### JUMBO SHRIMP BLANK SOUNDS 2-0

Jacksonville pitchers combined for 16 strikeouts and Will Banfield bopped a two-run home run to lead the Jumbo Shrimp to a 2-0 victory over Nashville. Banfield's homer broke open a scoreless game in the sixth inning for the contest's only runs. Edward Cabrera struck out seven in 4.0 hitless innings before ceding to Bryan Hoeing, who whiffed five across 2.0 scoreless frames. Anthony Maldonado tossed two perfect innings and Emmanuel Ramirez worked a scoreless ninth inning for his fifth save of the season. The 16 punchouts were the second-most in a game this year for the Jumbo Shrimp.

### STARTING FROM SCRATCH

Somewhat incredibly, Jacksonville starting pitchers have yielded three runs or fewer in 14 of the last 15 games, with 12 of those starts resulting in two runs or fewer charged to a Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifter, and seven being scoreless. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp starting pitchers have ceded only 18 runs, 16 earned, on 47 hits (7.1 H/9) in 59.2 innings for a 2.41 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 53 strikeouts (8.0 K/9) against 23 walks (3.5 BB/9) during this stretch.

### LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 38 of his last 43 games, notching 18 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 60-for-171 (.351/.406/.491/.897) at the plate with 12 doubles, three triples, two home runs, 30 RBIs, 18 walks and 22 runs scored.

### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 51 of Jacksonville's 76 games (67.1 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 12 of the club's last 14 contests and seven in a row. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 24 of its last 36 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 24-27 (.471) in these affairs.

### GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 42 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 47-for-his-last-143, slashing .329/.409/.671/1.080 with 11 doubles, one triple, 12 home runs, 32 RBIs, 20 walks and 27 runs scored. Among the 119 qualified hitters in the IL, Conine ranks ninth in HR/FB (27.8 percent). On the season, the 26-year-old ranks tied for second in the International League in extra-base hits (32), tied for 10th in home runs (15), 11th in slugging percentage (.555), 11th in OPS (.930), tied for 17th in hits (65) and tied for 23rd in RBIs (42).

### ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS?

Jacksonville's 15-25 (.375) home record is the worst such mark in the IL, while the club's 20-15 (.571) road record is one of only seven winning away records in the circuit this year. On the road, the Shrimp have scored 187 runs in 36 games (5.2 per game), more than a full run better than what they average at home (151 runs, second-fewest in Triple-A, in 40 games, 3.8 per game). Jacksonville has surrendered 196 runs (16th-most) in 40 home games (4.9 per game) compared to 157 (sixth-fewest) on the road (4.4 per game).

### PITCH (CLOSE TO) PERFECT

Jacksonville has won 11 of their last 16 contests, mainly behind some dominant pitching and defense. During this span, the Jumbo Shrimp have ceded four runs or fewer in 13 of those 16 affairs. Since this run began on June 7, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A in runs allowed (47), ERA and (.273). The Jumbo Shrimp rank in a tie with Charlotte for the fewest hits allowed (119) while placing second in batting average against (.227) and fourth in fewest walks (54) during this stretch.

### SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville's 16 strikeouts were their second-most in a game this season (17, April 11 vs. Charlotte), with their two hits allowed matching their fewest in a contest... The Jumbo Shrimp have won four in a row. Their season-high winning streak is five, which they have accomplished twice... Will Banfield is 9-for-18 with two doubles, two home runs, six RBIs, one walk and six runs scored over his last five games.

### ABOUT MAX

-Selected by the Marlins with the third overall pick of the 2020 draft, Meyer tied Hall of Famer Paul Molitor (No. 3 to the Milwaukee Brewers in 1977) as the highest pick in Minnesota Golden Gophers history. Meyer is one of four Minnesotans to be picked in the top five in the draft, along with Molitor, Joe Mauer and Dave Winfield. Prior to Meyer, the last time the Gophers had a pitcher taken in the first round of the MLB draft was left-hander Glen Perkins, who was selected 22nd overall by the Minnesota Twins in 2004.

-During his junior season at Minnesota in 2020, Meyer was tabbed as a consensus Preseason All-American and made four starts in a shortened season due to the pandemic. He finished fifth in the nation with 46 strikeouts and a team-best 1.95 ERA in 27.2 innings. Meyer has slashed .185/.214/.222 with one double, two runs scored, four RBIs and a stolen base while playing infield for the Gophers.

-As a sophomore in 2019, Meyer was named an All-Big Ten Second Team Selection. He made 16 appearances on the mound, including 11 starts, and went 5-3 with a 2.11 ERA and two saves 76.2 innings. He fanned a team-high 87 batters. Meyer also played in 35 games, including 30 starts, on the infield, batting .256/.323/.314 with four doubles, one home run, 12 RBIs and 15 runs scored.
