GAME INFORMATION

POSTSEASON PONIES: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies clinched a spot in the Eastern League Postseason with the Northeast Division first-half title. It marks' Binghamton's 13-time reaching the postseason in its 33-year franchise history and the second time in the last three years under fourth-year manager Reid Brignac. Binghamton has won three Eastern League Championships (1992, 1994, 2014) and last reached the Eastern League Championship Series in 2023.

FIRST PLACE PONIES: The Rumble Ponies are 42-19 and currently hold the best winning % in Minor League Baseball (.689). The Rumble Ponies have been in sole possession of first in the Eastern League's Northeast Division since May 18. Binghamton is 24-4 in its last 28 G, since May 14. LAST GAME: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies set a season high with 17 hits and defeated the Richmond Flying Squirrels, 8-2, at The Diamond on Saturday. Binghamton recorded a season-high-tying seven doubles. CF Jett Williams (3-for-5, RBI, 2 R, 2 K) recorded his second three-hit game of the series. Binghamton had seven hitters record multi-hit games. DH JT Schwartz (3-for-4, HR, RBI, 2 R, BB) blasted his third home run of the season.

PARADA PARTY: C Kevin Parada (2-for-4, RBI, R, 2 2B, K) hit two doubles on Saturday and is now 7-for-16 (.438 AVG) with 2 HR, 5 RBI, 3 R, and 3 2B in four games in this series. Parada has been on a tear over his last 22 games (24-for-73, .329 AVG, .409 OBP, .671 SLG, 1.080 OPS, 7 HR, 18 RBI, 14 R, 42B, 11BB, 16K), after getting off to a slow start over his first 25 games this season (10-for-82, .122 AVG, .375 OPS, 1 HR, 4 RBI, 3 R, 5 BB, 29 K). Since May 16, Parada ranks among the Eastern League: 7 HR (T-1st), 18 RBI (4th), 1.080 OPS (2nd), .671 SLG (2nd), .329 AVG (6th), .409 OBP (7th). In 10 games in June, Parada is hitting .371 with 1.239 OPS, 4 HR and 10 RBI.

CLEARED FOR TAKEOFF: SS/CF Jett Williams, the Mets No. 1 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 48 overall prospect, has reached base in 10-straight games. In 11 games in June, Williams is hitting .366 (15-for-41) with a 1.222 OPS, 2 HR, 7 RBI, 10 R, 5 2B, 2 3B, 9 XBH, 9 BB, 2 SB. Williams is now hitting .298 with a .928 OPS, 6 HR, 24 RBI, and 18 SB in 54 games this season. The 21-year-old ranks among the Eastern League: .928 OPS (T-2nd), .404 OBP (3rd), .524 SLG (3rd), .298 AVG (4th), 27 XBH (2nd), 4 3B (T-2nd), 17 2B (T-5th), 37 R (3rd), 32 BB (T-6th), 18 SB (T-6th).

BUILT CLIFFORD TOUGH: 1B/OF Ryan Clifford, the Mets No. 5 prospect (MLB Pipeline), went 2-for-4 with 2 RBI on Saturday. Clifford has homered in four of his last eight games, with two in this series and is tied for the Eastern League-lead with 12 HR. Clifford is riding a eight-game hit streak (12-for-30, .400 AVG, .486 OBP, .933 SLG, 1.420 OPS, 4 HR, 8 RBI, 5 R, 4 2B, 6 BB, 6 K). In 12 games in June, Clifford has 4 HR (12 H), 9 RBI, 5 R, 9 BB (8 K), 1.074 OPS. He had a strong May (27 G, .267 AVG, .843 OPS, 5 HR, 20 RBI, 11 R, 14 BB) and ranked T-3rd in the EL in HR (5) & 3rd in RBI (20) in May, after he hit .200 with a .703 OPS, 3 HR, & 9 RBI in April. The 21-year-old ranks among the EL: 12 HR (T-1st), 38 RBI (4th), 35 BB (5th), 24 XBH (8th), .485 SLG (10th).

GOTTA GO MORABITO: OF Nick Morabito, the Mets No. 16 prospect (MLB Pipeline), is hitting .298 (14-for-47) with 9 RBI, 8 R, 5 2B, 3 BB, and 3 SB in 11 games in June. The 22-year-old ranks among the Eastern League: 23 SB (2nd), 61 H (3rd), 18 2B (T-2nd), 35 R (T-7th), 23 XBH (9th). In May, he hit .326 (29-for-89) with an .833 OPS, 1 HR, 11 RBI, 14 R, 8 2B, 9 XBH, 9 BB, 12 SB (12-for-14) in 25 G. Morabito is in his first Double-A season and was the 2024 Mets MiLB Player of the Year.

TONG TERRIFIC: RHP Jonah Tong, the Mets No. 4 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 96 overall prospect, started against Richmond in the series opener on Tuesday at The Diamond (W, 5.1 IP, 4 H, 1 ER, 2 BB, 8 K). Tong now ranks tied for the second-most strikeouts (91) in Minor League Baseball. Tong also ranks 2nd in MiLB with a 15.07 K/9 and 41.6 K%. He ranks 3rd in MiLB with a .143 BAA. The 21-year-old ranks top 4 in MiLB in SO, K/9, K%, and BAA. Tong ranks 2nd in the Eastern League and 4th in Double-A with a 1.99 ERA and 5th in the EL and 9th in Double-A with a 1.03 WHIP. Over his last three starts, Tong is 3-0 with a 1.10 ERA (2 ER) and 26 strikeouts in 16.1 innings with opponents hitting .125 against him (7 H) in that span. Tong has allowed three earned runs or less in all 11 of his starts this season. The right-hander was drafted by the New York Mets in the seventh round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Georgia Premier Academy (GA).

-Reid Brignac is now the second-longest tenured manager in Binghamton history, behind Pedro Lopez (2012-16).
-In 2024, Brignac led a Rumble Ponies team that at one point won 10-conesecutive games, which marked the franchise's longest winning streak since 2006. Brignac also oversaw Eastern League Pitcher of the Year and Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year Brandon Sproat's dominant stint at Double-A. Brignac helped the Mets' MLB staff after the MiLB season.
-In 2023, Brignac led Binghamton to the postseason for the first time since 2017, going 39-27 in the second-half and 17-5

in the final 22 games. Binghamton swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to advance to the Eastern League Championship Series for the first time since 2014, before falling to the Erie SeaWolves.

-In 2022, he led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies, tying a franchise record (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, José Butto, Nate Fisher, Bryce Montes de Oca).
-Brignac enjoyed a long and successful playing career, spending parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School in Louisiana.
