017-19).

GOSSELIN GETS THE CALL: On Tuesday, the Atlanta Braves selected the contract of INF Phil Gosselin from Gwinnett. Gosselin hit safely in 23 of 29 games from 5/1-6/12, batting .312 (34-for-109, 10 2B, 1 3B, 4 HR, 14 R, 16 RBI, .885 OPS) in that stretch. Through 6/13, he ranked 14th in the IL with a .297 average (54-for-182, 13 2B, 2 3B, 5 HR, 25 R, 24 RBI, .831 OPS) in 49 games.

• GWN Career: In 284 games over four seasons (2013-14, 2018, 2022), Gosselin is batting .295 (309-for-1046, 64 2B, 10 3B, 17 HR, 138 R, 106 RBI, 11 SB, .769 OPS). He is one of just seven players in Gwinnett history to record 300 career hits with the club.

MANAGER MATT TUIASOSOPO

Matt Tuiasosopo is in his second season as the manager of the Stripers in 2022 ... He was named the seventh manager in Gwinnett history on 3/30/21, making him the first former Gwinnett player to manage the club (played OF/1B from 2016-17) ... In 2021, he guided the Stripers to a 71-58 record (3rd in Triple-A East Southeast Division) ... On 5/4/21 at Charlotte, he became the youngest manager in Gwinnett history (34 years, 11 months, 25 days) ... On 6/9/22 at Jacksonville, he became the fourth manager in Gwinnett history to reach 100 career wins ... Began his managerial career with Class-A Rome in 2019, earning Atlanta's Bobby Cox Award for MiLB Manager of the Year ... Coached at the Braves' Alternate Training Site in 2020.

PROSPECTING: Muller is currently ranked as the Atlanta Braves' No. 3 prospect by MLB.com ... He is the top-ranked pitcher on Gwinnett's active roster.
